RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WILL JOHNSTON 9 TO 3 ON THE HITS 3YO
<p>SAVASON (L Innes) began awkwardly.</p> <p>DEVIANT MISS (M Cameron) shifted outwards leaving the barriers crowding ROSE SAUVAGE (B Hutton) which was steadied losing ground.</p> <p>Shortly after leaving the barriers DEVIANT MISS was crowded between WINOR ELSA (L McGregor) which lay out and LANDED GENTRY (B R Jones) which shifted inwards when struck with the whip. As a result DEVIANT MISS had to briefly steady.</p> <p>LANDED GENTRY raced ungenerously when making the bend passing the 900 metres hampering MEGAWATT (V Colgan) with DEVIANT MISS then having to steady to avoid the heels of MEGAWATT and shifting outwards inconveniencing ROSE SAUVAGE which was forced wider on the track.</p> <p>SAVASON got its head up when being steadied off heels passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>RED TSUNAMI (A Jones) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of FIRE JET rider D Johnson advised that the gelding had found today's track conditions too testing in its race day debut.</p>	
Race 2	ULTIMATE MOTOR GROUP 1200
<p>L Innes was unable to make the weight for MARTINIZ SPECIAL being replaced by S Spratt. L Innes was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.</p> <p>WAINUI PRINCE (L McGregor) was inconvenienced leaving the barriers.</p> <p>B R Jones admitted a breach of careless riding in that near the 1100 metres he permitted his mount OHOPE PRINCE to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of CONRWIN (A Schwerin) which clipped a heel and blundered. Inconvenienced as a result was MR KNOWITALL (V Gatu). After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended Mr Jones' license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, Saturday 8 August, until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 15 August, 4 riding days.</p>	

OHOPE PRINCE got its head up when being steadied going into the bend near the 900 metres and shifted outwards across the heels of **SCHOLES** (B Hutton) taking **SUNBEAM** (A Jones) and **WAINUI PRINCE** over extra ground.
CONRWIN improved into a marginal run to the inside of **SCHOLES** which shifted outwards slightly when being restrained near the 850 metres.
SUNBEAM raced three wide without cover throughout.
MARTINIZ SPECIAL (S Spratt) was inclined to lay out once placed under pressure in the final straight.
OHOPE PRINCE lost the right hind plate during the running.

Race 3	J L MILLS BUILDERS TAURANGA 1200

MAKARIOS (C Grylls) was hampered leaving the barrier.
EMBRACEABLE YOU (S McKay) and **MANAIA ROSE** (L McGregor) both began awkwardly before being crowded by **HE'S GAME** (D Johnson) which lay in leaving the barriers with both runners losing ground as a result.
BACHATA (M McNab) raced keenly when being steadied for a distance passing the 900 metres.
The respective riders of **HE'S GAME** and **OFFSPRING** (J Oliver) were both unable to offer any excuses for their mounts poor performance other than failing to handle today's very testing track conditions. Post-race veterinary examinations of both runners did not reveal any abnormality.
HE'S GAME lost the right front and right hind plates during the running.

RAISAFUASHO (U Holmquist) began very awkwardly losing ground.
BAHHTON (D Johnson) was slow to begin.
Apprentice U Holmquist reported that **RAISAFUASHO** had felt a little indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 5	CRONIN CULLEN EGAN 2100

ON PAROLE (A Jones), **DOUCETTE** (B Hutton) and **SILVER MINX** (D Johnson) were all crowded leaving the barriers.
FAIR FLEET (V Gatu), **ST D'ORE** (C Grylls) and **DARTING** (J Oliver) were all slow to begin.
BOOTYFUL (M Cameron) raced wide without cover.

Race 6	CROCKFORD REAL ESTATE 1400

PAN DULCE (S McKay) and **GUEVARA** (M Coleman) were crowded leaving the barrier.
QUEENS ROSE (V Colgan) began awkwardly inconveniencing **JOHN GRAY** (M Cameron).
QUEENS ROSE was inclined to shift in under pressure passing the 100 metres making brief contact with **JOHN GRAY**.

Race 7	LASER PLUMBING TE PUKE 1600

WERIO (J Oliver) began awkwardly making contact with **PRIZE LAD** (B Hutton) then shifting outwards making contact with **FAST CATCH** (S Spratt).
FAST CATCH had a tendency to shift outwards under pressure in the final straight.

Race 8	AZTECH SIGNS TAURANGA 1600

GO GO GONZO (C Grylls), **LAMASON** (M McNab) and **HEEZA DREIMER** (A Jones) were all slow to begin.
VEGAS NIGHT (S McKay) and **WAJIMA** (B R Jones) were crowded shortly after the start when **ZAH CHAMP** (M Cameron) lay out away from **NIGHEAN** (U Holmquist).
ZAH CHAMP had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **NIGHEAN** near the 1200 metres.
LAMASON over-raced when being restrained near the 1200 metres.
NIGHEAN ducked outwards abruptly when struck with the whip entering the final straight near the 350 metres inconveniencing **CANCELLARA** (V Colgan). **NIGHEAN** continued to race greenly for the remainder of the straight being inclined to shift ground under pressure.
When questioned regarding the performance of **ZANOTTI** rider D Johnson advised that in her opinion the mare had been feeling the effects of recent racing following a couple of tough runs on heavy footing and would benefit from being freshened.
