RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MAINSTAY BRYDONE HOTEL MAIDEN 2200M

SHE'S RIVETING began awkwardly and got back.

MASTERZED raced keenly in the early stages.

HIGH COMMISSIONER improved forward from the 800 metres.

SHE'S RIVETING was held up passing the 400 metres and shifted wider near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

Trainer J Parsons admitted a breach of rule 404(2) in that he presented the wrong horse to race, after hearing all submissions the JCA imposed a fine of \$600.

Race 2 NORTHSIDE MOTEL'S RESTAURANT & BAR RATING 65

MAEVE DEVONE began awkwardly.

SWISS ALPS and **MAEVE DEVONE** raced keenly in the early stages.

KEEP THE LOT became awkwardly placed on the heels of **SWISS ALPS** at the 1500 metres and had to steady.

SWISS ALPS lay outwards from the 1400 metres.

KEEP THE LOT (K Mudhoo) shifted outwards passing the 350 metres making contact with the tiring **SWISS ALPS** which was in turn dictated onto **SLICK NICKEL** which was unbalanced momentarily. Rider K Mudhoo was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

Passing the 200 metres **KEEP THE LOT** shifted inwards and had to be straightened.

RUBY TUESDAY shifted ground outwards near the 175 metres to obtain clear running.

When spoken to about the improved performance of **SHE'S PAYBACK** trainer C Spittles advised the Stewards that at its previous start when in blinkers the mare had raced keenly and uncharacteristically in the lead, adding the mare had derived benefit from that race being fresh up from a month's let up.

Race 3 COLIN WEDERELL & JOHN ROLFE MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1600M

PERFECT SECRET was slow to begin.

CAFÉ NOIR raced wide throughout.

TOMMYRA was held up passing the 600 metres after becoming awkwardly placed on heels and had to shift ground outwards near the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

ROYAL CHANCE was held up momentarily passing the 450 metre mark.

ZAH KEISHA shifted in near the 400 metres and placed **MY PLAN** in restricted room momentarily.

TYCOON CLASS became awkwardly placed on the heels of ZAH KEISHA passing the 350 metres.

PERFECT SECRET which was attempting a marginal run near the 350 metres made firm contact with **TOMMYRA** which shifted inwards.

MY PLAN was held up in the early stages of the home straight.

FULL OF EXCUSES lost its right front plate during the running.

Race 4 GARDEN FRESH OAMARU MAIDEN 1400M

EMERGENCY CALL, WHATWASTHAT, OH SO SMART were all slow to begin.

HIGH IN DEMAND was restrained to the rear after jumping.

Passing the 900 metres OH SO SMART got its head up when being restrained off heels.

Near the 600 metres **EMERGENCY CALL** had to be restrained for a short distance when awkwardly placed on the heels of **REQUEST**.

OH SO SMART made the bend near the 400 metres awkwardly shifting across the heels of **EMERGENCY CALL** having to be straightened.

HIGH IN DEMAND lay outwards rounding the final bend and shifted away from inside runners.

HIGH IN DEMAND hung outwards in the home straight.

Rider L Callaway (**HIGH IN DEMAND**) reported that the gelding had raced greenly throughout and in his opinion would take benefit from today's outing.

Race 5 OAMARU SCAFFOLDING MAIDEN 1200M

The start was delayed after **WEELYWONG** proved difficult to load. The connections were advised that a barrier manners warning was placed against the gelding's record.

STACEY and **COOLIN ROO** both began awkwardly.

MOONLIGHT DANCER raced ungenerously in the early stages and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

LADYBIRD raced wide throughout.

COOLIN ROO made the bend awkwardly near the 700 metres having to be steadied away from heels.

Rider K Mudhoo (**TOMM JONES**) admitted a breach of Rule 638(2) in that he made a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post, after hearing all submissions the JCA imposed a fine of \$100.

Apprentice rider B Murray weighed in in excess of the available allowance and was charged pursuant to Rule 648(5). After hearing all relevant submissions the JCA imposed a suspension of one day up to and including 21 August 2015.

Race 6 OAMARU LIQUORLAND RATING 65 1200M

K Mudhoo replaced rider B Murray as the rider of GILD THE LILY.

Rider B Murray was issued a minor infringement under 330 (3)(c) in that he failed to make the contract weight and was fined a sum of \$100.

There was a delay to the start of this race due to the late weighing out of K Mudhoo.

Several runners proved difficult to load.

Shortly after the start **GOODTAGO** shifted inwards despite the efforts of its rider resulting in **MACAN** contacting a heel and blundering. **MACAN** got back as a result.

Shortly thereafter **WILMA RUDOLF** was steadied away from the heels of **GOODTOGO** and shifted outwards resulting in **FLOSSY THE CAT** racing ungenerously in the early stages and getting its head up on a number of occasions passing the 1100 metres when being restrained.

ZEINA raced wide throughout.

FLOSSY THE CAT improved wide from the 400 metres.

Passing the 250 metres VITESSE ROSE shifted inwards under pressure and made contact with PERCY POSSUM.

VITESSE ROSE was placed in restricted room near the 150 metres and had to steady for a short distance when contacted by **PERCY POSSUM** which had lay outwards.

PERCY POSSUM was held up momentarily passing the 100 metre mark when laying outwards.

Rider J Lowry reported to the Stewards that PERCY POSSUM had raced greenly throughout.

When spoken to about the improved performance of the winner **AGNUS BROWN** trainer J Hillis reported that the mare had benefited from its first up run and the removal of the tongue tie.
