## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>Pakuranga Hunt Landowners Maiden Hurdle</b>
<p><b>VITALI</b> (R Cole) ran the first fence down hampering <b>ZAH OFF</b> (I Lupton) which had to be steadied losing ground.</p> <p><b>GINGERBREAD MAN</b> (M Gillies) put in a poor jump at the first fence.</p> <p><b>PIONEER</b> (M Cropp), <b>LUCKY CHARM</b> (E Farr) and <b>ZAH OFF</b> jumped the second fence poorly.</p> <p><b>CLOEMMBAI</b> hit the third fence hard and stumbled on landing dislodging Rider M Mitchell with both horse and rider uninjured. Hampered as a result was <b>PIONEER</b>. Also inconvenienced were <b>SCIMITAR LAD</b> (L Kennedy) and <b>HIGH DISDAIN</b> (N Quinn).</p> <p><b>GINGERBREAD MAN</b> had to be steadied passing the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>VITALI</b> which shifted in.</p> <p><b>ALL ZEDIN DONE</b> (A Kuru), <b>GINGERBREAD MAN</b> and <b>PIONEER</b> all jumped the fence near the 1000 metres poorly with</p>	

**GINGERBREAD MAN** losing ground as a result.

**ZAH OFF** landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres.

**HIGH DISDAIN** jumped indifferently throughout becoming tailed off and was pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.

**VITALI** was pulled up when well beaten prior to jumping the final two fences.

**NGATIRA GOLD** (R Cully) put in a poor jump at the second to last fence.

**GINGERBREAD MAN** jumped the second to last fence indifferently.

**NANCHO LASS** (C Studd) put in a poor jump at the final fence, landing awkwardly.

**D Miller**, the rider of **CANDIDLY**, admitted a breach under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) for excessive use of the whip and was therefore fined \$400.

**LUCKY CHARM** lost the right hind plate during the running.

**BIG MEADSY** received veterinary attention after showing signs of tying up.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Pakuranga Hunt Supporters Group 2200</b>

**HOUNDSCRY** (C Myers) began awkwardly.

**I'LL'AVA'ALF** (P Conder) began awkwardly crowding **HUFFANPUFF** (S MacNab) which had been slow to begin.

**HENRY TUDOR** (J Reid) began awkwardly.

**SUGGEST GOLD** (T Miles) was slow to begin.

**HUFFANPUFF** made the crossing awkwardly with the rider becoming briefly unbalanced then had to be steadied off heels near the 1400 metres.

Passing the 1400 metres **SECRETARY OF STATE** (L Wheeler) shifted out off the heels of **REGALO REAAL** (S MacNab) taking **HENRY TUDOR** and **SUGGEST GOLD** wider on the track.

Near the 1300 metres **I'LL'AVA'ALF** shifted across heels into the line of **HUFFANPUFF** which had to be steadied.

**TOP CHOICE** (N Jamieson) shifted out under pressure in the final straight.

**S MacNab**, the rider of **REGALO REAAL**, admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) for excessive use of the whip and was therefore fined \$150.

**M Browne**, the rider of **RAISAFUASHO**, admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) for excessive use of the whip and was therefore fined \$200.

**REGALO REAAL** was presented to race in blinkers which were not recorded as part of its notified gear. Trainer Mr S Cameron contacted the Stewards by telephone advising that he had declared blinkers when nominating the gelding for today's race. Enquiries made confirmed that Mr Cameron had declared blinkers to the NRB which appeared to have been omitted by an administrative error with **REGALO REAAL** accordingly being permitted to race in blinkers.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>BGA Marketing Maiden Steeplechase</b>

**NELLS BELLE** (L Kennedy) dipped on landing after jumping the first fence.

**STAGEHAND** (S Phelan) put in a poor jump at the third fence on the first occasion.

**YARDSTICK** (R Eynon) jumped indifferently throughout.

**YARDSTICK** stumbled badly after jumping the first fence on top of the hill on the second occasion.

S Phelan, the rider of **STAGEHAND** momentarily lost the use of his right hand stirrup iron passing the 400 metres.

**STAGEHAND** and **NELLS BELLE** both fell at the final fence with **NELLS BELLE** and both riders being uninjured. **STAGEHAND** suffered minor lacerations to both nostrils.

**YARDSTICK** lost the off front plate during the running.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>The Tractor Centre Open Hurdle</b>

**KINGS DEEP** (R Cully), **MONI NUI** (S Phelan), **JUST GOT HOME** (A Kuru), **READY EDDIE** (M Gillies) and **PRESTIGIOSA** (I Lupton) were all slow to begin.

**MASTER MICHAEL** (M Gibbs-Manssen) and **THENAMESBOND** (C Studd) put in poor jumps at the second fence with the saddle on **THENAMESBOND** commencing to shift forward. After jumping the fence near the 700 metres **THENAMESBOND** was then retired from the race as C Studd was in difficulty.

**LUCKY TONIGHT** (M Mitchell) hit the fence near the 1200 metres on the second occasion.

**BOY** (R Cole) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1200 metres on the second occasion losing ground.

**BOY** misjudged the fence approaching the 1000 metres.

**READY EDDIE** hit the fence near the 1000 metres.

**MONI NUI** was pulled up prior to jumping the third to last fence when well back.

**WEST END** (E Farr) hit the third to last fence hard.

**PRESTIGIOSA** landed awkwardly after jumping the second to last fence.

**MAGNA CARTA** (R Eynon) put in a poor jump at the second to last fence shifting out inconveniencing **LUCKY TONIGHT**.

**BOY** misjudged the final fence and fell dislodging the rider with both horse and rider being uninjured. **BACK IN BLACK** (T Ryan) was hampered by the fallen rider.

**MAGNA CARTA** and **KINGS DEEP** both hit the final fence.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>Veterinary Associates Equine 2200</b>

**THE JUNGLE BOY** was presented to race without its notified gear of blinkers. Trainer Mr S Clotworthy was issued with a

warning.

**THE JUNGLE BOY** (O Bosson) began awkwardly and then was crowded having to steady.

**BAHHTON** (A Collett) began awkwardly losing ground.

When questioned regarding the performance of **PERMESSO** Rider B Hutton advised that the mare had not helped its chances by racing keenly and had then been unable to quicken in today's very testing holding track conditions, adding that in his opinion it would prefer more rain affected looser conditions.

A post race veterinary examination of **SECONDS OUT** which was a beaten runner entering the final straight revealed no abnormalities.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>Pakuranga Hunt Cup</b>

**WAITOKI AHI** (A Tata) landed awkwardly when jumping the first and second fences.

**OLD REDFEATHER** (T Ryan) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1400 metres on the first occasion.

**JACK ROMANOV** (R Cully) and **GO JIMMY GO** (M Cropp) both put in a poor jump at the second fence on top of the hill on the first occasion.

**GO JIMMY GO** put in a poor jump at the first of the double.

**CARINYA** (C Studd) put in a bad jump at the first of the double and landed awkwardly losing ground and then continued to jump indifferently becoming tailed off and was pulled up prior to jumping the final fence. A post race veterinary examination of **CARINYA** did not reveal any abnormalities.

**GO JIMMY GO** was under pressure passing the 1600 metres on the second occasion and was pulled up passing the 1200 metres.

**BRUSHMAN** (M Mitchell) put in a poor jump at the second to last fence when well back.

**BIG BROWNIE** (S Phelan) ran down the final fence making solid contact with **TOBOUGGIE NIGHTS** (R Eynon) with Rider S Phelan losing the use of both his stirrup irons.

When questioned regarding the performance of **GO JIMMY GO** Rider M Cropp advised that the gelding had found today's conditions too testing at this stage of its preparation.

**AMANOOD LAD** lost the left hind plate during the running.

**SNODROPTWINKLETOES** lost the near hind plate during the running.

**GO JIMMY GO** lost the off front plate during the running.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>TDM Construction 1200</b>

The start of this race was delayed approximately 6 minutes due to **CELEBRITY MISS** requiring farrier attention.

**GESEMI** (A Collett) and **RAFA** (Z Moki) both began awkwardly losing ground.

Approaching the 1500 metres when linking on to the Course Proper **JOEY JONZ** (G Cooksley) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **JOHN GRAY** (S Collett) which shifted in with **JOEY JONZ** having to steady. **JOEY JONZ** then raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

**JOEY JONZ** had to steady losing ground when racing in restricted room near the 1200 metres. **JOEY JONZ** then continued to over-race for a short distance.

When questioned into the performance of the favourite **GESEMI** Rider A Collett felt the mare after having a brief let-up prior to a trial at Eastern Bay of Plenty may have felt the effects of a fresh up run on a heavy track may have contributed to the mares performance but was unable to offer any other reason.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>Sir Patrick Eisdell Moore Memorial</b>

**NOTHING** (L Innes) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**MR DOOLE** (B Hutton) had to steady when racing in restricted room between **FAST CATCH** (S Spratt) and **NIGHEAN** (T Thornton) near the 1100 meters.

**ARZAK** (O Bosson) lay out under pressure in the final straight.

**NIGHEAN** and **MR DOOLE** came together over the concluding stages when both runners shifted ground.

**RIOT ACT** (G Cooksley) and **BLACKJACK MAN** (S Collett) which were not persevered with in the final straight underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.
