RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ITM PINK BATTS S.C. MAIDEN

LADY OF LEID was slow to begin.

PERFECTLY ENCHANTED began awkwardly losing ground.

LADY OF LEID raced wide without cover for the final 1200 metres.

NITRO TED lay in when placed under pressure passing the 200 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **THE SECRET'S OUT** rider D Johnson stated that the mare failed to handle todays track conditions and in her opinion was feeling the effects of recent racing. A post race veterinary examination of the mare did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 2 ITM MAKITA RATING 75

IT'S A WONDER was slow to begin.

ANOTHERCHANCETAKEN was slow to begin and was further hampered when **STORM HOME** shifted out slightly, shortly after the start.

ANOTHERCHANCETAKEN commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres with **GREY GURU** becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels for a distance having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

GREY GURU was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of ME AROHA passing the 350 metres.

IT'S A WONDER was steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 150 metres when THE GRADUATE shifted ground

outwards to obtain clear running.

When questioned into the performance of **WAJIMA,** R Jones advised Stewards that the gelding failed to handle todays track conditions.

Race 3 ITM DRICON RATING 65

RIVERHEAD was slow to begin.

TALK THE TORQUE began awkwardly losing several lengths (4).

NOM DU BEEL when over racing in the run towards the 800 metre turn shifted in to avoid the heels of **DENTELLE** and in doing so shifted into the line of **OFFANGONE** which had to be steadied and went back on to **SILVER COURT** which improved on to that runners heels and momentarily blundered.

MR INK over raced rounding the turn and was unable to improve until shifting ground inwards near 150 metres to obtain clear running.

D MO (SILVER COURT) lost his whip near the 250 metres.

TALK THE TORQUE improved on to the heels of **DENTELLE** near the 300 metres.

When questioned into the run of **OFFANGONE** rider M McNab stated that after being galloped on near the 800 metres he considered something may be amiss and did not persevere with the mare in the home straight. A subsequent inspection confirmed superficial lacerations to both hind legs and that **OFFANGONE** had lost the right hind plate during the running.

Race 4 ITM NELSON PINE INDUSTRIES RATING 75

ACQUISTO began awkwardly shifting in making firm contact with **BATMAN** with rider L Hemi (ACQUISTO) momentarily becoming unbalanced.

GYPSY FAIR after being fractious in the barrier began awkwardly losing ground.

PERCY raced three wide without cover throughout.

A TAD LEICA was held up rounding the final bend and early part of the final straight.

L Allpress (BATMAN) advised Stewards the gelding was inclined to lay out for the majority of the race.

Race 5 ITM PSP CLEARVUE RATING 65

ROSAMOSA began awkwardly and was slow away.

ITSALRIGHT shifted out abruptly at the start and bumped with LAMASON

ONEFORTHEDITCH was slow away.

LUMIERE BLUE over raced in the run along the back straight and had to be steadied for some distance.

ITSALRIGHT over raced in the back straight so was taken wide to avoid heels.

RAISEDINASANDPIT raced three wide throughout.

LAMASON had to be steadied for several strides approaching the home bend when in restricted room.

Race 6 ITM NEW PLYMOUTH BUILDING SUPPLIES INTERPROVINCIAL R85

VINCENT STREET was slow to begin.

WERIO shifted out on jumping away forcing SPOKE TO CARLO out on to RED KING which was crowded losing ground.

KINDALEICA raced wide without cover throughout.

VINCENT STREET had to be steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 500 metres.

SPOKE TO CARLO shifted out when placed under pressure over the final 200 metres.

KEMOSABI returned to the enclosure with blood present in its left nostril. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a nasal blood vessel rupture so was not classified as a bleeder

Race 7 ITM WINSTONE WALLBOARDS SC MAIDEN

Shortly after the start when over racing **DE GAULLE** shifted out hampering **BRECON BEAU**.

WILL FERRET raced keenly early and had to steady off the heels of UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT near the 1000 metres. Passing the 800 metres WILL FERRET was angled out abruptly into clear running dictating DELUXE EDITION over extra

ground. A short distance further **WILL FERRET** had to be steadied when racing in restricted room to the inside of **DELUXE EDITION** and **THE GIN KEEPER** which was hanging out. **WILL FERRET** was further bumped on the 350 metre corner when **DELUXE EDITION** made the bend awkwardly.

Prior to the authorisation of dividends a protest was lodged by the connections of 2nd placed horse **TRICKLE DOWN** (L Hemi), 4th place horse **FORTUNE KEPT** (R Jones), 5th placed **WILL FERRET** (D Johnson) against 1st placed horse **THE GIN KEEPER** (S McKay) After deliberations the protests were upheld and now read 2,12,10,3,5,6.

S McKay the rider of **THE GIN KEEPER** subsequently admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift out in the final straight when insufficiently clear of **HOTSHOT LASS, WILL FERRET**, **DELUXE**

EDITION and **FORTUNE KEPT** which were all crowded losing ground. TRICKLE DOWN (L Hemi) was held up near the 150m then was forced wide over extra ground when improving to the outside of FORTUNE KEPT. The Judicial Committee suspended Mr McKay's licence to ride in races from close of racing on 29/8/15 up to and including 5/9/15 (5 days).
