## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>MARKS EWEN &amp; ASSOCIATES 2000</b>
<p><b>MINTED BLACK</b> (A Jones) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>JUSTIFIED</b> (S Spratt) began awkwardly, and then was inconvenienced shortly after.</p> <p><b>MINTED BLACK</b> raced wide around the first bend when being allowed to improve forward to lead approaching the 1100 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 800 metres <b>KIMS MESSAGE</b> (S McKay) lay in becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>COPPER QUEEN</b> (D Johnson).</p> <p><b>BORNINASANDPIT</b> (C Grylls) was held up passing the 500 metres for a distance.</p> <p><b>MINTED BLACK</b> raced in restricted room briefly passing the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>PIEOMIE</b> (M McNab) and <b>COPPER QUEEN</b> came together just prior to the winning post.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>16TH DECEMBER TWILIGHT CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES 1600</b>
<p><b>MATANGI BOY</b> (U Holmquist) shifted out leaving the barrier crowding <b>HOLLY ROSE</b> (Z Moki) and <b>ELFEE</b> (D Johnson).</p> <p><b>IT'S SLOTS OF FUN</b> (B R Jones) began awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of <b>SHANE O'</b> (P Holmes) which shifted out slightly with <b>IT'S SLOTS OF FUN</b> losing ground.</p> <p><b>MARTINI LASS</b> (M Cameron) was inclined to lay in rounding the bend and throughout the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performances of <b>TOP DRIVE</b> rider L Allpress advised Stewards that the gelding had failed to handle today's very testing track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a delayed recovery rate and the gelding to be suffering from mild respiratory distress.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>PROISIR @ RICH HILL STUD 1200</b>
<p><b>KEEPISH</b> (B Hutton) reared as the start was effected and lost considerable ground as a result. Trainer Ms N Young was advised that a warning would be placed against the barrier manners of <b>KEEPISH</b>.</p> <p><b>GOOD VIBES</b> (A Collett) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>EL NINO</b> (T Thornton) and <b>LADY QUASAR</b> (A Jones) were both crowded between <b>ONLY IF</b> (S Collett) and <b>CIVIC RECEPTION</b> (D Johnson) leaving the barrier.</p>	

<b>PEACH BELLINI</b> (S Spratt) shifted out under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing <b>ONLY IF</b> (S Collett) approaching the 200 metres. <b>ONLY IF</b> then shifted in slightly under pressure over the final 100 metres.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>PERTAB BLOODSTOCK LTD 1200</b>
<p><b>JUST CALL ME RIO</b> (T Thornton) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>WARNER</b> (C Grylls) was slow to begin.</p> <p>Shortly after the start <b>UJUMPIJUMP</b> (L Innes) knuckled.</p> <p><b>ROUGH CUT</b> (A Jones) and <b>WINTIME</b> (M Hills) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>UJUMPIJUMP</b> was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>KILMAC</b> (S Spratt) passing the 800 metres with <b>UJUMPIJUMP</b> going back on to <b>WINTIME</b> which was hampered.</p> <p><b>MARGIN CALL</b> (D Johnson) raced in restricted room becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of <b>JUST CALL ME RIO</b> approaching the 700 metres having to steady going back on to <b>WARNER</b> which was then held up for a distance.</p> <p><b>UJUMPIJUMP</b> lay out entering the final straight crowding <b>WARNER</b> outwards making contact with the hind quarters of <b>JUST CALL ME RIO</b> which was momentarily unbalanced.</p> <p><b>UJUMPIJUMP</b> and <b>WARNER</b> came together passing the 200 metres when both runners shifted ground when looking to obtain clear running with <b>UJUMPIJUMP</b> being denied clear running having to steady momentarily before shifting ground inwards passing the 100 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>UJUMPIJUMP</b> improved into a marginal run between <b>KILMAC</b> and <b>HARRY CLAASSEN</b> (V Gatu) making slight contact with <b>HARRY CLAASSEN</b> which then shifted away from <b>UJUMPIJUMP</b> crowding <b>ROUGH CUT</b> (A Jones) which was improving to its inside near the 50 metres.</p> <p>The connections of <b>UJUMPIJUMP</b> viewed the video footage of the run home before electing not to proceed with a protest.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>SEATON PARK 1200</b>
<p><b>WADAPLEASURE</b> (G Cooksley) and <b>GETALONGHOME CINDY</b> (J Whiteside) came together on jumping away.</p> <p><b>KING PANAMERA</b> (M Cameron) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>GARDONE</b> (S McKay) was slow to begin.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>SCAMP</b> rider O Bosson advised the gelding had found today's track conditions too testing in its fresh up state.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>VALACHI DOWNS 1400</b>
<p><b>REAL WINNERS</b> (S McKay) began awkwardly, and then shifted out inconveniencing <b>BLACK IZIAH</b> (U Holmquist) which had been slow to begin.</p> <p><b>MISS DISTINGUISH</b> (L Allpress) raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>JIMMY CHOUX FIRST SEASON FAVOURITE 1400</b>
<p><b>ROCKET QUEEN</b> (C Grylls) and <b>LOTUS LAUD</b> (V Gatu) were both a little slow to begin.</p> <p><b>DON'T LOOK BACK</b> (S Spratt) was inclined to shift inwards under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p><b>HAPPYTO KEEPA</b> (M Cameron) returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. After a veterinary examination <b>HAPPYTO KEEPA</b> was confirmed to be a bleeder and is subject to the mandatory three month stand down from racing in New Zealand with a veterinary certificate of fitness to be provided prior to racing next. The connections advised that the mare is now likely to be retired.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>SHOCKING'S CLASSIC THREE YEAR OLDS 1600</b>
<p><b>OOMPA</b> (L Allpress) began awkwardly, and then was crowded.</p> <p><b>JUD STRUNK</b> (A Schwerin) shifted out leaving the barrier inconveniencing <b>SORORIA</b> (D Johnson).</p> <p><b>GOODN'TARG</b> (L Innes) and <b>LUCKY DESIRE</b> (S Spratt) came together leaving the barrier.</p> <p><b>JUD STRUNK</b> and <b>SORORIA</b> both appeared to dip approaching the 1500 metres.</p> <p><b>JUD STRUNK</b> made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly, and then appeared to go off stride losing ground.</p> <p><b>LUCKY DESIRE</b> was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>PACKING CHAPARRAL</b> rider C Grylls advised Stewards that the gelding had failed to respond when place under pressure, further adding that he may have failed to handle today's existing track conditions.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>PENTIRE'S 12 GROUP 1 WINNERS 2000</b>
<p><b>FAIR FLEET</b> (T Thornton) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>THE SHACKLER</b> (C Lammas) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>GO GO GONZO</b> (M Hills) over-raced for a distance passing the 1600 metres.</p>
