SUPPLEMENTARY:

<p>Canterbury Racing –Saturday, 8th August 2015 <u>Race 10 - LINDAUER PREMIER 2000</u></p> <p>Stewards today concluded an inquiry into Apprentice M Haruki being dislodged from ANDROID near the 1800 metres when evidence was taken from Apprentice Haruki. Stewards found that shortly after leaving the barriers ANDROID, when being ridden forward, became awkwardly placed tight inside the heels of CHOPPER (J Parkes) which in turn was racing in restricted room to the inside of MENDOZA (K Myers). Immediately outside MENDOZA at this point were HASSELL COURT (R Myers) and KEEP THE LOT (G Jogoo). Passing the 1850 metres there was general crowding as a result of the majority of the field repositioning after negotiating the stables crossing and when approaching the turn into the back straight. This resulted in ANDROID being badly crowded between CHOPPER and HOWZAT (R Black), resulting in ANDROID falling.</p> <p>After reviewing all evidence adduced, including viewing the very limited video coverage of the incident, the Stewards could find no one rider at fault. However the Stewards have advised Canterbury Racing and NZTR that the starting limit for this start point will be reviewed.</p>

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SOUTH ISLAND RACING AWARDS 18 SEPTEMBER BENCHMARK 85 (1400m)
<p>SHE'S INSATIABLE began awkwardly and got back. MAYBE MIAMI raced wide throughout. MERCI CHERIE, KINA WIN and ELECTRONIC MOTION raced keenly in the early stages. MAYBE MIAMI raced keenly in the middle stages. MERCI CHERIE was held up in the early stages of the run home.</p>	

Race 2	SPEIGHTS MID ALE BENCHMARK 75 (1200m)
<p>Trainer P McKenzie was issued with a warning for presenting FARCE in incorrect gear. LET'S ESCAPE was buffeted on jumping between FARCE and VIVE LA DIFFERENCE, both of which shifted ground. SOMETHINGS BURNING shifted out on jumping and made firm contact with LA VEUVE. LA VEUVE raced keenly in the early stages. IRONWORKER raced fiercely in the early stages and got its head up, shifting outwards passing the 1000 metres hampering VIVE LA DIFFERENCE which was taken wider on the track. SOMETHINGS BURNING raced keenly in the early and middle stages. VIVA LA DIFFERENCE lay inwards near the 600 metres, with the rider swapping whip hands. VIVA LA DIFFERENCE lay inwards over the concluding stages and hampered IRONWORKER momentarily passing the 100 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner FARCE, rider D Walsh stated that the gelding had battled well over the concluding stages and in his opinion would take benefit from today's race.</p>	
Race 3	FLAIR MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>S Muniandy was stood down from his riding engagements by St John Paramedics after suffering the events of dehydration. S Muniandy was advised that a medical clearance would be required prior to racing next. WHATASTAR was restrained to the rear on jumping. HI YO UGO began awkwardly and got back. SHE'S GALVANISED began awkwardly and shifted inwards abruptly on jumping, checking both POWERBALL and LIFESAHIGHWAY. ACUTE SHOCK, RESET THE TURBO, I AM NOT and DAIFUKU all raced keenly in the early and middle stages. COOLIN ROO raced wide throughout. SHE'S GALVANISED got its head up near the 1000 metres when being restrained. SHE'S GALVANISED was held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres. POWERBALL lay outwards near the 350 metres and hampered SHE'S GALVANISED which had to steady. FORWARNING was hampered in consequence. Passing the 125 metres POWERBALL shifted inwards, hampering ACUTE SHOCK. Rider T Moseley was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. Passing the 100 metres SHE'S GALVANISED shifted in under pressure and made firm contact with I AM NOT. POWERBALL lost the left hind plate during the running. Following this race the track was upgraded to Slow (7) retrospectively.</p>	
Race 4	COASTERS TAVERN OPEN DASH (1000m)
<p>Trainer J Hay was issued with a warning for presenting BOWLING BOY in incorrect gear. HOMELAND was very slow to begin. PACIFIC CHOICE raced wide throughout. BOWLING BOY lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 5	NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK THREE-YEAR-OLD (1000m)
<p>EL BEE DARCI which escaped from its rider en-route to the barriers underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to race. Rider C Barnes was attended to by St John Paramedics and cleared to ride. There was a further delay when DEZZIES DREAM burst through the barriers however was immediately restrained by rider J Lowry. DEZZIES DREAM underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to race. ROC LEONE and VELOCCI were buffeted in the early stages between MARGARITA MOVER and DEZZIES DREAM which both shifted ground. VELOCCI got back as a result. LINDIS PASS shifted inwards and bumped with EL BEE DARCI shortly after the start. ROC LEONE, EL BEE DARCI and MARGARITA MOVER raced keenly in the early stages. VELOCCI raced keenly in the early and middle stages. MARGARITA MOVER hung out in the early stages of the run home and continued to lay out throughout the final straight. ROC LEONE hung inwards and bumped with VELOCCI on the bend near the 500 metres. ROC LEONE continued to hang in under pressure for the remainder of the run home. When questioned regarding the performance of ROC LEONE, rider D Walsh advised that the colt raced greenly throughout. When spoken to regarding the performance of MARGARITA MOVER, apprentice S Wynne reported that the filly which had led in its previous start raced somewhat field shy after getting further back than anticipated. She added she had recommended to the connections a change of gear prior to the next start. LINDIS PASS lost the right hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 6	WELSH & ASSOCIATES RISK INSURANCE SPECIALISTS BENCHMARK 65 (1200m)
<p>KILMARNOCH was crowded in the early stages when FERGIE shifted outwards. TRICOTEUSE shifted out on jumping inconveniencing THE BROWNE KEEPER.</p>	

MANUIA raced keenly in the early stages.

TRICOTEUSE raced wide throughout.

FERGIE was held up in the early stages of the home straight and shifted ground outwards near the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

THE BROWNE KEEPER was not afforded clear running in the early stages of the home straight.

KEVILDO lay outwards throughout the final straight.

METALWORKER lay inwards under pressure in the final stages.

When questioned regarding the run of **TRICOTEUSE**, rider D Walsh advised that the mare had made respiratory noises during the running. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities. The connections advised the mare would undergo a dynamic endoscopic exam prior to racing next and undertook to inform the Stewards of these findings.

Race 7

NZ CUP MEETING TICKETS ON SALE NOW BENCHMARK 75 (1600m)

SLICK NICKEL began awkwardly and shifted out hampering **THE ENERGIZER** and **LORD OF THE STARS**.

IT AINT OVER began awkwardly and shifted out making contact with **MISS MIA**.

SLICK NICKEL raced wide throughout.

SHADOW PLAYER raced keenly in the early stages.

HANDSOME DAX raced keenly in the early stages and had to be steadied near the 1400 metres when racing in tight quarters.

HANDSOME DAX was steadied passing the 700 metres when awkwardly positioned near the heels of **PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE**.

LORD OF THE STARS and **SLICK NICKEL** came together and brushed on a number of occasions in the final straight.

IT AINT OVER underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Apprentice R Black was reminded of her obligations with respect to use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 8

VALE BART CUMMINGS METRIC MILE (1600m)

R Cuneen was fined \$100 under Rule 330(3) (c) for failing to make the contracted weight on **COMANCHE GOLD**.

CORBYN was restrained to the rear on jumping.

MISS THREE STARS was slow to begin.

EVA KEENEVA and **KEEP THE COURAGE** jostled for several strides passing the 500 metres when **EVA KEENEVA** endeavored to shift that gelding wider. **EVA KEENEVA** was then held up for a short distance, shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running. **MISS THREE STARS** was steadied momentarily when **EVA KEENEVA** shifted inwards. Apprentice R Black was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

MISS THREE STARS and **UPPLAND** bumped passing the 50 metres when both horses shifted ground.

When questioned regarding the improved performance of **EVA KEENEVA**, co-trainer P Corbett reported that the gelding had appreciated the drop back in class from which it had raced in its previous two starts and had taken benefit from those runs after a spell.

Race 9

PRYDE'S EASIFEED BENCHMARK 65 (1600m)

CARMEN SANDIEGO and **BRANDY** were slow to begin.

CARMEN SANDIEGO got its head up and raced fiercely in the early stages when being restrained.

WISE MOVE had to be steadied passing the 1400 metres when briefly crowded for racing room by **NAKOMA** which was shifting inwards.

MOONOFKLAIRESSA raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1400 metres.

MAEVE DAVONE (L Callaway) shifted in passing the 1350 metres hampering **EL BEE DEE** and **SECRET POWER**. **SECRET POWER** was buffeted and then over raced for some distance losing its position. Jockey L Callaway was issued with charge pursuant to rule 638 (1) (d) with this matter being adjourned sine-die.

TOETWOTOE raced ungenerously for some distance passing the 1000 metres.

EL BEE DEE raced wide throughout.

NAKOMA was steadied off heels passing the 800 metres.

ADMIRAL ROUS lay out under pressure in the early stages of the run home.

COUP ROTORUA, **CARMEN SANDIEGO** and **TOETWOTOE** all had difficulty obtaining clear racing room in the early stages of the run home.

WISE MOVE shifted in under pressure in the run home.

Apprentice C Barnes was attended to by St Johns after being struck by a clod during the race.
