## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>GRAPHIX EXPLSION MDN HIGHWEIGHT</b>
<p><b>ALTIPLANO</b> raced wide into the first turn.</p> <p><b>HAMILTONIAN</b> over raced in the early and middle stages and had little left at the finish. Rider J Riddell confirmed the observation but added the gelding was also unsuited to the Heavy 11 track.</p> <p><b>LAST TRUMP</b> had to be steadied to avoid the heels of the tiring <b>AND THATZ SCOTTY</b> near the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>JUS TINKIN</b> shifted outwards abruptly under pressure passing the 50 metres mark into the line of <b>ZEDACE</b> which was finishing on resulting in ZEDACE having its momentum impeded.</p> <p>Prior to the authorisation of dividends the connections of 2<sup>nd</sup> placed <b>ZEDACE</b> lodged a protest against <b>JUS TINKIN</b> alleging interference over the concluding stages. After deliberations the Judicial Committee upheld the protest.</p> <p>Trainer G Thomas reported that <b>BORNINASANDPIT</b> got its tongue over the bit during the running which had proved detrimental to its chances. Mr Thomas added that he would be applying a tongue tie to <b>BORNINASANDPIT</b> prior to its next racing.</p> <p><b>Jockey N Quin</b> (LAST TRUMP) was spoken to with regard to his use of the whip on a horse out of contention.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>SEATON PARK MDN</b>
<p><b>LONDONDERRY AIR</b> began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p><b>WILDCARD</b> was inclined to lay out rounding the first turn when over racing.</p> <p><b>HOTSHOT LASS</b> was held up rounding the turn and was taken wider near the 200 metres in an attempt to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>ILY LILY</b> was held up on the heels of <b>WILDCARD</b> passing the 200 metres so was taken inwards near the 150 metres to</p>	

improve.

**MR ENTHUSIASTIC** was inconvenienced near 100 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of **CRAFTY CRIM**.

When questioned regarding the run of **WILDCARD**, rider K Myers reported the gelding was unsuited to the deep nature of today's track.

**Race 3** | **GIANT STEPS @ LINWOOD PARK R85**

**CATWOMANDU** jumped out at the start hampering **AWESOME GOAL**.

**Race 4** | **STELLA ARTOIS MDN**

**KEEPISH** dislodged rider apprentice M Dravitzki en route to the barriers however was quickly recaptured and passed fit to start.

**KEEPISH** began awkwardly and was then slow over the early stages.

**THIRD TIME LUCKY** raced wide throughout and was denied a run near the 400 metres when there was insufficient room to improve. A short distance further **THIRD TIME LUCKY** was again denied clear racing room only gaining clear running near the 200 metres.

**Race 5** | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE R65**

**SKYCHI** was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers and got back.

**BROWN GIRL** raced three wide without cover throughout.

**BROWN GIRL** and **UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT** came together and brushed near the 200 metres. **BROWN GIRL** then lay in under pressure and near the 100 metres shifted in bumping with **UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT** with both runners being momentarily unbalanced. Apprentice D Mo was advised that he must straighten his mounts when they commence to shift ground, sooner than he did on this occasion.

**Race 6** | **ECHOES OF HEAVEN @ LINWOOD PARK MDN**

**ROCFIVE** jumped in at the start hampering **HARD TO BE HUMBLE** which lost ground.

**ONE OF THREE** hung out after making the crossing near the 1500 metres having to be firmly restrained away from the heels of **MISSY BA BA**, resulting in **ONE OF THREE** losing ground.

**MISS DISTINGUISH** raced wide without cover throughout.

Co-trainer C Bothwell reported that **GORDY'S GESTURE** was showing signs of soreness on cooling down and undertook to report the gelding's progress.

When questioned into the run of **MISS DISTINGUISH** jockey L Allpress stated that while her mount was not entirely suited to the Heavy 11 track conditions, the mare was nevertheless disappointing.

**Race 7** | **EKRAAR @ LINWOOD PARK R65 1800**

**DANCE IN THE PARK** and **CISKAY** were slow to begin.

**ITSALRIGHT** lay in and away from **DONLEE** entering the first turn, resulting in crowding to **MAN VERSUS WILD** for a short distance.

**POWER TRIP** raced wide rounding the first turn.

**DANCE IN THE PARK** raced wide from the 1000 metres.

**LAUTARO** over raced in the middle stages.

**TIME BOMB** raced greenly and lay in under pressure over the final stages.

L Allpress reported that **MAN VERSUS WILD** had been unsuited to the holding nature of today's track.
