RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	FARMLANDS CO OPERATIVE HURDLES
<p>KINGS KITE (G Walsh) ran down the first fence making contact with NANCHO LASS (C Studd) when landing and forcing that runner wider on the track. Hampered as a result was WAIKIRIKIRI (L Kennedy).</p> <p>YARDSTICK (I Lupton) and ALL ZEDIN DONE (A Kuru) were crowded after jumping the first fence.</p> <p>KINGS KITE ran down the second fence badly hampering NANCHO LASS. YARDSTICK which was following was hampered as a result. KINGS KITE continued to run its fences down.</p> <p>NGATIRA GOLD (M Mitchell) and SACRED FLYER (M Gillies) both raced ungenerously passing the 800 metres when making the bend.</p> <p>BEVERLEY BECK (M Gibbs-Manssen) raced wide without cover in the early stages.</p> <p>KINGS KITE ran down the fourth fence and fell dislodging rider G Walsh badly hampering LUCKY CHARM (E Farr). YARDSTICK which was following was unable to avoid the fallen runner and fell dislodging rider I Lupton. Both horses and riders were uninjured.</p>	

SACRED FLYER landed awkwardly after jumping the fourth fence.

BEVERLEY BECK misjudged the fifth fence landing awkwardly with the rider losing the use of his stirrup iron, and was then not persevered with for the remainder of the race.

NGATIRA GOLD hit the fence near the 1200 metres on the second occasion landing awkwardly. **SACRED FLYER** also jumped that same fence poorly.

SCIMITAR LAD (R Cole) put in a poor jump at the third to last fence when well back, and was pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.

SACRED FLYER hit the second to last fence hard and blundered on landing dislodging rider M Gillies – both horse and rider were uninjured.

ALL ZEDIN DONE put in a poor jump at the final fence.

Race 2

TEAM WEALLEANS HURDLES

KRASE (I Lupton) lost momentum going into the first fence.

SIR AL SYD (D Miller) ran down the second fence hampering **ARAKI** (R Cole) which was forced wider on the track.

SINISTA (M Gibbs-Manssen) and **I'VE GOT THIS** (M Gillies) misjudged the fourth fence with **I'VE GOT THIS** then misjudging the fifth fence landing awkwardly.

SINISTA put in a poor jump at the sixth fence.

KRASE jumped the eighth fence poorly.

I'VE GOT THIS landed awkwardly after jumping the twelfth fence.

KRASE and **I'VE GOT THIS** jumped the third to last fence poorly.

I'VE GOT THIS landed awkwardly after jumping the final fence.

Race 3

SWEENEY TOWNSEND INSURANCE BROKERS ROTORUA & BAY OF PLENTY HUNT CUP

PRESTIGIOSA (L Kennedy) and **SIR MANAWA** (M Gillies) were both slow to begin.

PRESTIGIOSA jumped the first fence poorly.

D'LLARO (A Kuru) misjudged the second and sixth fences.

SIR MANAWA misjudged the sixth fence.

PRESTIGIOSA landed awkwardly when jumping the ninth fence.

D'LLARO jumped indifferently throughout.

THENAMEBOND (M Mitchell) hit the second to last fence landing awkwardly.

D'LLARO hit the second last fence landing awkwardly making heavy contact with the running rail.

PRESTIGIOSA misjudged the final fence and fell dislodging rider L Kennedy. **PRESTIGIOSA** after being attended to by the veterinarian was humanely euthanased. L Kennedy was transferred to hospital for further evaluation.

BOY (R Cole) which had become tailed off was pulled up passing the 600 metres.

D'LLARO lost the off front plate during the running.

Race 4

TW MOORE LTD HIGHWEIGHT

STAGEHAND (A Kuru) was slow to begin.

IT'S A WONDER (M Mitchell) was slow to begin, and then was hampered by **I'LL'AVA'ALF** (D Miller) which shifted out becoming unbalanced.

IT'S A WONDER raced wide in the early stages.

CRKEY CRON (M Gillies) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

Passing the 1000 metres **STAGEHAND** shifted out crowding **MAGNA CARTA** (C Studd) which then raced in restricted room for a distance to the inside of **BUSINESSMAN** (H McNeill) which was then taken in by **JUST ISHI** (G Walsh) which was laying in entering the bend. **IT'S A WONDER** then lay out causing further crowding to **STAGEHAND**, **MAGNA CARTA** and **BUSINESSMAN** which all had to be steadied as a result. After questioning all riders concerned both G Walsh and A Kuru were issued with warnings under Rule 638(1)(d).

Race 5

AONGATETE COOL STORES LTD 1950

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (S McKay) began awkwardly.

WOOD CHOPPER (L Werner) and **MINTED BLACK** (J Oliver) were slow to begin.

HIGH DISDAIN (T Thornton) was a little slow to begin.

EVADIR LA BALA (C Grylls) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

THAT'S HOW IT GOES got its head up when being steadied passing the winning post on the first occasion.

CONTESTANT (R Elliot) lost ground when awkwardly placed for a distance passing the 700 metres.

Passing the 550 metres **EL DISPARO** (S Collett) shifted out off the heels of **ROCK ROSE** (M McNab) taking **EVADIR LA BALA** wider on the track with that runner then becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **HIGH DISDAIN** having to steady and shift outside that runner's heels.

Passing the 300 metres **EL DISPARO** when angling out to obtain clear running made contact with **ROCK ROSE** which had to be steadied.

LUCKY AFFAIR (B Hutton) and **HIGH DISDAIN** were not persevered with over the final 200 metres when well back.

Race 6	BURTON CONSTRUCTION LTD – FLAIR AMATEUR RIDERS SERIES
<p>DUCHESS OF CAMBRIDGE (S J MacNab) began awkwardly, and then raced ungenerously for a distance. SUGGEST GOLD (T Miles) was slow to begin. TWENTYTHIRTYFOUR (S K MacNab) began awkwardly and shifted out losing ground, then over-raced in the early stages. TWENTYTHIRTYFOUR dipped passing the 1500 metres. J Myers the rider of GET FLASH was issued with a warning over his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres. TWENTYTHIRTYFOUR lay in under pressure in the final straight. IMA PERFECT GUY (H Fleming) lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 7	PEARCE FLOORING 1200
<p>GARDONE (S McKay) was slow to begin. MACKLEMORE (L Magorrian) and MANAIA ROSE (C Grylls) raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier. ROCK ROYALTY (B Hutton) over-raced in the early and middle stages. ROCK ROYALTY ducked out approaching the 400 metres.</p>	
Race 8	PATRON'S SPRINT
<p>DUKE OF HEARTS (J Oliver) had to be steadied shortly after jumping away when crowded by FLYING RIO (L Magorrian) which shifted in. SODALICIOUS (S McKay) and MONTEGO BAY (B R Jones) came together on jumping away when both runners shifted ground. SODALICIOUS over-raced in the early and middle stages. Passing the 800 metres GOOD VIBES (A Collett) commenced to over-race, and then lay in crowding ROCK HARMONY (B Hutton) which shifted in making contact with DUKE OF HEARTS with both those runners jostling for several strides. Passing the 500 metres FLYING RIO lay in with THEIA (T Thornton) having to steady when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of FLYING RIO. Approaching the 150 metres EL BAYARDO (M McNab) had to steady when crowded between WOTUONABOUT (R Elliot) and ROCK HARMONY when both those runners shifted ground. PEACH BELLINI (S Spratt) lay out under pressure over the final 100 metres. The connections of the second placed runner MONTEGO BAY wished to view the films as to lodging a protest alleging interference by the winner PEACH BELLINI which shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages, but elected not to proceed.</p>
