RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	G BRISTOL & SONS MAIDEN HURDLE 3000
YARDSTICK slowed up and lost ground at the jump near the 900 metres. LUMIERE BLUE raced keenly throughout. GINGERBREAD MAN lost ground at the fence near the 1,300 metres. YARDSTICK landed very awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 900 metres losing ground and when being corrected shifted in and hampered GINGERBREAD MAN . CISKAY blundered after jumping the second last fence dislodging rider E Farr who was uninjured. JUS TINKIN jumped the last fence awkwardly and lost momentum.	
Race 2	CLASS CARPENTRY RST OPEN HURDLE 3000
HOUNDSCRY was slow to begin. SHARE THE BLAME raced keenly in the lead throughout. HOUNDSCRY raced well back throughout and failed to finish the race off. Rider L Kennedy advised the gelding was better suited to a more rain affected track and despite her urgings was unable to improve its position in the better footing and struggled to keep up.	

SHARE THE BLAME (D Miller) shifted out under pressure over the final stages dictating SAN PEDRO wider on the track. Rider D Miller was shown footage of his ride and advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.	
Race 3	INFUSION CATERING MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE 4100
<p>NELLS BELLE was very slow away, then jumped the first fence poorly.</p> <p>MY MAGICIAN raced wide in the initial stages.</p> <p>HARD SHOT put in a poor jump near the 1,200 metres and at the next fence landed awkwardly when bumping with NELLS BELLE. HARD SHOT put in another bad jump at the fence near the 900 metres when well back and under pressure.</p> <p>HANCOCK (C Studd) was retired near the end of the back straight on the last round when well back and out of contention. Rider C Studd had no excuse.</p> <p>WAI NOT landed awkwardly at the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p>MY MAGICIAN (G Walsh) fell at the last fence which resulted in NELLS BELLE, CRKEY CRON and WAIKIRIKIRI having to take evasive action to avoid it. SORTEMOUT also had to dodge the fallen horse after jumping the last. Both horse and rider were uninjured.</p> <p>L Kennedy (NELLS BELLE) was questioned into her lack of urgency over the initial stages, in particular the run up to the first fence after the open start. L Kennedy advised her riding instructions were not to bustle the mare early as it had a tendency to over-race but agreed with the stewards that she allowed her mount to get further back than intended. Miss Kennedy was advised that she is expected to exercise better judgement in future. Trainer K Myers confirmed the riding instructions given and advised that when hustled, NELLS BELLE had a tendency to over-race and get in close to its fences and as a result, not jump fluently.</p>	
Race 4	JOLT COFFEE HOUSE RST OPEN STEEPLECHASE 4100
<p>CARINYA (C Studd) shifted in near the winning post on the first round when not clear of MCCULLEY which had to be steadied. C Studd was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d).</p> <p>MCCULLEY lost ground at the fence near the 1,200 metres with a round to go.</p> <p>TIZZA SECRET jumped the fence poorly near the 900 metres with a round to go and hampered BIG BROWNIE.</p> <p>When questioned into the disappointing run of BIG BROWNIE (M Gillies) which failed to finish the race and was pulled up near the 1,000 metres, Rider M Gillies considered something amiss. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>C Studd the rider of CARINYA admitted a breach of Rule 638 (1) (d) in that he allowed his mount to shift in after jumping the fence near the 600 metres when not clear of BRUSHMAN and MISTER DEEJAY which were crowded. After deliberations C Studd was fined the sum of \$1,000.</p> <p>CARINYA (C Studd) fell after jumping the second last fence, both horse and rider were uninjured.</p> <p>When questioned into the disappointing run of OLD REDFEATHER Rider M Mitchell was of the opinion the gelding was better suited to the bigger live fences than those experienced today, which was confirmed by trainer D Hollinshead.</p> <p>Jockey N Quinn was issued with a warning after leaving the Jockeys Room without seeking permission from the stewards.</p>	
Race 5	GRANGEWILLIAM STUD MAIDEN 1360
<p>O'REN ISHII began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>WILLYBE shifted out a short distance after the start when racing greenly, tightening BETTER IN TIME and RINGBOLT.</p> <p>WILLYBE shifted inwards when racing greenly at the end of the back straight and bumped with PERFECT HOLIDAY which became unbalanced.</p> <p>TROUP ROAD and RINGBOLT bumped approaching the straight entrance.</p> <p>WILLYBE shifted out under pressure over the final stages and had to be straightened.</p> <p>O'REN ISHII hung outwards in the home straight.</p> <p>BETTER IN TIME failed to keep up and finished some distance last proving uncompetitive. Stewards advised connections that BETTER IN TIME must trial satisfactorily prior to its next start.</p>	
Race 6	J D WORKMAN & CO 3YO 1200
<p>MISSY MOO and MORSE CODE were both slow to begin and settled back.</p> <p>KING OF STING was slow away.</p> <p>WESTERN over-raced in the run along the back straight and had to be steadied for some distance.</p> <p>THE CZAR when being angled for a run near the 400 metres dictated SUPERVELOCE over extra ground.</p> <p>When questioned in to the run of BOOK SMART Rider L Allpress said the filly had difficulty maintaining the steady pace throughout and would improve with experience.</p>	
Race 7	WANGANUI TROTting CLUB MAIDEN 1200
<p>ALY'S BELT shifted out at the start and bumped HUNDYAMONTH which then shifted into the line of MISSTART which lost ground and settled back.</p> <p>JOGO raced four-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>RON'S LAST shifted in under pressure entering the home straight and dictated the line of ALY'S BELT for a short distance.</p> <p>J Riddell, the Rider of HUNDYAMONTH was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground after he allowed his mount to</p>	

shift out when not clear of BARTOLI which had to steady and change ground over the final stages.	
Race 8	WANGANUI GREYHOUND RACING CLUB 1200
<p>KEWZERO was tightened at the start and got back.</p> <p>KEWZERO was further hampered near the end of the back straight when TAYLA MAID shifted outwards.</p> <p>SILVER NANCHO raced wide throughout.</p> <p>EXCUSE ME BAYBEE was denied a run at the top of the home straight when racing in restricted room between LINCOLN STREET and SILVER NANCHO. EXCUSE ME BAYBEE continued to race in restricted room until gaining clear running over the final stages.</p> <p>TAYLA MAID was denied a run near the 350 metres so was angled inwards to improve.</p> <p>ITS A TRU STORY was denied a clear run near the straight entrance.</p>	
Race 9	PALAMOUNTAINS NUTRITION MAIDEN 2060
<p>LADY OF LEID and CARTAGENA were both slow away.</p> <p>ROBBIE KAPOW proved very slow to load. Stewards placed a warning on its barrier manners.</p> <p>LADY OF LEID made the first turn awkwardly and was eased going into the back straight.</p> <p>NED raced very wide throughout.</p> <p>HAVATASTE raced wide without cover throughout.</p>
