## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND SPRING CARNIVAL 2200
<p><b>DUCATI</b> (N Teeluck) shifted in on jumping away crowding <b>ZEDBEE</b> (R Goldsbury) and <b>PENTIME</b> (D Turner) which got back. <b>ZEDACE</b> (L Hemi) jumped out at the start bumping <b>BEAU ZED</b> (C Johnson).</p> <p><b>COOL HAND DUKE</b> (L Magorrian) was crowded near the winning post on the first occasion when on the inside of <b>CYCLONE TRACY</b> (D Johnson).</p> <p><b>ZEDBEE</b> over-raced in the early stages and near the 1700 metres was steadied off the heels of <b>DANCE IN THE PARK</b> (R Hannam) which resulted in <b>BEAU ZED</b> being dictated wider for a short distance.</p> <p><b>PENTIME</b> made the first turn awkwardly and shifted out hampering <b>BEAU ZED</b>.</p> <p>The following horses had to be eased going into the bend near the 1400 metres when the pace ahead steadied, <b>MICHELIN</b> (K Myers), <b>EL BANDIDO</b> (C Grylls), <b>EARL'S COURT</b> (O Bosson) and <b>ZEDACE</b> which had to take evasive action and in doing so shifted into the line of <b>PENTIME</b> which clipped that runners heel and blundered badly, unbalancing rider D Turner.</p> <p><b>BEAU ZED</b> which was in behind also had to take evasive action.</p> <p><b>ZEDBEE</b> raced wide throughout when over-racing.</p> <p><b>EL BANDIDO</b> over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>DANCE IN THE PARK</b> was crowded for a short distance near the 200 metres when between <b>BEAU ZED</b> and <b>EARL'S COURT</b>.</p> <p><b>MICHELIN</b> was held up on the heels of <b>PRIVATE HERO</b> (L Innes) near the 200 metres and shortly after shifted out and bumped with <b>DUCATI</b> which in turn shifted out onto <b>ZEDBEE</b>. Miss Myers explanation that her mount had shifted out over more ground than she had anticipated due to its hanging tendency was accepted by the stewards.</p> <p>On returning to scale O Bosson reported that his mount <b>EARL'S COURT</b> had lost its footing in behind near the 800 metres. After questioning all riders who participated in this race and undertaking an inspection of that area of the track, it was</p>	

unanimously determined that the meeting would continue.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>TRINITY HILL 2000</b>
<p><b>DRAGON BEAUTY</b> (R Goldsbury) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>BIOLOGIST</b> (L Allpress) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>DRAGON BEAUTY</b> was held up for short distance passing the 600 metres before making its finishing run very wide round the final turn.</p> <p><b>GUESS WHAT</b> (L Hemi) lay out under pressure in the final straight and near the 250 metres brushed with <b>BIOLOGIST</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>LIVAMOL OPTIMISER 2000</b>
<p><b>JOCHEN RINDT</b> (S Spratt) shifted in on jumping away crowding <b>TAIPA TIGER</b> (M Coleman) and <b>SKYBIRD</b> (C Johnson) with <b>TAIPA TIGER</b> losing ground as a result.</p> <p><b>SELWYN</b> (R Hannam) over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>CENTRE ATTENTION</b> (D Turner) raced wide in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>FLINT</b>(K Myers) raced keenly throughout</p> <p><b>SELWYN</b> raced wide from the 1200 metres.</p> <p><b>NIGELISSIMA</b> (V Colgan) was held up rounding the final turn and near the 400 metres shifted out to improve which resulted in crowding to <b>SACRED MASTER</b> (L Innes) which was taken out onto the hind quarters of <b>PERFECT MIX</b> (M Hills) which was briefly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>NIGELISSIMA</b> was further held up and near the 250 metres shifted out into the line of <b>SACRED MASTER</b> which was taken out again onto <b>PERFECT MIX</b> making heavy contact with <b>PERFECT MIX</b> being forced wider. Stewards opened and adjourned an investigation into this matter.</p> <p><b>SELWYN</b> was held up over the final 150 metres when racing in restricted room.</p> <p>Rider D Johnson reported that <b>BEE TEE JUNIOR</b> which finished well back was unsuited to the firm conditions.</p> <p><b>TIGER TIM</b> (J Riddell) slipped free of interference losing momentum entering the final straight.</p> <p>A meeting was convened with all riders following this event where concerns were expressed with respect to the shifting nature of the racing surface. After a further meeting with club officials and riders the stewards deemed the racing surface unsafe and abandoned the meeting at 1.54pm.</p>
