RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BAYLEYS 3YO
<p>ST REGIS (L Magorrian) was slow to begin.</p> <p>LOLA JANE (C Lammas) and SUNSET GIRL (S Collett) came together shortly after jumping away.</p> <p>ST REGIS raced keenly having to be steadied passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>LOLA JANE hung out around the final bend.</p> <p>Approaching the 400 metres THE TILBURY (D Johnson) shifted out to obtain a run to the outside of LOLA JANE which lay out taking THE TILBURY out on to AGAVE (M Coleman) which then shifted away taking ARRAIGNMENT (C Grylls) over extra ground. Inconvenienced was SUNSET GIRL.</p> <p>ST REGIS was held up for clear running passing the 200 metres until near the 100 meters due to slight outward movement from LOLA JANE.</p>	
Race 2	WILL JOHNSTON – 9 TO 3 ON THE HITS 1400
<p>CALL ME ROYAL (O Bosson) was slow to begin.</p> <p>ARCADE (S Collett) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with DANICA (U Holmquist) with rider S Collett becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>REMIND ME AGAIN (L McGregor) began awkwardly shifting out wider on the track.</p> <p>ARCADE raced keenly in the early stages when being steadied.</p>	

LA BELLE ETOILE (C Lammas) jumped a shadow on the ground passing the 400 metres.	
Race 3	STELLA ARTOIS TGA STAKES – 14 NOV 1200
<p>MOSSOMAK (O Bosson) underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the start and was declared a late scratching at 1.54 pm on veterinary advice being lame in the left foreleg.</p> <p>HIDDEN TREASURE (M Coleman) and ESBEEDEE (T Thornton) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>THE KEPT MAN (C Grylls) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>ESBEEDEE raced greenly passing the 200 metres and shifted out abruptly when struck with the whip near the 150 metres making contact with HIDDEN TREASURE. Contributing was inward movement from HIDDEN TREASURE. Passing the 50 metres both runners again made contact. The connections of HIDDEN TREASURE the third placed horse lodged an objection against the second placed horse ESBEEDEE. After hearing all relevant evidence and viewing videos the protest was upheld. The final placings now read 12 MIME first, 3 HIDDEN TREASURE second, 10 ESBEEDEE third and 7 MOONS OF JUPITER (V Colgan) fourth.</p>	
Race 4	CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES – 31 OCT TGA 2170
<p>Trainer Mr B McKeagg was issued with a warning for presenting ON PAROLE (C Lammas) without the notified gear (blinkers).</p> <p>ON PAROLE was slow away.</p> <p>FINNS HALO (D Johnson) commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the final straight. When questioned rider D Johnson advised the gelding was making abnormal breathing noises, but was unable to offer any other reason. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 5	INTERISLANDER SUMMER FESTIVAL – 2 JAN TGA 2170
<p>DARTING (A Collett) and THE TALISMAN (C Lammas) were slow to begin.</p> <p>BRAVO SUPREMO (O Bosson) raced keenly in the early stages when being steadied.</p> <p>THE TALISMAN raced wide without cover throughout, and was quickly under pressure passing the 400 metres and not persevered with for the remainder of the race. When questioned, rider C Lammas could offer no tangible excuse for the gelding's performance.</p> <p>BRAVO SUPREMO was not persevered with over the final 300 metres. When questioned, rider O Bosson advised the gelding was making abnormal breathing noises. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 6	GARTSHORE JOINERY 1200
<p>ONLY IF (S Collett) began awkwardly.</p> <p>AMBER RAYNE (T Thornton) over-raced through the early stages, and made the 800 metres bend awkwardly having to shift out off the heels of WINOR ELSA (L McGregor).</p> <p>OUR KING SWAY (S McKay) was held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p>Approaching the 100 metres OUR KING SWAY was briefly crowded when improving into a run between AMBER RAYNE (T Thornton) which lay out and MOCCONA MIST (D Johnson) which lay in, with MOCCONA MIST then shifting out and inconveniencing MANAIA ROSE (C Grylls).</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of ONLY IF rider S Collett advised the filly was unable to quicken near the 400 metres, but could offer no other reason.</p>	
Race 7	GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1600
<p>BACHELOR ZEEL (S Collett) was slow to begin.</p> <p>SORORIA (D Johnson) raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1300 metres.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of ARZAK rider M Cameron advised the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.</p>	
Race 8	GARTSHORE INTERIORS 1600
<p>This race was delayed due to there being people with a dog on the course near the 800 metres.</p> <p>PINZ CHARMING (L McGregor) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Approaching the 350 metres TRIUMPH (L Magorrian) shifted out making contact with PINZ CHARMING.</p> <p>Near the 300 metres EDEN ROSE (T Thornton) shifted out when not clear of PINZ CHARMING which clipped a heel and fell. Both horse and rider were uninjured. T Thornton was charged under Rule 638(1)(d) for careless riding to which she pleaded not guilty. A hearing into the incident was commenced with rider T Thornton seeking an adjournment from the Judicial Control Authority which was granted to a date to be set.</p>
