RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WAITOTARA BULK SUPPLIES 2200
<p>CARTAGENA was slow away.</p> <p>TALLEMOSA raced wide in the initial stages.</p> <p>HIP HOORAY had to be steadied off the heels of BELLE ZED (A Collett) near the 600 metres when BELLE ZED was angled outwards to obtain a run. A Collett was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.</p> <p>QUANTUM MAELSTROM lay in and could not be ridden out to advantage in the home straight.</p> <p>The winner RED THUNDER (L Hemi) shifted in under pressure near the 200 metres hampering the second placed ALTIPLANO which was improving to its inside causing the rider of ALTIPLANO H Tinsley to ease his mount for several strides when the position became marginal. Prior to the authorisation of dividends an objection was lodged by the connections of ALTIPLANO against the winner RED THUNDER alleging interference in the home straight. After a judicial hearing the protest was dismissed. L Hemi was advised that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.</p>	
Race 2	TARANAKI DISTRICT TURF CLUB 2200
<p>SKYBIRD was slow away.</p> <p>IT'S A WONDER over-raced in the early stages so was shifted wide off heels near the post with a round to go.</p> <p>ALINKO PRINCE was held up for a short distance near the 600 metres.</p>	

Following the running of Race 2 the track conditions were downgraded to Slow 7 after consultation with riders.	
Race 3	SUMMIT ELECTRICAL 1200
ROCK OF ACES and SAKURA were slow to begin. WILDCARD raced keenly early. WILDCARD had to be steadied when improving on to the heels of SUO LIN NANG approaching the straight entrance. WILDCARD was held up from passing the 200 metres and could not be ridden out fully over the final stages when in restricted room.	
Race 4	HOOPER ENGINEERING 1200
VERNA AUDREY began awkwardly. PLATINUM MONARCH hampered LOVETHEFEELING on jumping away. ALL IN VOGUE was slow away DEVI had to be restrained near the 800 metres when over-racing. This resulted in SWISS BOUQUET having to be steadied and go back on VERNA AUDREY which had to be restrained off that runner's heels. DEVI was momentarily held up near the 250 metres.	
Race 5	EDMONDS SHEARING 1200
RAM SAM SAM began awkwardly and was slow away. LOVETOKEEPHIM had to be steadied near the 900 metres when DIVA ACHIEVER (L Allpress) shifted in when only marginally clear. L Allpress was advised to exercise care when shifting ground. RAM SAM SAM raced greenly throughout. SARGENT RAHTWO finished some distance last after Rider A Collett did not persevere with the gelding in the home straight. A Collet had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.	
Race 6	MARKHAMS WAVERLEY 1200
HOVER (D Bradley) was fractious in the barrier prior to the start and hit the side of the gate when the start was made and was consequently slow away. D Bradley reported the gelding was unsuited to the rain affected going underfoot today. SILVER NANCHO commenced to over-race in the back straight and had to be steadied off heels for some distance near the 800 metres. MISS BENCI had to be steadied near the 800 metres when in restricted room.	
Race 7	BETAVET PREPARE 2200
DANCE IN THE PARK was slow into stride. HAMILTONIAN over-raced in the early and middle stages. BEAU ZED was posted wide early so was taken forward to sit outside the leader near the 1,400 metres. When questioned into the disappointing run of SHEEZABABE Rider K Myers said the mare struggled in the going throughout.	
Race 8	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1650
MISS ABBOTT was slow away. HI FIVER raced keenly going into the first bend so was taken wide and in doing so hampered CASEY MARIE which had to be steadied sharply off that runner's heels. CASEY MARIE over-raced in the back straight so was angled wide off heels. WAITUNA HEIGHTS raced wide throughout. CHEERS FOR NADIA was held up for some distance rounding the turn. ETERNAL ANGEL when improving near the 400 metres lay inwards into the line of OMA ELLE which was checked. After questioning riders and viewing footage it was not conclusive that any particular rider was at fault. A short distance further on entering the home straight near the 200 metres MARGIN CALL was tightened and dictated inwards tightening ETERNAL ANGEL after WAITUNA HEIGHTS (T Johnson) was angled inwards when not clear. Apprentice Jockey Johnson was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the riding master and issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d). A subsequent veterinary inspection of OMA ELLE which finished some distance last revealed stiffness in the hind quarters and a small abrasion to a hind leg.	
Race 9	MITAVITE 1650
PICCADILLY was slow away. KING SAMBO raced three-wide without cover throughout. THE QUIET MAN shifted in near the 200metres dictating SAVARHYS inwards and when being straightened, over-reacted and bumped with CAVALRY . PIHA finished some distance last. Rider J Riddell advised connections the gelding has a respiratory issue. Connections advised that consideration would be given to retiring PIHA .
