RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 HIREPOOL VEHICLES 1400

OUTSPOKEN (R Myers) was slow to begin.

KING PANAMERA (C Dell) jumped away awkwardly, shifting in abruptly, making contact with **RUSTANA** (B Hutton) which lost ground. Also hampered as a result was **LIQUID ASSET** (U Holmquist).

LIQUID ASSET raced ungenerously in the early stages.

GISELA (L Allpress) was steadied approaching the 900 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels, and then made the bend awkwardly, running wide.

PEACH BELLINI (S Spratt) raced in restricted room approaching the 900 metres to the inside of **BRAKBAR** (L Magorrian) which lay in, with **PEACH BELLINI** losing ground as a result.

ASTRONOMER (Z Nor Azman) ran wide when making the final bend.

PEACH BELLINI had to steady and change ground passing the 300 metres when improving to the inside of **KING PANAMERA** which shifted in. Apprentice rider C Dell was reprimanded by Stewards and advised he must exercise greater care.

Rider C Dell advised stewards that **KING PANAMERA** was making abnormal breathing noises during the running, with the gelding undergoing a veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which could find no abnormality.

Rider B Jones reported that **FORTUNE KEPT**, which had not been persevered with in the final straight, had felt indifferent in its action. **FORTUNE KEPT** underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 2 VALE ZABEEL 1400

DYNAMO (D Johnson) was slow to begin.

JET TRAC (U Holmquist) and BERG EN DAL (S Collett) both jumped away awkwardly.

JET TRAC raced ungenerously when the pace steadied in the early stages.

GRACEHILL (V Colgan) raced in restricted room to the inside of **SEVENTEEN SEVENTY** (S Spratt) which was taken in by **SHEEZ TORKIN** (B Hutton) passing the 1300 metres

NOMISMA (L Innes) raced three wide without cover throughout.

JET TRAC steadied and shifted out when awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 400 metres.

NOMISMA had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the final straight, inconveniencing **INTERSTELLAR** (M Cameron) passing the 200 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **INTERSTELLAR** rider M Cameron advised that the filly had not been comfortable in today's track conditions.

When questioned regarding the performance of **GRACEHILL** rider V Colgan could offer no tangible excuse with **GRACEHILL** undergoing a subsequent veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

SHEEZ TORKIN returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils, and after undergoing a veterinary examination was deemed to have bled, and as such is subject to a three month stand down from racing in New Zealand. **SHEEZ TORKIN** will also require veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

Race 3 HINUERA LODGE 1200

FASCINATE ME (M Coleman) jumped away awkwardly.

HIGH CLASS (B Hutton) was slow to begin.

HES CALLINGCALLING (U Holmquist) raced keenly through the middle stages, making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

DAZZLING LADY (S Spratt) shifted out passing the 400 metres, inconveniencing **JACQUETTA** (R Hutchings) for a distance. Rider S Spratt was advised to exercise greater care.

UNTAMED DIAMOND (A Collett) shifted out under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing **WAWRINKA** (R Elliot) near the 150 metres.

Race 4 HIREPOOL LTD PORTABLES 1600

HIGH SOCIETY (E Smith), NIGHEAN (A Collett) and ZAFRENZY (M Coleman) were all slow to begin.

LUCKY FEATHER (S M McKay) blundered shortly after leaving the barrier, shifting in, inconveniencing **BIG DREAMER** (V Colgan) which lost ground.

EL DUQUE (D Johnson) commenced to over-race passing the 1200 metres shifting out off heels, making contact with **CURSIVE** (S Collett) which became briefly unbalanced. **EL DUQUE** continued to over-race through the middle stages.

WHATZ OCCURRING (L Allpress) shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres, hampering **CURSIVE** which was giving ground. Rider L Allpress was reprimanded and advised a warning would be placed on her record.

When questioned regarding the performance of **MARTINIZ SPECIAL** rider R Hutchings could offer no tangible excuse, with a subsequent veterinary examination failing to find any obvious abnormality.

EL DUQUE underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 5 HIREPOOL ACCESS 1600

R Hutchings was fined \$225.00 by the Judicial Committee for being unable to make the weight for **GIN SWING**, and was replaced by L Allpress.

RETROSPECT (Z Nor Azman) was slow to begin.

SINGLE SHOT (E Smith) shifted out leaving the barrier, inconveniencing **SYLVIAN** (L Innes) and **LAMASON** (M Coleman).

GERRY MERITO (L Magorrian) over-raced in the early stages.

MY ALEGRIA (C Grylls) shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 375 metres, inconveniencing HALONG BAY (T Thornton) which shifted out, inconveniencing WHAKATANE (V Colgan).

LAMASON (M Coleman) shifted out slightly early in the final straight, inconveniencing **SINGLE SHOT** which then lay in onto heels.

When questioned regarding the performance of **WHAKATANE** rider V Colgan could offer no tangible excuse for the gelding's performance.

Race 6 SENSORTRONIC SCALES 2100

CHARLIE PRIDE (M Coleman) was slow to begin.

EL BANDIDO (C Grylls) jumped away awkwardly.

LOTUS LAUD (A Schwerin) shifted in shortly after the start, crowding **MARTINI LASS** (L Allpress) and **EL BANDIDO** which both lost ground. Contributing was outward movement from **IMA PERFECT GUY** (S Spratt) which commenced to lay out.

SILVER MINX (V Colgan) commenced to race fiercely leaving the straight on the first occasion, and when being steadied by its rider, shifted out, inconveniencing **OUR BANDIDO** near the 1600 metres, and then shifting back on to **IMA PERFECT GUY** and **MARTINI LASS** which were both hampered.

EL BANDIDO was steadied passing the 450 metres when awkwardly placed inside heels.

L Innes (**PRIVATE HERO**) was reminded that he must ride his horses out fully to the end of a race when circumstances permit him to do so.

Race 7 HIREPOOL 60 YEARS 1400

Trainer Mr S Marsh was advised that a warning would be placed on his record after he presented **OCEANIA** (D Johnson) to race without notified gear (side winkers).

OCEANIA and **WOLFWHISTLE** (M Cameron) both began awkwardly, losing ground, with **OCEANIA** then being further inconvenienced by **SECRET'S ONLY** (L Magorrian) which shifted out.

OCEANIA over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MADONNA MIA (B R Jones) commenced to over-race passing the 1100 metres shifting in to avoid heels, making contact with **WOLFWHISTLE** which was forced inwards.

MISS FOXWOOD (V Colgan) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the middle stages.

GRAPHIC (C Grylls) was crowded and checked passing the 100 metres between **ROSE OF VIRGINIA** (A Jones) which shifted in when struck with the whip and **SECRET'S ONLY** which shifted out slightly. Apprentices L Magorrian and A Jones were advised to exercise greater care as the movement from both horses was beyond the control of the respective riders.

Apprentice A Schwerin (**SPIN DOCTOR**) was reprimanded and issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 200 metres.

Race 8 HIREPOOL GENERAL HIRE 1200

MR KNOWITALL (A Schwerin) and QUINTASTICS (B B Hong) both began awkwardly.

SHEBANG (S Spratt) was slow to begin.

LIGHT SHADOW (L Innes) was crowded soon after leaving the barrier.

QUINTASTICS raced in restricted room passing the 600 metres.

SANASAR (S Olney) commenced to lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight, inconveniencing **WAINUI PRINCE** (L McGregor) which became awkwardly placed on that runner's heels near the 200 metres, and then shifted in crowding **JACQUI ICKX** (U Holmquist) which had been held up, and improved to the inside of **WAINUI PRINCE**. Apprentice S Olney (**SANASAR**) was reminded that she must ride her mounts out fully to the end of a race when circumstances permit her to do so.

AIRMAN (C Dell) lost the left front plate during the running.

Race 9 TOPSOIL AND SAND SUPPLIES 1200

DENTELLE (S Spratt) shifted out leaving the barriers, hampering **ILIKAI** (T Thornton), **FRANCIS DRAKE** (R Hutchings), **FLYING FANTASY** (L Magorrian) and **TROJAN WARRIOR** (B Hutton) with **FLYING FANTASY** and **FRANCIS DRAKE** losing considerable ground.

WOOSTER (C Grylls) began awkwardly, making contact.

FLAVIGNY (G Cooksley) and MISS ELEGANTE (A Jones) both began awkwardly, losing ground.

TATTERS (M Coleman) was hampered leaving the barrier.

ROCKWEILER raced keenly in the early stages.

WOOSTER commenced to race greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight shifting out abruptly passing the 250 metres making contact with **TATTERS** which became unbalanced.

BOLD BACHELOR (U Holmquist) lost the right front plate during the running.

ROCKWEILER (S Collett) lost the left front plate during the running.
