SUPPLEMENTARY:

Hawke's Bay Saturday 19th September Race 3
Stewards today concluded an investigation where SACRED MASTER (L Innes) was crowded and hampered near the 400 metres. After questioning riders concerned it was established NIGELISSIMA (V Colgan) when improving outward had become unbalanced in the ground and shifted out crowding SACRED MASTER out onto PERFECT MIX (M Hills) which was unbalanced and lost its footing.
Near the 200 metres SACRED MASTER and PERFECT MIX were again hampered when inside NIGELISSIMA which when improving and near the heels of SELWYN (R Hannam) was crowded out by TIGER TIM (J Riddell) which was itself taken out by JIMMY MAC (L Allpress).
Stewards determined no further action was necessary.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	DUNDEEL ALL AGED SALVER
J Parkes replaced R Hutchings on CANTERINO after R Hutchings was delayed in traffic.	
CHAIROS (R Hannam) was slow away and then was obliged to race wide in the early stages.	
When questioned regarding the disappointing run of JACKFROST which gave ground passing the 800 metres finishing a distance last, rider C Johnson reported the gelding had travelled well throughout the running, however when placed under pressure failed to respond and gave ground quickly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed cardiac arrhythmia. Connections were advised that a clearance is required prior to JACKFROST next racing.	

Race 2	HAWKE'S BAY MASTER PLUMBERS 2000
<p>C Grylls replaced R Hutchings on PRIZE LAD due to R Hutchings being ½ kilo over the carded weight.</p> <p>PRIZE LAD (C Grylls) began awkwardly and was slow away.</p> <p>EMPRESS ELECT (T Thornton) over-raced in the early stages and had to be steadied off the heels of TIGER TIM (J Riddell) near the post on the first round.</p> <p>HESALLJAZZ (M Coleman) raced keenly early.</p> <p>SUSSED (R Goldsbury) made the first bend poorly and race wide.</p> <p>CHOP CHOP (D Johnson) had to be steadied sharply off heels on entering the back straight and in doing so shifted out abruptly, hampering PERFECT MIX (M Hills)</p> <p>SARABI (L Allpress) had to be restrained when over-racing early in the back straight.</p> <p>CENTRE ATTENTION (S McKay) raced wide from the 1400 metres.</p> <p>BACK IN BLACK (L Magorrian) raced ungenerously near the 500 metres.</p> <p>SING FOR THE SUN (U Holmquist) was held up momentarily near the 350 metres.</p> <p>PERFECT MIX hung in under pressure near the 300 metres and dictated ROCKY (J Parkes) inwards into the line of the weakening HESALLJAZZ.</p> <p>IMPERIUM (M Cameron) raced greenly over the final 300 metres.</p> <p>When questioned into the disappointing run of PRIZE LAD rider C Grylls reported the gelding was unsuited to the indifferent tempo of the race.</p>	
Race 3	GREAT THINGS GROW HERE 1200
<p>SHEZGORGEIOUS (L Allpress) was slow away.</p> <p>THEE AULD FLOOZIE (D Johnson) and THE KNIGHT'S QUEEN (K Myers) were severely tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground resulting in THEE AULD FLOOZIE settling well back.</p> <p>Shortly after the start MISS APPLETON (S McKay) lay in hampering THE KNIGHT'S QUEEN.</p> <p>DESIGNATED DRIVER (N Teeluck) improved up on the heels of STELLA'S HONOUR (C Grylls) nearing the end of the back straight and when being restrained shifted out abruptly dictating MIGHTY MATT (L Hemi) outwards into the line of THEE AULD FLOOZIE and SHEZGORGEIOUS which were hampered.</p> <p>DESIGNATED DRIVER then continued to race ungenerously for some distance.</p> <p>THE KNIGHT'S QUEEN raced in restricted room for a short distance near the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 4	WINDSOR PARK / HAWKE'S BAY BREEDERS GOLD TRAIL STAKES
<p>NO MORE TEARS (M Coleman) underwent and passed a veterinary inspection prior to the start after rearing when loaded away.</p> <p>IFF SO HAPPENS (C Johnson) was tightened at the start and lost ground.</p> <p>BELLA COURT (K Myers) was tightened at the start and got back.</p> <p>LOVE TRIANGLE (M Cameron) over-raced in the back straight and had to be steadied near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>FREE REIN (T Thornton) raced wide throughout.</p> <p>NAHEMA (R Myers) raced fiercely in the early stages and near the 800 metres had to be restrained off heels for some distance. MARITIMO (J Parkes) had to be momentarily steadied on the point of the turn when attempting a run to the inside of O'DIANNE (S Spratt).</p> <p>SERIOUS SATIRE (D Johnson) and SERENA MISS (L Innes) came together and bumped near the 350 metres.</p> <p>MARITIMO shifted in under pressure over the final stages.</p> <p>Following the running of Race 4 the track conditions were upgraded to a Good 3.</p>	
Race 5	STELLA ARTOIS SPRINT
<p>WATCH THIS SPACE (L Allpress) began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>TWYA (L Magorrian) was tightened at the start and settled back.</p> <p>NYMPH MONTE (R Myers) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed between HOCUS POCUS (N Teeluck) and ALL TORN UP (D Johnson) leaving the back straight near the 900 metres. After questioning riders it was established NYMPH MONTE, despite its riders' efforts, had improved into a marginal run to the inside of ALL TORN UP and had to be steadied to avoid that runners heel.</p> <p>CITY BOY (L Innes) was inclined to get its head up when being restrained off the heels of ZUCCATO (S Spratt) passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>BLAME DE ANGELS (S McKay) was held up rounding the turn and near the 200 metres shifted in to improve simultaneously as HOCUS POCUS was attempting a run adjacent to the rail, this resulting in HOCUS POCUS having to be steadied losing momentum.</p> <p>NYMPH MONTE shifted out and away from AL PACINO (J Parkes) near the 50 metres and bumped TWYA.</p> <p>DONNA BEEL (C Grylls) ran off rounding the turn and was pulled up near the 400 metres. When questioned rider C Grylls had no tangible reason, but advised the mare was fractious prior to the start. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of DONNA BEEL which did not reveal any immediate abnormality other than potentially showing signs of coming in season. Trainer J Bary undertook to advise Stewards of the mares progress over coming days. DONNA BEEL was ordered to trial prior to its next start.</p>	

Race 6	SACRED FALLS HAWKE'S BAY GUINEAS
<p>SELFIE (M Coleman) and LUCKY EDIE (J Parkes) bumped at the start.</p> <p>FIVE TO MIDNIGHT (J Riddell) was slow away.</p> <p>SELFIE commenced to over-race shortly after leaving the barriers.</p> <p>ROCANTO (D Johnson) was tightened and compelled to check near the 1200 metres when inside LUCKY EDIE which was taken inward by AMARULA (S McKay) which was improving forward to lead. Apprentice S McKay denied a resultant breach of [Rule 638(1)(d)] careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift in when not clear.</p> <p>After consideration the Judicial Committee found the charge proved and subsequently suspended apprentice S McKay 's licence from the conclusion of racing on October 10th up to and including racing on 23rd October (6 days)</p> <p>BATTLE TIME over-raced near the 1,000 metres and had to be steadied resulting in the trailing MR CONDUCTOR (R Hutchings) also having to be steady off that runners heels. BATTLE TIME then shifted outward forcing SELFIE over extra ground.</p> <p>MR CONDUCTOR raced wide from the 800 metres.</p> <p>BATTLE TIME (V Colgan) was held up rounding the turn and on straightening improved into a marginal run to the inside of RULE THE WORLD (S Spratt). RULE THE WORLD then lay in and bumped with BATTLE TIME which became unbalanced and shifted out and in doing so dictated RULE THE WORLD and MR CONDUCTOR outwards.</p> <p>SCRUTINIZE (M Cameron) which was awkwardly placed near the heels of MR CONDUCTOR shifted out into the line of MARKY MARK (L Innes) which was dictated out when improving to the outside.</p> <p>When questioned into the disappointing run of SELFIE rider M Coleman had no excuse and stated the gelding was under pressure from the 600 metres.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality however connections undertook to report the progress of SELFIE over coming days.</p>	
Race 7	NIAGARA @ LIME COUNTRY 1400
<p>CALL ME ROYAL (D Johnson) and CHARLIE CHINE (K Myers) were slow away.</p> <p>QUEENOFHARPZ (J Parkes) had to steady near the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of ZABELLE (L Innes) which shifted in. L Innes was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>L Allpress (MENDIP) lost the use of her irons in the early stage thereafter not taking any effective part in the race.</p> <p>ZABELLE lay out rounding the final turn resulting in LASTROLLOFTHEDICE (L Hemi) being taken wider.</p> <p>SHE KNOWS (V Colgan) had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned in to the run of ADMIRAL which finished well back apprentice Zy Nor Azman reported that the horse was not suited to the firm nature of today's track.</p>	
Race 8	LINWOOD PARK STUD SPRING SPRINT
<p>GWYNETHANNE (L Allpress) was slow away.</p> <p>ANTONIO LOMBARDO (S McKay) began awkwardly and was slow away.</p> <p>PUSSY O'REILLY (M Cameron) raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained.</p> <p>MOSSE (V Colgan) was held up for a distance passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>MOSSE had to steady over the final stages when awkwardly near the heels of ALLEZ EAGLE (D Johnson)</p>	
Race 9	LIVAMOL CLASSIC
<p>THORN PRINCE (J Parkes) shifted out on jumping bumping with FARM BOY (V Colgan)</p> <p>NASHVILLE (K Myers) was slow away.</p> <p>BLIZZARD (C Grylls) raced wide around the first turn.</p> <p>PONDEROSA MISS had to steady approaching the 300 metres when awkwardly between FARM BOY which lay in marginally shortly after straightening and BLIZZARD which lay out under pressure. SORIANO (R Hutchings) which was immediately in behind had to take evasive action and consequently lost momentum.</p> <p>BENZINI (R Myers) had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p> <p>ADDICTIVE HABIT (S Spratt) lay out under pressure near the 50 metres.</p> <p>Following the race L Innes was stood down for his remaining mounts after suffering the effects of dehydration.</p>	
Race 10	TUMU ITM 1400
<p>S Spratt replaced L Innes on LIL MISS WAITOKI</p> <p>DANNY BOY (N Teeluck) and POWERADE (M Dravitzki) were slow away.</p> <p>DANNY BOY the commenced to over-race for some distance in the back straight.</p> <p>POWERADE had to be steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of OLLIE'S NOTE (L Magorrian) after making the crossing in the back straight near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>THE CANON (K Myers) raced wide throughout.</p> <p>WILLS ROAD (R Myers) was obliged to improve wide rounding the turn.</p>	
Race 11	BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND SPRING CARNIVAL FINALE
C Grylls replaced L Innes on BONINSKY	

TYNE COT (L Hemi) and **MUNGO JERRY** (S McKay) was slow away.

TYNE COT raced keenly throughout.

MISS SELBY (J Parkes) was held up and unable to improve throughout the straight and went to the line untested.
