RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PIRONGIA RSC 1150
<p>BRESHARNY (C Dell), QUAALUP (D Johnson), MY PALOMA (J Oliver) and RISING SON (C Grylls) were all slow to begin. BAMURRU commenced to hang out shortly after leaving the barrier placing apprentice rider U Holmquist in difficulty, and making the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres. BAMURRU continued to hang out and race ungenerously placing U Holmquist at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>CARMENIZE (C Lammas) was held up rounding the final turn approaching the 300 metres.</p> <p>S McKay the rider of LUCKY BOY dropped his whip approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>HONKIETONK TIGER (T Thornton) shifted out over the concluding stages making brief contact with MOSSOMAK (S Collett). Rider D Johnson reported that QUAALUP had held its breath during the running.</p>	
Race 2	WAIPA TOWING 1150
<p>RIDDLE (A Schwerin) and NEALA (R Norvall) were slow to begin.</p> <p>WON BY ONE (Z Nor Azman) shifted in leaving the barriers crowding ARCHDUCHESS (K Myers) which was steadied.</p> <p>FORT KNOX (C Grylls) shifted out shortly after jumping away making contact with GUMBOOTS (C Lammas), then got its head up and shifted out abruptly having to be firmly restrained off the heels of GUMBOOTS losing ground as a result. After questioning riders concerned no action was deemed necessary.</p> <p>WON BY ONE raced ungenerously when being steadied through the middle stages.</p> <p>ALAMER (M Coleman) was held up making the final bend approaching the 300 metres.</p>	

Race 3	WAIPA TRAINERS THANKS FOR 100 YEARS 1150
<p>ARIZONA BLIZZARD (T Thornton) and ITSABIRD (U Holmquist) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>Approaching the 900 metres MARKWOOD (L Magorrian) had to steady off the heels of STACEY ANN (D Hain) which shifted out, then shortly after made contact with CHANTELLE (B R Jones) which shifted out when over-racing becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>STACEY ANN raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>ARIZONA BLIZZARD hung out when making the final bend.</p>	
Race 4	WAIPA DISTRICT COUNCIL – HOME OF CHAMPIONS 1400
<p>HOWLAND (V Colgan) was slow to begin.</p> <p>CRUCIAL (L Allpress) and EL HEALO (R Norvall) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>CRUCIAL had to steady passing the 1300 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of BUSTER ABBOTT (C Grylls). As a result JOHNNY THE JET (L Magorrian) had to steady.</p> <p>TANIA (S Collett) lost the off front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 5	COLOUR PLUS 1400
<p>ROSE SAUVAGE (B Hutton) began awkwardly.</p> <p>ROC DE BANK (M Hills) and ESBEEDEE (T Thornton) came together leaving the barrier.</p> <p>ROSE SAUVAGE commenced to over-race passing the 1200 metres shifting out off heels.</p> <p>YOUWANTMORE (S Collett) was obliged to race wide in the early to middle stages before obtaining cover.</p>	
Race 6	TE AWAMUTU COURIER 1400
<p>SPECIAL DUKE (J Oliver) reared as the barriers were released losing ground.</p> <p>THE KEPT MAN (C Grylls) was slow to begin.</p> <p>Passing the 1200 metres EL BAYARDO (K Myers), SUPERMAN (M Coleman) and PURE LORDE (S Collett) all raced in restricted room to the inside of LADY PAINTON (C Lammas) which shifted in when marginally clear. EL BAYARDO then shifted out hampering PARTNER IN TIME (D Johnson) and ZEUS (V Colgan). PARTNER IN TIME then raced ungenerously for a distance. Rider C Lammas was advised to exercise care when shifting ground. SPECIAL DUKE which was following PARTNER IN TIME also raced ungenerously when being steadied.</p> <p>Passing the 800 metres PURE LORDE hung out around the bend becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of SUPERMAN having to be firmly restrained dropping back on to SILVER SERVICE (R Norvall) which then shifted out abruptly taking EL BAYARDO, PARTNER IN TIME and ZEUS over extra ground with V Colgan becoming unbalanced for a short distance, with PARTNER IN TIME and ZEUS having to race wide for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>Passing the 600 metres SUPERMAN shifted out off the heels of HEART OF GRACE (A Collett) to obtain clear running inconveniencing SILVER SERVICE.</p> <p>SPECIAL DUKE had to be steadied off heels passing the 300 metres, and had difficulty obtaining clear running for the remainder of the race.</p>	
Race 7	TE AWAMUTU RSA 1580
<p>LOWRIDER was a late scratching at 10.20 am on veterinary advice.</p> <p>PATIENCE PREVAILS (E Smith) was slow to begin.</p> <p>AL BE CIVICS (R Norvall) and LADY OONA (S Collett) came together leaving the barrier with LADY OONA then shifting away crowding RIVER FORCE (S McKay).</p> <p>I GOTTA HUNCH (J Oliver) raced keenly when being steadied passing the 1300 metres.</p> <p>LADY OONA was steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 1150 metres TUI'S BLUE (T Thornton) made the bend awkwardly having to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of SUM FAVOUR (D Hain).</p>	
Race 8	CENTURY 21 1580
<p>CONRWIN (A Schwerin) began awkwardly, and then was contacted by PAN DULCE (S McKay) with rider A Schwerin becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>Passing the 1500 metres COACHLINE (A Collett) was crowded to the inside of MAXIMUM HEIGHT (A Jones) which was taken in slightly by OHOPE PRINCE (L McGregor). As a result COACHLINE was steadied losing ground. Rider L McGregor was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.</p> <p>OHOPE PRINCE raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>MAXIMUM HEIGHT was steadied approaching the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>Passing the 700 metres CONRWIN when awkwardly placed on the heels of the weakening GUESS WHAT (T Thornton) shifted out making contact with COACHLINE on at least two occasions.</p> <p>Near the 300 metres GUESS WHAT lay in under pressure briefly crowding MAXIMUM HEIGHT which made contact with the running rail.</p>	
Race 9	CAL ISUZU 1400

REBEL ROSE (L Allpress) was slow to begin.

FLYING TREASURE (C Grylls) began awkwardly.

TORRICELLA (R Elliot) was crowded shortly after jumping away having to steady losing ground.

Shortly after leaving the barriers **UNDISCOVERED** (A Schwerin) and **THE GREAT FOX** (Z Nor Azman) raced in restricted room to the inside of **CANDID MAN** (T Thornton) which lay in. **LADDIE OF OAKVIEW** (L Magorrian) then shifted in when racing ungenerously becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **PARISDOTCON** (D Johnson) crowding **CANDID MAN** which then dictated **UNDISCOVERED** in on to **THE GREAT FOX** which was hampered losing ground. **LADDIE OF OAKVIEW** then continued to race ungenerously making the bend awkwardly passing the 1100 metres.

BACHATA (S McKay) commenced to over-race passing the 1100 metres making the bend awkwardly running wide.

ENDEAN ROSE (B Hutton) lay out rounding the bend by the 800 metres having to be steadied when awkwardly placed inside heels.

FLYING TREASURE (C Grylls) returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and will be stood down for the mandatory three months. The trainer advised Stewards that the gelding will not be persevered with as a racing proposition.

Race 10

FREIGHT LINES TE AWAMUTU CENTENNIAL CUP 2000

TOKOMUTU JUDGE (J Oliver) was slow to begin.

THE JUNGLE BOY (L Magorrian) jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

LITTLE ALFIE BROWN (R Norvall) and **BIOLOGIST** (L Allpress) both raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

When questioned into the performance of **LETMEBY** rider M Coleman was unable to offer any excuse for the gelding's performance.

When questioned into the improved performance of **FLYINBY** (K Myers) the trainer advised that carrying a lighter weight than in its previous starts, and also the step up in distance probably contributed to the improved performance.

Race 11

LIFE & HONORARY MEMBERS 2000

NOTHING (L Allpress) was slow to begin.

NOTHING had to be steadied shortly after the start when **HIGH TAIL IT** (M Coleman) shifted in.

DOUCETTE (B Hutton) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Approaching the 350 metres **HIGH TAIL IT** had to be steadied when in restricted room between **FORBIDDEN** (C Grylls) and **BACHELOR ZEEL** (S Collett) when both those runners shifted ground.
