## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>FAIRVIEW MOTORS MATAMATA 1600</b>
<p>Trainer N Bishara was issued with a warning for presenting <b>EDEN ROSE</b> (A Collett) to race without the notified blinkers.</p> <p><b>ARRAIGNMENT</b> (D Johnson) was observed to have blood present in its mouth on arriving at the barriers, and after undergoing a veterinary inspection was passed fit to run.</p> <p><b>REMINDE ME AGAIN</b> (L McGregor) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SILVER SERVICE</b> (R Norvall) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>HIDDEN TREASURE</b> (M Coleman) was crowded shortly after leaving the barrier when runners on either side shifted ground.</p> <p><b>SHEEMA</b> (S Spratt) and <b>SPECIAL DUKE</b> (L Magorrian) both over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>BON MARCHE</b> (M Cameron) lay in rounding the final bend.</p> <p><b>EDEN ROSE</b> lay out around the final bend, and continued to lay out down the final straight.</p> <p><b>CLARIFY</b> (S McKay) lost the right hind plate during the running.</p> <p><b>SILVER SERVICE</b> returned to the enclosure with a minor laceration over the right hip requiring veterinary attention.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>COLCHESTER ENGINEERING LIMITED 1400</b>
<p><b>GERARDASUN</b> (G Cooksley), <b>TIARA CONCERTO</b> (S McKay) and <b>DA SHINDIG</b> (A Collett) were all slow to begin.</p>	

<p><b>ZADIFFRA</b> (S Collett) raced keenly through the middle stages.</p> <p><b>WOODSMAN</b> (A Jones) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Shortly after entering the final straight <b>HAYLEY ANN</b> (L Innes) shifted out and away from <b>MOCCONA MIST</b> (D Johnson) inconveniencing <b>O'REILLY'S GOLD</b> (B R Jones) which had to be briefly steadied.</p> <p>Approaching the 200 metres <b>GERARDASUN</b> when attempting a marginal run made contact with <b>EYE RACED NINETY</b> (M Cameron) which was laying out, and contributing was inward movement from <b>JOUET CUVÉE</b> (S Spratt) which was taken in by <b>WOODSMAN</b>, with <b>TIARA CONCERTO</b> having to be firmly restrained off the heels of <b>EYE RACED NINETY</b>.</p> <p><b>DA SHINDIG</b> and <b>ZADIFFRA</b> were both briefly held up passing the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>WAHAROA LIVESTOCK 1400</b>
<p><b>NO NEED</b> (S Spratt) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SCOOTER O'REILLY</b> (L Innes) got its head up and made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly when over-racing on a moderate pace.</p> <p>When questioned into the improved performance of <b>ALI BABA</b> (G Cooksley) the trainer advised Stewards that at its previous start had become fractious in the barriers and was slow away, and also stepping up to 1400 metres on this occasion may have contributed to the colt's improved performance.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of the favourite <b>MASSA LU</b> rider M Cameron was unable to offer any reason for the colt's performance, apart from it may prefer a little more easing of the ground.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>COMAG 1600</b>
<p><b>RIVER RAIDER</b> (C Dell) and <b>REAL WINNERS</b> (S McKay) both jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p><b>DELUXE EDITION</b> (Z Moki) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>IDAHO'S CHOICE</b> (S Spratt) was inclined to lay out in the final straight when placed under pressure.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>MATAMATA VETERINARY SERVICES LIMITED 1600</b>
<p><b>HER CHOICE</b> (A Collett) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SAINT EMILION</b> (M Cameron) jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p><b>HE'S CAVALIER</b> (B Hutton) blundered shortly after jumping away.</p> <p><b>DOIKNOWYOU</b> (L Magorrian) shifted out near the 1400 metres into the line of <b>ROUGH COPY</b> (S Spratt) with that runner having to be steadied off heels.</p> <p><b>HE'S CAVALIER</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>CURSIVE</b> (D Johnson) lay in under pressure briefly crowding <b>OUR KING SWAY</b> (S McKay) near the 150 metres.</p> <p>Apprentice rider U Holmquist (<b>YSABELLA BRAVE</b>) was spoken to advisedly as after the finishing line she relaxed her ride and allowed her mount to drift out into the line of <b>OUR KING SWAY</b> which shifted out making contact with <b>CURSIVE</b> dictating that runner out into the line of <b>HER CHOICE</b> (A Collett) which clipped a heel and blundered.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>MATAMATA MITRE 10 2000</b>
<p><b>MASTER MICHAEL</b> (C Dell) jumped away awkwardly shifting out into the line of <b>THE SHACKLER</b> (A Schwerin) which was hampered losing ground.</p> <p><b>SORORIA</b> (S McKay) stumbled on leaving the barriers shifting out and making contact with <b>HIGH TAIL IT</b> (D Johnson).</p> <p><b>KATY O'BEEL</b> (U Holmquist) blundered shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p><b>BACK IN BLACK</b> (S Collett) raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p><b>THE SHACKLER</b> ran wide leaving the straight on the first occasion.</p> <p><b>THE SHACKLER</b> shifted out entering the final straight taking <b>PRIZE LAD</b> (B Hutton) outwards making contact with <b>PACKING CHAPARRAL</b> (M Coleman).</p> <p><b>ROYAL SCEPTRE</b> (A Jones) and <b>EL BANDIDO</b> (L McGregor) both raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>TEAM WEALLEANS MATAMATA CUP</b>
<p><b>TYNE COT</b> (S Spratt), <b>RANSOMED</b> (L Magorrian) and <b>DELAGO'S SECRET</b> (D Johnson) were slow to begin.</p> <p><b>DRAGONKEEPER</b> (U Holmquist) jumped away awkwardly, and then over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>DRAGONKEEPER</b> hung out under pressure dropping back on to <b>SMARTLY</b> (B Hutton) which had to be firmly restrained off that runner's heels near the 400 metres.</p> <p>Rider M Cameron advised Stewards post-race that <b>CANDLE IN THE WIND</b> had pulled up lame in the off foreleg. The mare underwent a veterinary examination which confirmed lameness in the off foreleg.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>RUSSELL &amp; YVONNE GREEN MEMORIAL 1200</b>
<p><b>WAINUI PRINCE</b> (L McGregor) and <b>CAPONE</b> (B R Jones) were both slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ELETIST</b> (L Innes) blundered shortly after jumping away.</p> <p><b>SO WOTIF</b> (Z Moki) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p> <p><b>GETALONGHOME CINDY</b> (J Whiteside) shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip passing the 200 metres having to be straightened.</p> <p><b>ELETIST</b> had to shift out across heels passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>SAOIRSE</b> (B Hutton) returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. The trainer did not wish to have</p>	

the mare endoscoped, and **SAOIRISE** was deemed to be a bleeder and is stood down from racing for the mandatory three months.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>PIC INSURANCE BROKERS 2000</b>

**REAL THIRSTY** (L Innes) was slow to begin.

**VICTORYSHALLBEMINE** (M Coleman) jumped away awkwardly shifting out making firm contact with **BIG 'N' RICH** (S Spratt) forcing that runner on to **SEA OF SPEED** (L Magorrian) with those runners being hampered for a short distance.

**LUCKY CHARM** (B R Jones) settled back in the early stages, and when the pace steadied near the 1400 metres allowed the gelding to improve forward to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres.

**TABLE ONE** (A Schwerin) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**MESSI** (A Jones) and **TABLE ONE** were held up for a short distance passing the 100 metres.

**REAL THIRSTY** lay out under pressure in the final straight. When questioned into the gelding's performance rider L Innes was unable to offer any reason.
