RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TARANAKI INDUSTRIAL ELECTRICAL SERVICES LTD MDN 1600M
<p>DAL SIR TEE was slow to begin from the outside barrier.</p> <p>HARD TO BE HUMBLE and BRECON BEAU were slow to begin.</p> <p>WRONG BELT raced wide throughout.</p> <p>SAROOKH raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>NIPPA MARY was held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres and again near the 200 metres.</p> <p>KEILIB was held up rounding the turn until near the 200 metres.</p> <p>EVADIR LA BALA was held up passing the 400 metres, had to be steadied then angled wider near the 100 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of HARD TO BE HUMBLE rider M Hills advised the mare never travelled well during the running. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 2	JOHNNY NEIL BUILDING LTD R65 1600
<p>PHONE GIRL was slow to begin.</p> <p>BUCK CANNON had to be steadied briefly when making the turn into the back straight near the 1400 metres.</p> <p>KERMIT commenced to over race near the 1200 metres so was taken wider then raced wide without cover for the remainder.</p>	

<p>CHOPPER and MASTER FIN raced wide throughout.</p> <p>PHONE GIRL went off stride near the 400 metres and lost ground. A subsequent veterinary examination of the mare revealed a possible sesamoid injury to the left foreleg. Further veterinary assessment of PHONE GIRL will be undertaken in coming days with the outcome to be advised to Stewards.</p>	
Race 3	ANDERSONS PIES 1600M
<p>ONEFORTHEDITCH reared on jumping away and settled back.</p> <p>ACQUISTO jumped in at the start hampering POSTBOY which lost ground.</p> <p>RED KING was slow away.</p> <p>CLAPATHUNDA raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>WOW WHATA PRINCESS was held up from passing the 600 metres until near the 250 metres.</p> <p>H Tinsley had no excuse for the disappointing run of POSTBOY which failed to finish the race off as expected. Stewards ordered a subsequent veterinary inspection which did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer R Bergerson undertook to advise Stewards should any relevant matter become apparent in the coming days.</p>	
Race 4	MOLLER JOHNSON ISUZU R65 1400M
<p>ARYA began awkwardly and was then impeded when HUNDYAMONTH shifted in on jumping.</p> <p>ANGELICA ROX stumbled on jumping away and shifted in making heavy contact with NEWSTEAD which was unbalanced.</p> <p>WHEELER FORTUNE hung out in the initial stages dictating ANGELICA ROX and HUNDYAMONTH outwards resulting in HUNDYAMONTH having to be steadied off heels.</p> <p>ALL IN LUCK and SATIN RIDGE over raced early and in the middle stages.</p> <p>EFFECTAV raced thee wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>CHRISTAL was held up rounding the turn only obtaining clear running near the 150 metres.</p> <p>WHEELER FORTUNE (M Dravitzki) lay out early in the final straight and approaching the 350 metres shifted out into the line of ALL IN LUCK when M Dravitzki momentarily lost the use of her inside rein. ALL IN LUCK was compelled to steady and in doing so came back on to ARYA which was hampered.</p>	
Race 5	AITKEN TRANSPORT 1994 LTD 75 1200M
<p>KOLONEL KEV bounded on jumping away losing ground.</p> <p>STEEL ROSE lay in shortly after leaving the barriers crowding FIGURAC in onto LEEDS which was briefly hampered.</p> <p>HADDON HALL raced wide without cover.</p> <p>FIGURAC had to steady passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of SALUTE ME.</p> <p>LEEDS was held up passing the 600 metres until near the 250 metres.</p> <p>KOLONEL KEV lay out under pressure near the 250 metres crowding HADDON HALL out onto AUSTIN ROAD.</p> <p>KOLONEL KEV had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the final turn and early part of the straight.</p>	
Race 6	EGMONT TYRES R65 2000M
<p>ALL STARS bounded at the start.</p> <p>DONLEE and LUCKY DESIRE were slow to begin.</p> <p>TWENTYTHIRTYFOUR raced ungenerously passing the winning post on the first occasion and when being restrained came back on to DUCATI which had to steady and shift ground outwards resulting in LUCKY DESIRE being taken wider on the track.</p> <p>ALLSTARS had to steady going over the crossing near the 1600 metres.</p> <p>FRIED RICE raced keenly in the lead in the middle stages.</p> <p>DUCATI raced wide without cover for the majority.</p> <p>POWER TRIP broke down in the off foreleg near the 400 metres and subsequently had to be humanely euthanized.</p> <p>MAILLY was held up for a short distance approaching the 400 metres.</p> <p>Following the race it was reported that DUCATI had been galloped on sustaining a cut.</p>	
Race 7	KAPONGA HOTEL EGMONT CUP 2000M
<p>MUNGO JERRY and BLOOD BROTHA were slow to begin.</p> <p>SHARE THE BLAME over raced in the lead in the early stages</p> <p>KING KAMADA was inclined to over race in the middle stages.</p> <p>SAMPSON was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>KING KAMADA was held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres.</p>	
Race 8	RICH HILL STUD TARANAKI BREEDERS WFA F&M STAKES 1400M
<p>BETTER KEEPER and TE HANA were slow to begin.</p>	

CATWOMANDU dipped after jumping away however recovering quickly.
CENTRE CROSS, KISSES, SECOND TIME LUCKY and **ANNIESSTAR** all over raced for a short distance near the 900 metres when the pace steadied.
RECITE raced three wide without cover throughout.
RECITE was galloped on during the running requiring minor veterinary treatment.
KISSES was held up for a short distance rounding the final turn.
TIE ME DOWN was held up rounding the turn.
CENTRE CROSS had to steady momentarily and shift ground inwards to improve near the 250 metres when **TIE ME DOWN**
K Myers shifted out when only marginally clear. K Myers was reminded of her obligations.

Race 9	SOUTH TARANAKI CLUB R65 1400M

ANTONIO raced wide without cover throughout.
COOL MOON was held up passing the 700 metres and near the 500 metres when taken out to improve dictated **COASTAL EXPRESS, ANTONIO** and **CITY CHIC** wider on the track.
FREDERICK WILLIAM was held up passing the 400 metres until near the 150 metres.
MAE WEST had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the final straight.
CASSIE ANNE was held up between the 400 and 150 metres.
