RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MATAMATA VETERINARY SERVICES 3YO
<p>BAMURRU (S Collett) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with SLEEK SECRET (Z Nor Azman) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>AMBER ACHIEVER (D Johnson) began awkwardly.</p> <p>RUBY ARMANI (A Collett) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>LUCROR FESTINATIO (M Coleman) was momentarily crowded passing the 1000 metres to the inside of SLEEK SECRET which was taken in by BAMURRU. Rider S Collett was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>ORANGE CRUSH (L Innes) had to steady near the 800 metres when in restricted room to the inside of SLEEK SECRET which lay in. ORANGE CRUSH then made the bend awkwardly taking AMBER ACHIEVER over extra ground.</p> <p>CILLA (K Myers) shifted out abruptly away from ORANGE CRUSH forcing DUKE STREET (M Cameron) over extra ground passing the 750 metres.</p> <p>SLEEK SECRET was held up approaching the 300 metres having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running. When questioned regarding the performance of CILLA rider K Myers advised that in her opinion the filly was not suited to the firm nature of today's track.</p>	
Race 2	WILL JOHNSTON-9 TO 3 ON THE HITS 1300
<p>GO TEENA (D Johnson) after becoming fractious in the barriers was removed and underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was declared a late scratching at 1.09 pm.</p> <p>KING BOLT (B R Jones), PINKO MOON (T Thornton) and SODALICIOUS (A Collett) were all slow to begin.</p> <p>CHACHAR (L Innes) returned to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril. CHACHAR underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed a laceration inside the left nostril.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of PINKO MOON rider T Thornton advised that the gelding had felt</p>	

indifferent in its action during the running. PINKO MOON underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.		
Race 3	GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1600	
<p>WHATZ OCCURRING (A Collett) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MALCOLM (R Norvall) was slow to begin.</p> <p>BHIWANI (M Cameron) over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>Approaching the 800 metres BHIWANI had to be restrained when the pace eased dropping back on to BIG DREAMER (V Colgan) which in turn went back on to MALCOLM which had to be firmly restrained off that runner’s heels, and then commenced to over-race for a short distance.</p> <p>ALL ABOUT FUN (B Hutton) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>BHIWANI and MALCOLM were both held up rounding the final turn.</p> <p>EL PISTOLA (C Grylls) was momentarily held up passing the 200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of MAID OF STEEL (L Innes).</p> <p>BIG DREAMER which was eased down in the final straight underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have suffered from an atrial fibrillation. The connections of BIG DREAMER were advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to racing next.</p>		
Race 4	VERO INSURANCE 1600	
<p>BRESHARNY (C Dell) became fractious in the barriers rearing over and becoming cast, striking CHATEAU ROC (L Innes) in the adjacent barrier several times. Both runners were removed from the barriers and underwent pre-race veterinary examinations with both runners being declared late scratchings at 1.18 pm. BRESHARNY will be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>THE BOSS (C Lammas) shifted in after jumping away crowding SUZERAIN (M Cameron) which lost ground.</p> <p>FAMOUS GROUSE (D Johnson) began awkwardly, and then over-raced through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>FAMOUS GROUSE shifted out passing the 600 metres to obtain clear running making contact with SIH RAH (A Jones).</p>		
Race 5	WAIKATO BRANCH NZ FARRIERS ASSOCIATION 2100	
<p>FORBIDDEN (M Cameron) was slow to begin.</p> <p>DUQUESA (S Collett) stumbled on jumping away.</p> <p>MR DOOLE (B Hutton) began awkwardly shifting in hampering KIDNAPPED (A Collett) which had been slow to begin.</p> <p>PHEROZARDO (T Thornton) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>ON PAROLE (C Lammas) became awkwardly placed on heels near the 1600 metres having to be firmly restrained dropping back on to KIDNAPPED which had to steady.</p> <p>MR DOOLE raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1400 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of LETMEBY rider M Coleman advised Stewards that the gelding had been unsuited to the firm nature of today’s track conditions.</p>		
Race 6	GARTSHORE INTERIORS 1200	
<p>WINOR ELSA (L McGregor) jumped in the air at the start losing ground.</p> <p>KING PANAMERA (S Collett) began very awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>SAVANNAH SOMOYA (T Thornton) began awkwardly laying in inconveniencing EMBRACEABLE YOU (A Collett).</p> <p>BACHATA began awkwardly with rider L Magorrian becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>GEMODI (R Elliot) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>KING PANAMERA over-raced in the early stages making the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>CUSTER (K Myers) had to steady near the 800 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of ALICUDI which had shifted in. M McNab was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>BACHATA was inclined to lay out rounding the final bend.</p> <p>KING PANAMERA was held up early in the final straight having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.</p> <p>SAVANNAH SOMOYA was held up until passing 350 metres.</p> <p>SILVER PLATTER (M Cameron) shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres making contact with WAIPIPI LAD (B Hutton).</p> <p>LAAFFAIRE (L Innes) was held up until passing the 200 metres.</p>		
Race 7	MILLS REEF WINERY & RESTAURANT 1600	
<p>Rider M McNab was unable to make the carded weight for DEZIGNATOR with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$275. M McNab was replaced by A Collett.</p> <p>STORM BRO (C Grylls) and DEZIGNATOR (A Collett) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>MANAIA ROSE (L McGregor) became awkwardly placed on the heels of VEGAS NIGHT (K Myers) which was weakening having to shift out entering the final straight.</p> <p>ZAVIERA (L Innes) was held up until passing the 400 metres and then commenced to lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>DEZIGNATOR when weakening had to steady when crowded between OSMUNDA (M Cameron) and LONELY BOY (M Hills)</p>		

which both shifted ground passing the 200 metres.

DIESEL (D Johnson) returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril. **DIESEL** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration inside the right nostril.

When questioned regarding the performance of **VEGAS NIGHT** rider K Myers could offer no tangible reason for the gelding's disappointing performance.

Race 8

GARTSHORE JOINERY 1600

TASHA AIMEE (M Coleman) was slow to begin.

SHEEMA (L Magorrian) began awkwardly, then had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

SHEEMA over-raced in the early stages.

LOWRIDER (C Dell) when placed under pressure in the final straight lay out and was unable to be ridden to full advantage over the concluding stages.

LOWRIDER lost the right hind plate during the running.
