RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NOTTINGHAM CASTLE HOTEL 2200
<p>COPPER QUEEN (S Collett) knuckled after jumping away.</p> <p>TUI'S BLUE (Z Moki) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MINTED BLACK (Z Nor Azman) was crowded passing the 1800 metres when ABSOLUTE GEM (B Hutton) lay in and TUI'S BLUE made the bend awkwardly shifting out. TUI'S BLUE continued to make the bend awkwardly again crowding MINTED BLACK on to the hind quarters of ABSOLUTE GEM which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>Approaching the 1600 metres PATIENCE PREVAILS (S Spratt) lay out when the pace eased into the line of ABSOLUTE GEM which had to be steadied, and as a result dropped back on to TUI'S BLUE which also had to be steadied.</p> <p>PLENTEOUS (L Magorrian) raced three wide without cover in the early stages before improving forward to race outside the leader near the 1400 metres.</p> <p>At the 350 metres AMETRINE (A Collett) lay in under pressure making contact with INASTRIDE (M Cameron).</p> <p>COPPER QUEEN was held up for clear running until approaching the 250 metres having to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running.</p> <p>CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF (C Grylls) lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	

BULLITT (O Bosson) lay in under pressure in the final straight.	
Race 2	DONAGHYS UDDERMATE 1400
<p>ECHZEAEUX (M Cameron) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>ITSABIRD (U Holmquist) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with LADY FERNER (L Magorrian).</p> <p>IRISH (B R Jones) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Approaching the 1000 metres SAINT LUCIA (C Lammas) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of LADY FERNER which shifted in.</p> <p>ITSABIRD had to steady when crowded to the inside of PACORUS (D Johnson) which was taken in by ROAD TRIP (K Myers) which was inclined to lay inwards passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>ROAD TRIP raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>IRISH was held up having to shift ground approaching the 150 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>Passing the 100 metres ROAD TRIP lay in under pressure taking LADY FERNER into the line of IRISH which had to be steadied, and was unable to be ridden out fully to the line.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of ECHZEAEUX rider M Cameron advised that the mare is very soft in the mouth and was inclined to race greenly throughout. He also recommended to the connections appropriate gear changes.</p> <p>OSCARLITO (S Collett) lost the right front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 3	DONAGHYS PRO-DAIRY 1400
<p>WAIHOU LASS became fractious at the start dislodging rider B Hutton. After going a short distance the mare was recaptured undergoing a pre-race veterinary inspection being passed fit to race.</p> <p>LEICA DREIM (B R Jones) began awkwardly shifting out making contact with SECOND FLING (C Grylls) with LEICA DREIM losing ground. LEICA DREIM then commenced to over-race, and shifted out near the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed on heels and raced wide for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>EBONY AYES (A Collett) and WAIHOU LASS (B Hutton) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>SUMMALUCKY (D Johnson) began awkwardly, and was inclined to lay inwards in the early stages when over-racing crowding EM KAY POPS (M Cameron) near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>HUSSLER HEIGHTS (V Colgan) got its head up passing the 1300 metres when being steadied to shift in to a position closer to the running rail.</p> <p>Near the 650 metres EM KAY POPS had to be firmly restrained off the heels of SUMMALUCKY.</p> <p>BRILLIANT MAGIC (A Schwerin) lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>Near the 200 metres HUSSLER HEIGHTS lay out under pressure making contact with the hind quarters of SWIFT CODE (S Collett) for several strides. SWIFT CODE then shifted back inwards inconveniencing HUSSLER HEIGHTS.</p> <p>Rider B Hutton (WAIHOU LASS) dropped his whip near the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 4	MAINFREIGHT 1400
<p>PACO RABANNE (M Coleman) was crowded losing ground shortly after the start when runners on either side shifted ground.</p> <p>NEALA (R Norvall) was inconvenienced shortly after the start when RAGHU (D Johnson) shifted out.</p> <p>CLASSIC WARRIOR (K Myers) and NEALA both over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>DETACH (M Cameron) lay out rounding the final bend, and was not persevered with for the remainder of the race. Rider M Cameron advised the filly had continued to hang out for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>CLASSIC WARRIOR was held up early in the final straight when shifting out to obtain clear running made contact with SURE ENOUGH (L Innes), which in turn shifted out making contact with NEALA.</p>	
Race 5	DONAGHYS N-BOOST 1400
<p>BOWIE (M Cameron) was crowded at the start when runners on either side shifted ground.</p> <p>TERI (C Lammas) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with FIVE OFF THE TEE (O Bosson).</p> <p>BLINDING FAST (M Coleman) was slow to begin.</p> <p>PROMISE TO REIGN (L Innes) began awkwardly.</p> <p>DOWNTON ABBEY (D Johnson) and SACRED SIREN (V Colgan) had to steady when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 600 metres with SACRED SIREN dropping back on to BOWIE (M Cameron) which had to be firmly restrained.</p> <p>Passing the 350 metres DOWNTON ABBEY lay in and away from PROMISE TO REIGN having to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of RAY'S LEGACY (A Collett) which shifted out when racing greenly with D Johnson then having to firmly restrain DOWNTON ABBEY and shift out abruptly across the heels of PROMISE TO REIGN.</p> <p>FIVE OFF THE TEE shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres crowding BOWIE over the concluding stages. Rider O Bosson was advised to exercise care when riding his mounts out to the finish.</p>	
Race 6	DONAGHYS PROABAMEC 1200
<p>ORCHESTRA (L Magorrian) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with the hind quarters of MY PALOMA (C Grylls) then blundered.</p>	

AUGUST EDITION (A Collett) was crowded shortly after the start.
SPRITZ (M Cameron) and **MURIWAI** (M Coleman) were both crowded on jumping away.
HEAD SPIN (D Johnson) began awkwardly.
MADDEE FAE (S Spratt) began awkwardly shifting in hampering **MONTEGO BAY** (L Innes).
Approaching the 200 metres **MONTEGO BAY** shifted out to obtain clear running making contact with **MY PALOMA**.

Race 7 | **DONAGHYS PROMONENSIN 1200**

BOULDER (M Coleman) was slow to begin, and then further hampered when **THORNHILL** (O Bosson) knuckled shortly after the start shifting in.
LANDED GENTRY (B R Jones) and **HIFLYER** (S Collett) were both slow to begin.
BOULDER over-raced in the early and middle stages.
THORNHILL raced keenly in the early and middle stages.
LANDED GENTRY and **BOULDER** were both held up early in the final straight.
HANNIBAL LECTER (A Collett) lay in early in the final straight, and then commenced to lay out when placed under pressure for the remainder of the race. Rider A Collett was reminded of her obligation of riding her mount out when circumstances permit.
SIR HAROLD (C Lammas) lay out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 8 | **DONAGHYS PUREFLUSH 1200**

CASTLE RIDGE (Z Moki), **BOB VALDEZ** (C Lammas) and **SIR FRANCIS** (M McNab) were all slow to begin.
SKYWARDS (O Bosson) knuckled passing the 1000 metres.
WHAT'S UP ALF (L Magorrian) got its head up for a distance when being restrained off heels near the 1000 metres.
DEELIGNA (L Innes) and **SNOW CHARM** (D Johnson) both raced wide without cover throughout.
BEYOND REACH (S Spratt) had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 150 metres.
When questioned into the performance of **SKYWARDS** rider O Bosson was unable to offer any tangible excuse.

Race 9 | **TASMAN TIM 1600**

REPRISE (M McNab) and **THE SWEET ESCAPE** (S Collett) were both slow to begin.
ADMEISTER (O Bosson) began awkwardly shifting in crowding **SHINKITOVER** (A Collett).
CABALLO NOIR (L Magorrian) shifted out hampering **ALL RAZZLE DAZZLE** (V Colgan) approaching the 1400 metres with rider V Colgan becoming unbalanced.
Passing the 1400 metres **ZADOREE** (Z Nor Azman) shifted out making contact with **ADMEISTER** becoming briefly unbalanced. **ADMEISTER** then shifted back out crowding **HIDDEN TREASURE** (M Coleman).
EL HEALO (R Norvall) and **PARTNER IN TIME** (C Grylls) both over-raced in the early and middle stages.
Near the 700 metres **CAN YOU HEAR ME** (S Spratt) lay out making contact with the hind quarters of **HIDDEN TREASURE** which was turned in resulting in **CAN YOU HEAR ME** having to be steadied.
HIDDEN TREASURE raced three wide without cover.
THE SWEET ESCAPE lay out rounding the final bend.
Approaching the 300 metres **ALL RAZZLE DAZZLE** lay in under pressure having to be steadied and shift out off the heels of **HIDDEN TREASURE** which shifted out slightly.

Race 10 | **DONAGHYS PROEQUINE 1600**

PRESIDENT TOMADO (C Lammas) was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 5.34 pm after becoming fractious at the start and dislodging its rider.
HEEZA DREIMER (M Coleman) and **DYNAMO** (D Johnson) both began awkwardly losing ground.
Shortly after the start **ELLE GRACE** (S Collett) was crowded losing ground.
Near the 1300 metres **UNDISCOVERED** (A Schwerin) shifted in towards the running rail when not sufficiently clear of **KAREN IRIS** (R Norvall) which had to be sharply checked clipping a heel and blundering, then shifted in causing crowding to **WHAKATANE** (V Colgan) which had to be checked as a result. Apprentice jockey A Schwerin admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 28 October up to and including racing on 4 November, 4 riding days.
UNDISCOVERED was held up early in the final straight.
STRALIS (A Collett) commenced to shift out under pressure passing the 100 metres inconveniencing **BLACKBIRD** (O Bosson).
WOODSMAN (A Jones) raced three wide without cover throughout.
