RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PALAMOUNTAINS MAIDEN STEEPLE 3780 3780M
HARD SHOT was slow to begin and settled at the rear. SCARAMOUCHE dipped on landing over the first fence and lost ground. SCIMITAR LAD fell at the fence near the 1000 metres. Rider D Miller was and cleared by Paramedics. HARD SHOT had to shift ground to avoid the fallen runner. REVEAL jumped the fence near the 1000 metres poorly then commenced to give ground. CRACKA CROWN was inclined to run down its fences throughout. AND THATZ SCOTTY was retired from the contest after jumping the fence near the 600 metres when well back and out of contention. When questioned into the disappointing run of BUNKERED Rider M Mitchell advised that the mare which was having its first steeple chase was outpaced throughout.	
Race 2	JOLT COFFEE HOUSE OPEN STEEPLE 3780 3780M
WISE MEN SAY was slow to begin and settled at the rear. GET FLASH hung out and raced ungenerously on the first bend when being restrained by the rider.	

WISE MEN SAY jumped the fence near the 1000 metres poorly unbalancing the rider.	
Race 3	LOWE SCHOLLUM & JONES MAIDEN HURDLE 3000 3000M
<p>MAILLY began a little awkwardly and lost three lengths.</p> <p>SNEDDON raced in restricted room in the approach to the final hurdle and had to be steadied for a short distance.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of MENDOZA Rider S Karnicnik reported that the gelding put in a high leap at the fence near the 1000 metres and from then commenced to give ground and was generally disappointing.</p> <p>CHEESE MAKER landed awkwardly over the second to last fence and lost ground.</p> <p>The winner VICEROY returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which proved clear and further inspection revealed a cut to the inside of the right nostril.</p>	
Race 4	KEN DUNCAN RACING OPEN HURDLE 3000 3000M
<p>GAGARIN began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>PUDDLE ALLEY over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>JUST ISHI shifted out on jumping the last fence, was then angled inwards, shifting in when only marginally clear of SEA KING (S Fannin) which was hampered when attempting to improve. Prior to the authorisation of dividends the rider of SEA KING (S Fannin) viewed video footage of the final stages but elected not to proceed with an objection. G Walsh the rider of JUST ISHI was nevertheless reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.</p> <p>C Perrett (THATZ DAVID) admitted a breach of Rule 636(1)(d) in the failed to ride his mount out fully to the finish after he was observed to relax his ride over the final stages losing fifth position by a short margin. After deliberations the JCA fined C Perrett the sum of \$300.</p>	
Race 5	G BRISTOL & SONS MAIDEN 1360 1360M
<p>M Singh (SEA STAR) admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift out shortly after the start dictating DUPLICITY which was tightened outwards on to DALRIADA which was checked and lost ground. After deliberations Apprentice Jockey Singh had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Thursday the 12th of May 2016 up to and including Saturday the 21st of May 2016. SEA STAR then commenced to race fiercely in the back straight.</p> <p>HONEY QUEEN raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>HONEY QUEEN was hampered when weakening near the 250 metres.</p> <p>MOUNTAIN PRINCESS shifted inwards under pressure and had to be straightened near the 250 metres.</p> <p>When questioned in to the run of AMORATA Rider R Myers advised that despite racing wide throughout the filly failed to finish the race off and was disappointing.</p>	
Race 6	FAULDINGS SOUND MAIDEN 1200 1200M
<p>WENTWORTH was slow away.</p> <p>GROUND CONTROL and SPANNERWORKS over-raced in the back straight.</p> <p>DEEP BLUE made the first bend awkwardly and hung out for some distance hampering WENTWORTH. DEEP BLUE continued to hang out rounding the turn when racing very greenly.</p> <p>SPANNERWORKS and CHATEAU MAROUX both had to be steadied when racing up on to heels near the 600 metres. This resulted in MYSTIGAN having to be steadied.</p> <p>GROUND CONTROL was inclined to hang in under pressure in the home straight and had to be straightened near the 150 metres and was then angled inwards over the final stages to improve to the inside of PRINCESS BELLE which shifted out.</p> <p>L Allpress (GROUND CONTROL) which finished fourth viewed footage of the final stages but elected not to proceed with an objection against the second placed PRINCESS BELLE.</p> <p>CHATEAU MAROUX was held up for a short distance after entering the home straight.</p>	
Race 7	ALLAN BARNES DECORATING RATING 65 1200 1200M
<p>HUNDYAMONTH jumped out at the start dictating MENDIP outwards into the line of CAUGHT BEHIND which was checked lost ground and settled at the rear.</p> <p>BEAUTIFUL MAN began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>A short distance after the start HOCUS POCUS and HUNDYAMONTH were tightened when there was simultaneous movement from DANMULAN which shifted out and MENDIP which shifted in resulting in HUNDYAMONTH losing several lengths. Apprentice Jockey D Mo (DANMULAN) was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift out momentarily hampering INTERSTELLAR and FETCHING which was improving to its outside.</p> <p>BEAUTIFUL MAN raced in restricted room over the final stages and could not be ridden out fully.</p> <p>ACCOLADES Rider D Bradley retired the mare from about the 500 metres when he considered something amiss. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality however connections were advised to report the progress of ACCOLADES over the coming days should anything arise.</p> <p>INTERSTELLAR raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 8	FLAIR AMATEUR RIDERS SERIES MAIDEN 2060 2060M
KING OBERON and NO DEAL both began awkwardly and settled back.	

MYSTERY GIFT had to be steadied when in restricted room near the post on the first occasion.

The saddle on **NO DEAL** shifted forward near the 1600 metre mark placing rider L Wheeler at a disadvantage for the remainder.

KING OBERON raced very wide in the back straight.

MYSTERY GIFT had to be steadied passing the 800 metres off the heels of **NO DEAL** when that runner shifted in despite the rider's efforts with the slipped saddle.

S Rennie (**MYSTERY GIFT**) was given a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(iii) in that she used her whip excessively in the home straight on a runner out of contention.

C Myers had no excuse for the disappointing run of **SHAMROCK KING**. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 9 | **OMAHANUI SPECIAL CARE UNIT RATING 75 2060M**

PERRAN BEACH began awkwardly shifting out bumping **IRISH WHISPER**

WAIT A SEC and **TEQUILA SUNRISE** bumped at the start.

IRISH WHISPER over raced when wide without cover throughout.

RED SUNSET made the first bend awkwardly.

Rider D Bradley reported that **IRISH WHISPER** had little left after over-racing. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

Race 10 | **WESTMERE BULK SPREADING LTD RATING 65 1600 1600M**

GOLDEN PENNY was slow to begin and settled back.

GILT raced fiercely throughout placing rider M Singh at a disadvantage and shifted out on the first bend forcing **STANDING IN LINE** wide.

KINGOFPLATINUM over-raced in the early stages

CHONNEY had to be steadied off heels going into the back straight.

GILT had to be eased near the 800 metres when racing in restricted room.

GILT shifted in near the 600 metres dictating **KINGOFPLATINUM** inwards on to **JUSTA CHARLIE**.

M Singh was shown footage of his ride for educational purposes.

KINGOFPLATINUM and **ETERNAL ANGEL** bumped on the bend when **ETERNAL ANGEL** was seeking a run.

CARNABY raced greenly for some distance prior to entering the home straight and had to be steadied off the heels of **GILT**

CARNABY raced in restricted room over the final stages and went to the line without being fully tested.
