## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>IRWIN'S TRUCK AND BUS SALES LTD 1580</b>
<p><b>MY BABY ROCS</b> (B Hutton) was slow to begin.  <b>CLOUDS OF GLORY</b> (S McKay) jumped away awkwardly forcing <b>THAILAND</b> (S Collett) wider.  <b>BIXBY</b> (M McNab) began awkwardly making contact with <b>LAEKEEPER</b> (C Grylls).  <b>FORT KNOX</b> (L Satherley) ducked out abruptly near the 850 metres inconveniencing <b>TURQUOISE COAST</b> (V Colgan).  <b>FORT KNOX</b> was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>DOMEROVA</b> (M Coleman) near the 400 metres.  <b>THAILAND</b> lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight making slight contact with <b>CLOUDS OF GLORY</b> passing the 100 metres.  Rider L Satherley (<b>FORT KNOX</b>) advised Stewards that the gelding had raced greenly throughout, and was inclined to lay out.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>RED BINS LTD 1580</b>
<p><b>CAPISTRANO PEARL</b> (L Allpress) jumped away awkwardly losing ground.  <b>SPAWN OF ELAIA</b> (M Hills) began awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of <b>ATUA</b> (C Lammas).  <b>BACHATA DANCE</b> (M Cameron) made the bend near the 1200 metres awkwardly shifting out crowding <b>ATUA</b> on to the hind quarters of <b>SPAWN OF ELAIA</b> with <b>ATUA</b> having to be steadied losing ground.  <b>SPAWN OF ELAIA</b> raced wide without cover throughout.  <b>O'CAROL</b> (C Grylls) was held up rounding the bend and throughout the final straight.  <b>SO TRUE</b> (M Coleman) had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 150 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>CRAIG'S TAKEAWAYS &amp; WHANGAMATA 1400</b>
<p><b>ENGLISH LADY</b> (L Magorrian) was slow to begin.  <b>SPARKLING SWORD</b> (V Ravikummar) was slow to begin, and then blundered shortly after the start.  <b>DARCI'S DAUGHTER</b> (S McKay) over-raced in the early stages.  <b>SIN TO WIN</b> (M McNab) knuckled leaving the barriers and again shortly after shifting in making contact with <b>ENGLISH LADY</b>.</p>	

<p>Rider V Ravikumar opted to steady his mount <b>SPARKLING SWORD</b> when placed in restricted room to the inside of <b>HOYT AXTON</b> (C Lammas) near the 150 metres, then angling outwards abruptly across that runner's heels. When questioned V Ravikumar advised that he had felt the run to the inside of <b>HOYT AXTON</b> had been closing and had made a decision to shift ground outwards. V Ravikumar's explanation was noted.</p> <p>Rider L Allpress (<b>FORREEL</b>) advised Stewards that her saddle had shifted backwards shortly after jumping away placing her at some disadvantage.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>BAINS LIQUID DISPOSAL 1400</b>
<p>R Elliot replaced R Grant on <b>JANE'S SECRET</b> after R Grant was unable to claim down to her nominated riding weight. R Grant was issued with a warning.</p> <p><b>PRINCESS RAAJ</b> (M Coleman) and <b>COVERED 'N BAY</b> (A Jones) were both slow to begin.</p> <p><b>INTO THE MYSTIC</b> (A Collett) shifted in jumping away forcing <b>YA THINK</b> (D Danis) inwards which made firm contact with <b>ORANGE ROUGHIE</b> (C Grylls).</p> <p><b>ORANGE ROUGHIE</b> was steadied shortly after the start when placed in restricted room.</p> <p><b>WEE SONYA</b> (T Thornton) made the bend near the 1200 metres awkwardly when over-racing shifting out making firm contact with the hind quarters of <b>LIBRETTI</b> (V Colgan) which was momentarily unbalanced.</p> <p><b>YA THINK</b> made the bend near the 1200 metres awkwardly shifting out forcing <b>COVERED 'N BAY</b> wider on the track, with <b>YA THINK</b> and <b>COVERED 'N BAY</b> then racing wide for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>Rider L Allpress admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount <b>KITTYKITTYBANGBANG</b> to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of <b>LIBRETTI</b> (V Colgan) which was checked when crowded onto the hind quarters of <b>INTO THE MYSTIC</b> near the 1000 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended L Allpress' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 14 May up to and including racing on 20 May, 4 riding days.</p> <p><b>WEE SONYA</b> was held up until near the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>KITTYKITTYBANGBANG</b> lost the right front plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>WAIPA WORKINGMENS CLUB 1150</b>
<p><b>SPRING SHOW</b> (S McKay) raced ungenerously when being steadied near the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>OKAGBARE</b> (L Allpress) raced wide for the majority of the race.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>VERNON AND VAZEY TRUCK PARTS LTD 1150</b>
<p><b>RIGHT SAID FRED</b> (T Thornton) and <b>RAPID AS</b> (U Holmquist) were both slow to begin.</p> <p><b>DUKE OF SUSSEX</b> (S McKay) was steadied when briefly placed in restricted room approaching the 350 metres.</p> <p><b>SENASSY</b> (S Collett) and <b>MONEY TRAIL</b> (M McNab) came together momentarily near the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>REDOUBT BAR &amp; EATERY 1150</b>
<p><b>MORSE CODE</b> (S Collett), <b>INA CANTA</b> (M McNab) and <b>CIVIQUE ROSE</b> (T Thornton) were all slow to begin.</p> <p><b>STAR AMAZING</b> (L Satherley) commenced to lay out shortly after the start and approaching the 800 metres had to be firmly restrained by its rider losing ground with <b>INA CANTA</b> becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels near the 600 metres having to be steadied.</p> <p><b>UNCONQUERED</b> (L Allpress) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>UNCONQUERED</b> was steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 350 metres when weakening.</p> <p><b>STAR AMAZING</b> raced greenly in the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>UNCONQUERED</b> rider L Allpress was of the opinion that the colt may be feeling the effects of recent racing.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination of <b>CIVIQUE ROSE</b>, which trailed the field throughout, revealed the filly to be suffering from shin soreness.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>VE VETERINARY SERVICES 1150</b>
<p><b>IL ROSSO</b> (S McKay) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>FALKIRK LASS</b> (B Hutton) had to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>GLOSS</b> (C Lammas) was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring <b>BEWITCHED</b> (A Jones) near the 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>FIBRE FRESH 1150</b>
<p><b>CONRWIN</b> (R Grant) began very awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>CLUBS CHOICE</b> (A Collett) failed to make the bend near the 800 metres running wide. A warning was placed against the mare's racing manners.</p>	
<b>Race 10</b>	<b>FAIRVIEW MOTORS 2000</b>
<p><b>IRISH GEM</b> (L Magorrian) began awkwardly shifting out making contact with <b>GOTTA KEEPER</b> (S Collett).</p> <p><b>RADAR</b> (E Farr) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>GOTTA KEEPER</b>, when racing keenly, was steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1700 metres.</p> <p><b>THE SNOW QUEEN</b> (L Allpress) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>GOTTA KEEPER</b> raced keenly before being allowed to improve forward near the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>ANA</b> (L Satherley) went off stride approaching the 600 metres losing ground inconveniencing <b>SOUTHERN POWER</b> (V</p>	

Colgan).

**ROYAL SCEPTRE** (T Thornton) was briefly held up entering the final straight.
