RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TWILIGHT RACES @ HASTINGS 10/12
FRIED RICE (J Parkes) was slow away. DAL TE EN TEE (R Goldsbury) over-raced in the early and middle stages. FRIED RICE lay out rounding the final turn. INASTRIDE (J Riddell) and NOLAWOOD (C Grylls) came together early in the final straight. The track was upgraded to Good(3) retrospective to Race 1.	
Race 2	HB RACING AGM 24/11
INZAABAA (M Dravitzki) and TONY SOPRANO (D Bradley) were slow to begin. THE GREAT GURU (M McNab) was crowded leaving the barriers. BAD BOY BROWN (K Myers) after being posted three wide was taken forward early in the back straight when the pace eased.	
Race 3	LIVAMOL OPTIMISER 1400
ARROW IN THE SAND (K Myers) jumped away awkwardly. SAOVOYA (C Grylls) was held up near the 150 metres having to shift inwards across the heels of MAE WEST (R Myers) to obtain clear running.	
Race 4	STELLA ARTOIS 1200

THE BANDITO (J Riddell) raced ungenerously when being restrained going into the bend near the 800 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **AUXSOELUSIVE** (K Myers) which shifted inwards. **THE BANDITO** then made the turn awkwardly hampering **POROTENE DIVA** (L Allpress) and **ABBEY ROAD** (J Parkes).

THE BANDITO, LADY PINOT (C Lammas), **ABBEY ROAD, POROTENE DIVA** and **BLACK LABEL** (R Goldsbury) all over-raced in the middle stages when the pace came out of the race. C Grylls the rider of **TALITA** was spoken to regarding the extent which he had eased the pace.

ABBEY ROAD was inclined to lug inwards throughout the final straight.

BLACK LABEL had to be straightened near the 100 metres when laying in.

GARDONE (C Grylls) jumped away awkwardly hampering **THE CANON** (M Dravitzki) which lost ground.

THE CANON had to be steadied shortly after the start when **SIR DARCI** (C Lammas) shifted inwards. C Lammas was advised to exercise more care.

DALEZINGA (R Myers) raced three wide without cover.

SIR DARCI shifted outwards across the heels of **CHARLESTOWN** (K Myers) to obtain clear running passing the 50 metres.

WRONG BELT (L Allpress) was slow away.

JUBILANT (C Grylls) shifted outwards jumping away hampering **MIGHTY THUNDER** (C Lammas) which lost ground.

SILVER SHADOW (D Bradley) raced wide without cover around the first turn when improving forward.

Race 7	TRINITY HILL 1400

Several runners anticipated the start when the gates did not open after the starter had depressed the start button. This was found to be due to the power not being connected which was rectified and a start effected. After questioning Starter Mr G Phillips he was advised by Stewards to modify the start procedure prior to each race to prevent any repetition.

PERCY'S JAZZ (R Hannam) was slow away.

CORSAIR (L Magorrian) raced keenly in the run along the back straight.

CILLA CROSS (K Smith) raced three wide without cover.

When questioned regarding the performance of **WISEMAN'S FAIRY** rider D Bradley was unable to offer any excuses but was of the opinion that the filly would be better suited by some easing of the ground. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 8	STOCKNZ INDEPENDENT LIVESTOCK AGENTS 1400

MISSY MOO (A Jones) was steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start.

DONNA BEEL (L Magorrian) hung out rounding the final turn dictating **GOODSAV** (L Allpress) outwards making contact with **RUNNY HONEY** (K Myers).

BELLA COURT (D Bradley) raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight placing **MARE MIA** (J Parkes) in restricted room near the 100 metres before being corrected by its rider. **BELLA COURT** then shifted inwards abruptly making contact with **MARE MIA** just short of the finish. The connections of **MARE MIA** viewed Stewards footage of the incident before electing not to proceed with a protest.
