RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	LIQUORLAND TE AWAMUTU 1580
<p>ALL ON RED (M McNab) and PANORAMA (L Allpress) were slow to begin. SHIMMY (S Collett) jumped away awkwardly. PANORAMA was inclined to lay in when racing wide without cover throughout. Passing the 500 metres MARIPOSA (L Magorrian) when shifting out off heels made contact with PANORAMA. AMAZING LADY (V Colgan) was briefly held up early in the final straight shifting out across heels to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.</p>	
Race 2	BOXING DAY @ PIRONGIA 1580
<p>STACCATO (L Allpress) was slow to begin. Passing the 200 metres STACCATO commenced to shift inwards with ROC THAT (M McNab) shifting away from that runner causing crowding to TOKOMUTU JUDGE (S McKay) which when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of ROC THAT had to steady and shift inwards crowding KENTUCKY SON (T Thornton) which had to be steadied. M McNab was advised to exercise care when riding his mounts out to the finish.</p>	

Race 3	BDO 1400
<p>DOWNTON ABBEY (S Spratt) was slow to begin. YNGVARR (U Holmquist) jumped away awkwardly shifting in making firm contact with OUR ABBADEAN (M McNab) with YNGVARR becoming briefly unbalanced. Near the 1300 metres M McNab allowed his mount OUR ABBADEAN to shift in when not clear of LE PETITE ROUGE (S Collett) which had to be checked losing ground. Jockey M McNab admitted a breach of careless riding and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 17 November until the conclusion of racing on 20 November, 3 riding days. DOWNTON ABBEY and ROYAL POWER (L Magorrian) both over-raced through the early and middle stages. SAVASON (L Allpress) and YNGVARR both raced wide without cover throughout. Passing the 150 metres OUR ABBADEAN shifted in abruptly inconveniencing SAVASON.</p>	
Race 4	FILLIES BREEDING SYNDICATE 1150
<p>NIGHT VOYAGE (L Allpress), SNEAKYSID (R Norvall) and SECLUDED (S McKay) were all slow to begin. Approaching the 800 metres MONEY TRAIL (S Collett) had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed inside the heels of POINT TAKEN (V Colgan), and continued to over-race for a distance. POINT TAKEN made the bend awkwardly passing the 700 metres shifting out into the line of I'M ALL EARS (Z Nor Azman) which had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of POINT TAKEN which then continued to lay out taking DINAH LEE (C Lammas) wider on the track. SNEAKYSID was held up early in the final straight having to shift in across the heels of MONEY TRAIL to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres. When questioned into the performance of the favourite MONEY TRAIL rider S Collett advised the gelding got left a little flat footed when the pace increased, and would be looking for more ground, also would take improvement from the race.</p>	
Race 5	PAPER PLUS & TOYWORLD 2000
<p>SHEEZ THE BOSS (L Allpress) and I'M ALL YOURS (R Elliot) both began awkwardly. STRALIS (A Collett) got its head up when being restrained passing the winning post on the first occasion. GOTTA KEEPER (S Collett) was inclined to lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 6	HARNESS @ WAIPA 29 DECEMBER 2000
<p>THE KAKAHU EXPRESS (C Lammas) and RESULT MERCHANT (M McNab) were both slow to begin. RESULT MERCHANT shifted out abruptly approaching the 1150 metres when well back, and was not persevered with from near the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer Mr B Jones advised Stewards that he may consider spelling the gelding. SUM FAVOUR (D Hain) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 7	VE VETERINARY SERVICES 1150
<p>HALLELOOJAH (L Allpress) and COPS 'N' COYOTE (E Smith) were both slow to begin. HALLELOOJAH after being slow away improved quickly to the inside of HES CALLINGCALLING (U Holmquist) which had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of I'M BRONSON (K Myers). ELUSIVE KITTY (R Elliot) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of DEELIGNA (S McKay) passing the 800 metres. Passing the 200 metres ELUSIVE KITTY lay in under pressure with RIO CLARO (M McNab) shifting away from that runner making contact with I'M BRONSON which shifted in crowding HALLELOOJAH which was weakening. Passing the 100 metres HALLELOOJAH lay out with HES CALLINGCALLING shifting away from that runner making contact with MAGNIFIER (Z Nor Azman) with both those runners becoming briefly unbalanced. SANTIAGO (S Collett) lay in under pressure over the final 100 metres.</p>	
Race 8	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>LADY FERNER (L Magorrian) began awkwardly shifting out making contact with MOONRAKER (S Collett). ALL RAZZLE DAZZLE (V Colgan) raced wide for the majority of the race.</p>
