### RACE COMMENTS:

# Race 1 MILLS REEF WINERY HANDICAP (2200 metres)

**MASTER THOMAS** was late scratched by the stewards at 12.37pm after dislodging rider J Riddell during the preliminary and galloping a distance. Jockey J Riddell was examined by paramedics and cleared to resume.

**CULLISTER** was slow away.

**PICCADILLY** was held up rounding the final turn.

**SAVARHYS** raced in restricted room near the 200 metres when improving into a run to the inside of **NO CHANGE**, which rolled in slightly under pressure. **MAITRE DU JEU** was briefly crowded to the inside of **SAVARHYS** as a result.

#### Race 2 ECOLAB 3YO MAIDEN (1200 metres)

**ROCK ON** was slow away.

**WATERBERG** (M Cameron) and **BLACK SAV** both jumped away awkwardly and came together making solid contact with M Cameron becoming badly unbalanced. **FLYING QUEST** which had been slow to begin was further hampered as a result of this incident.

**ALL IN VOGUE** began awkwardly, shifting inwards abruptly crowding **SLEEK SECRET**, **DEEDEE PANACH** and **TAKE THE TRICK**. **SLEEK SECRET** (L Allpress) had to be steadied shortly after the start to avoid the heels of **WEAPON OF CHOICE (K Smith)**, which shifted inwards. K Smith was advised to take more care.

PRINCESS BELLE raced greenly in the home straight and shifted out near the finish bumping with BLACK SAV.

**FLYING QUEST** was held up for several strides approaching the 100 metres when in restricted room.

TERRACOTTA WARRIOR raced wide throughout.

Rider A Collett had no excuse for the run of IRISH BOUNTY which failed to finish the race off as expected.

# Race 3 NUFARM MAIDEN (1400 metres)

**LOVETOKEEPHIM** jumped in the air at the start losing ground.

CANNY MAGIC began awkwardly making contact with MASTER JACK.

**MISS INTERPRETED** (R Goldsbury) made contact with **BRICKLEBERRY** when attempting to force a run near the 300 metres. R Goldsbury was advised to exercise greater care.

**Te Baker (FRUITION)** was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the riding master after he allowed his mount to drift wide rounding the final turn.

**VITALIA** had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight.

**KIRRA BELLE** hung outwards under pressure in the final straight making contact with **MASTER JACK** passing the 100 metres. **FRUITION** raced wide without cover throughout.

When questioned into the run of **MANEO INVICTUS**, rider L Allpress reported the filly was inclined to change legs in the early and middle stages and was unsuited to racing in close quarters in the home straight.

# Race 4 PIONEER HANDICAP (2100 metres)

**SAMPSON** raced three wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres with **RED MAFIA** then left three wide without cover from this point onwards.

**AUTHENTIC PADDY** raced keenly in the middle stages.

WEREGOINGTOGETCHA was steadied to shift outwards across the heels of RED MAFIA near the 350 metres.

When questioned regarding the run of **SLAZENJAH**, rider J Parkes had no real excuse other than the gelding may improve with the race.

# Race 5 FARM SOURCE HANDICAP (1600 metres)

THATZ LOUIE was slow away.

**MASTER FIN** raced wide without cover throughout.

# Race 6 TRU TEST HANDICAP (1600 metres)

**ANTONIO** began awkwardly.

**NYMPHE MONTE** galloped up on to the heels of **JUST A LOVER** passing the 200 metres and had to be angled inwards to improve.

**TIE ME DOWN** had a tendency to lay out under pressure in the final straight.

**FLINT** raced three wide without cover.

# Race 7 SEALES WINSLOW HANDICAP (1600 metres)

**OUTSPOKEN** began awkwardly making solid contact with **JACKSSTAR** which lost ground.

**DUKEBOX** was slow away.

**KALINGA** raced three wide without cover.

**TEXAS YELLOW ROSE** was held up near the 400 metres when on the heels of **LET'S** and then a short distance further had to shift ground outwards to improve.

JACKSSTAR was held up passing the 150 metres.

KAIRANGA LAD was held up for a short distance approaching the 200 metres.

**OUTSPOKEN** returned to the enclosure with a laceration to the near side front leg which required veterinary attention.

#### Race 8 HYDROFLOW HANDICAP (1200 metres)

CASINO over-raced in the back straight making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly hampering MCLAREN.

**UNBELIEVEABELLE** raced three wide without cover.

**SPEECH CRAFT** was held up early in the final straight and when shifting out to obtain clear running made contact with **CASINO** near the 250 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of IRISH ENCORE, rider R Myers was unable to offer any excuses.

**DESIGNATED DRIVER** required veterinary attention following the race for a laceration to the right hind leg.

# Race 9 FARM SOURCE HANDICAP (1400 metres)

JOBY was slow away.

**CENTRE CROSS** had to be steadied to avoid the heels of **STOWAWAY** (U Holmquist) which shifted inwards near the 1200 metres when not fully clear. **Apprentice U Holmquist** was issued with a warning. **CENTRE CROSS** then over-raced, having

to shift outwards to avoid the heels of **STOWAWAY** which was being restrained by its rider passing the 1100 metres.

**STOWAWAY** then raced three wide without cover.

MISS BENCI over-raced badly near the 1000 metres when being restrained, becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance.

**JOBY** had to be angled outwards to improve near the 200 metres when denied a run.

**LEEDS** raced in restricted room near the post.

**STAR O'FRAAJ** raced wide throughout and was not persevered with in the final straight when rider L Allpress considered something amiss. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**Apprentice jockey T Kahlon** (ZORRALI) will be spoken to by the stewards after leaving the course without permission and for the manner in which she used her whip in the home straight.
