RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Dargaville Benchmark R65 2000
SPECIAL DUKE (L Magorrian) raced keenly in the early to middle stages and as a result hung out making the first bend.	
Race 2	Lion Red Maiden 1000
MACAKIZI (L Magorrian) was slow away. ESTEEM (A Jones) began awkwardly, shifting out, making contact with the hind quarters of PORTFOLIO (A Collett) which became briefly unbalanced. FOURTEEN (S Spratt) stumbled leaving the barrier. SEGENHOE (S Collett) began awkwardly and then was restrained in the early stages. FOURTEEN made the 800 metre bend awkwardly, having to be steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of RONCHI (G Cooksley) with FOURTEEN then continuing to race ungenerously for a distance. YWAHOO (L Innes) raced wide without cover throughout. NIPABRANDY (U Holmquist) raced wide for the majority of the race. ROYAL VISION (M McNab) was briefly held up when angling for a run to the outside of SEGENHOE approaching the 200 metres when that runner shifted out slightly. Rider L Innes reported that YWAHOO had made irregular breathing noises and underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality. Trainer T Pike undertook to report anything that may become	

apparent in days subsequent, further advising the irregular breather may have been a result of the filly becoming uptight after being obliged to race wide.
Apprentice Rider **L Magorrian** admitted a breach of Rule 649(1)(a) in that he attempted to weigh out without a body protector. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$1400.

Race 3 Kumara Capital R65 1400

HEAD SPIN (S Collett) began awkwardly losing ground.
CULLCH FORTY FIVE (L Magorrian) and **SKYWARDS** (M McNab) both began awkwardly making contact and losing ground.
CULLCH FORTY FIVE over-raced in the early to middle stages.
SIR SAVA (G Cooksley) was held up early in the final straight shifting out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 4 City of Auckland Supporters Group Maiden

ACEDECEE (M McNab) began awkwardly, shifting out making contact with **MAYTRA DEE** (M Hills).
ACEDECEE and **MAYTRA DEE** both over-raced when being restrained passing the 900 metres.
When questioned regarding the performance of **SUPREME ADDITION** Rider S Collett advised that the filly may be feeling the effects of the firmer nature of the track.

Race 5 Farmlands Maiden 1400

LIBIAMO (S Collett) began awkwardly, losing ground, and then over-raced through the early and middle stages.
PETER'S FINGER (M Hills) was slow away.
SISTER O'REILLY (S Spratt) shifted out leaving the barrier, making contact with **COHABITATE** (A Collett).
LIZ'S GIFT (U Holmquist) raced wide without cover and had a tendency to over-race through the middle stages. Passing the 600 metres **HAPI GIRL** (Zy Nor Azman) became awkwardly placed on heels.
LIBIAMO shifted in abruptly under pressure passing the 150 metres having to be corrected by its rider.
SISTER O'REILLY was unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.
When questioned regarding the performance of **VAN GOGH** Rider L Innes advised that the horse had raced greenly and would improve with the experience.

Race 6 Nauman Insurance Northland Cup

CHEEKY BOY (M Hills) became fractious in its barrier stall and was removed to undergo a veterinary inspection and was declared a late scratching at 3.29pm.
SMEDLEY (L Magorrian) began awkwardly, shifting out and crowding **STORMING THE TOWER** (A Jones) which lost ground.
NOBLE WARRIOR (Z Moki) lay in shortly after jumping away, hampering **ZAFRENZY** (A Collett) which had to be steadied, losing ground.
FARAWAY EYES (Z Nor Azman) raced wide around the first bend until being allowed to work forward and obtain the lead passing the 1300 metres.
SMEDLEY (L Magorrian) had difficulty obtaining clear running inside the final 200 metres.

Race 7 Stud Breeders Maiden 2000

JUST CALL ME MARG (G Cooksley) and **BATTLE PLAN** (L Innes) both began awkwardly.
TAMA AKARANA (Z Nor Azman) stumbled leaving the barrier, shifting out and making contact with **SILVER TIPS** (U Holmquist) forcing that runner outwards, hampering **HILARIOUS** (M McNab) which lost ground.
ARITE GURU (Z Moki) began awkwardly shifting in and when being corrected shifted out, hampering **JUST CALL ME MARG** which lost ground.
SILVER TIPS (U Holmquist) commenced to race fiercely approaching the winning post on the first occasion. Approaching the winning post on the first occasion **TAMA AKARANA** commenced to over-race placing Rider Z Nor Azman in difficulty. **TAMA AKARANA** then shifted out near the 1400 metres when racing fiercely, crowding **ARITE GURU** on to the hind quarters of **BATTLE PLAN** which shifted in. As a result **ARITE GURU** was hampered losing ground.
CARD SHARK (M Hills) over-raced when being restrained in the early stages running wide when making the bend near the 1600 metres. **CARD SHARK** then raced ungenerously for a distance and approaching the 1200 metres became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **BATTLE PLAN** having to steady.
RUNNING SMOOTH (L Magorrian) had to steady approaching the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **BATTLE PLAN**.
Passing the 1100 metres **SILVER TIPS** which had been over-racing, shifted out forcing **GLOBAL WARRIOR** (S Spratt) wider on the track. **GLOBAL WARRIOR** then was allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader.
HILARIOUS (M McNab) became awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 600 metres and shifted out abruptly. Approaching the 200 metres **JUST CALL ME MARG** had to be steadied when crowded between **HILARIOUS** and **LOWRIDER** (A Jones) both of which shifted ground.

Race 8**ITM R65 1200**

Trainer **R Patel** was advised a warning would be placed on record, after he presented OFFANGONE to race without notified gear (blinkers).

REPULSE BAY (M McNab) and **CONNOR JOHN** (M Hills) both began awkwardly, losing ground.

Approaching the 1000 metres **ENJOY THE RIDE** (A Collett) shifted in becoming briefly unbalanced when making contact with **CONNOR JOHN**.

Passing the 1000 metres **STREET WARS** (G Cooksley) ducked out abruptly, making contact with **REPULSE BAY** forcing that runner wider on the track. **STREET WARS** then continued to hang out through the middle stages.

Passing the 300 metres **STREET WARS** shifted in to obtain clear running and then was held up over the final 100 metres.

Rider L Innes advised that **FIERTE** had not been suited by today's track conditions.
