RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 BETHLEHEM MOTOR INN 1600

CAPTAIN CAVALIER (S Spratt) knuckled leaving the barriers, and then lay in with **TASHA AIMEE** (L Magorrian) shifting away from that runner crowding **ULTIMATA** (C Lammas) which was steadied.

I'LLAV BUBBLES (A Jones) blundered leaving the barriers.

CAPTAIN CAVALIER lay in when linking on to the course proper approaching the 1400 metres crowding **BUSTER ABBOTT** (L Satherley) which was hampered losing ground.

Passing the 1300 metres **THE HASSLER** (V Colgan) shifted inwards crowding **TASHA AIMEE** which had improved to that runner's inside. **TASHA AIMEE** then made contact with the hind quarters of **BUSTER ABBOTT** which lay out further crowding **TASHA AIMEE** which was hampered losing ground. V Colgan was issued with a warning.

I'LLAV BUBBLES raced wide throughout.

Passing the 800 metres **BUSTER ABBOTT** gave ground when briefly crowded to the inside of **SPENDIDO** (G Cooksley) which lav in.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BUSTER ABBOTT** rider L Satherley advised that the gelding had felt field shy when racing amongst other runners, also adding that it may be better suited by some easing of the ground.

Race 2 SEA CONTAINERS NZ LTD 1400

CARLOTTA (Z Moki) was slow to begin before being crowded by **SILVERDALE** (C Lammas) which shifted outwards after beginning awkwardly.

MOSSE (V Colgan) raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained passing the 1000 metres on a moderate pace. **YSABELLA BRAVE** (U Holmquist) lay out when making the final bend.

Race 3 O'CONNOR WARREN INSURANCE BROKERS 3YO

L Magorrian replaced D Turner on **DEL RIOS** as D Turner was unable to ride at his declared riding weight. After speaking with trainer Mr A Forsman and apprentice D Turner, given the circumstances of the engagement no charges were preferred on this occasion with D Turner being issued with a warning.

KEANDRA (R Norvall) and FIVE OFF THE TEE (B R Jones) were both slow to begin.

O'DIANNE (S Spratt) was crowded leaving the barriers between **BILLY MOJO** (S Collett) and **DEL RIOS** (L Magorrian), both of which began awkwardly.

ALAMER (M Hills) began awkwardly.

BILLY MOJO commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1200 metres becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of **RANGIPO** which shifted in.

LINK ROAD (L Satherley) commenced to over-race passing the 1250 metres shifting out and hampering ALAMER.

MURIWAI (C Lammas) raced greenly once placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 4 INGHAM MORA – A SURE BET FOR GREAT BUSINESS ADVICE 1300

GETALONGHOME CINDY (Z Moki) became fractious in the barriers, getting its left foreleg caught for a period before being removed and declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.12 p.m. Trainer Mr S Ralph was advised that the mare must barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward before racing next.

COUNTING HOUSE (L Satherley), FLAVIGNY (G Cooksley) and TWYA (L Magorrian) were slow to begin.

GRACEHILL (C Lammas) began awkwardly making contact with EIGHT POINTS (V Colgan).

AREZZO (M Hills) and **AMUSE** (B R Jones) were crowded between **BRILLIANT MAGIC** (A Schwerin) which began awkwardly shifting outwards and **ZUCCATO** (S Spratt) which shifted inwards leaving the barriers.

MAREEBA (S Collett) had to be steadied when crowded for room to the inside of **BORN HAPPY** (L Hemi) near the 700 metres. Apprentice L Hemi was advised to exercise care.

ZUCCATO raced three wide without cover.

GRACEHILL was held up entering the final straight near the 350 metres, and when shifting out to obtain clear running lay out inconveniencing **MEESKA MOOSKA** (A Jones) passing the 200 metres.

MAREEBA which was weakening had to be steadied near the 250 metres when crowded for room by **COUNTING HOUSE** which when improving to the inside of **BORN HAPPY** was taken in by that runner. When being steadied **MAREEBA** went back on to **TWYA** which was hampered. L Hemi was advised to exercise care.

EIGHT POINTS was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight, and when rider V Colgan was swapping the whip into his left hand rolled out into the line of **BRILLIANT MAGIC** which was steadied.

BRILLIANT MAGIC shifted outwards crowding TRONIC ROSE (D Hain) on to AMUSE (B R Jones) near the 50 metres.

Race 5 KONING WEBSTER LAWYERS TAURANGA 1200

BIGGIN HILL (V Colgan) knuckled leaving the barriers shifting out and crowding **ADMIRAL** (C Lammas).

RICH BILLIE MARSH (S Spratt) shifted inwards abruptly leaving the barriers hampering **CAELLUM** (G Cooksley) which lost ground. As a result **CARNAVALITO** (R Norvall) was also hampered and steadied.

TWOZNOTENOUGH (A Schwerin) was a little slow to begin.

ADMIRAL raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

CAELLUM had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting outwards passing the 200 metres.

TWOZNOTENOUGH was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of **PACKING TYCOON** (L Magorrian) passing the 200 metres.

Race 6 STELLA ARTOIS TAURANGA STAKES

KAWI (B R Jones) began awkwardly losing ground.

SURVIVED (C Lammas) began awkwardly making contact with SIERRA BEEL (S Collett).

SAKHEE'S SOLDIER (L Magorrian) was a little slow to begin.

SURVIVED raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

After recovering from its poor beginning **KAWI** commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 1300 metres, and continued to do so through the middle stages.

SURVIVED made the bend passing the 1000 metres awkwardly hampering **SHUKA** (V Colgan).

SORIANO (G Cooksley) was badly held up passing the 250 metres then having to angle outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.

KAWI was held up approaching the 200 metres, and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until improving into a tight run between **JULINSKY PRINCE** (S Spratt) and **SIERRA BEEL** (S Collett) near the 50 metres and when doing so made contact with **SIERRA BEEL**.

When questioned regarding the performance of **SAKHEE'S SOLDIER** apprentice L Magorrian advised the gelding had only weakened late in the race, and in his opinion would benefit further from today's run. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 7 IXOM 1600

SOUL SISTA (S Spratt) stood in the barriers when the start was effected losing approximately 15 lengths. The connections were advised that **SOUL SISTA** is now required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

MARCIANO (L Magorrian) shifted outwards leaving the barriers crowding **WOODSMAN** (A Jones) and **IRISH** (B R Jones) on to **CALL ME ROYAL** (L Satherley) which was hampered losing ground.

THE MIG (L Hemi) was slow to begin before being further hampered when crowded.

SOLO (S Collett) shifted inwards leaving the barriers further hampering **HEEZA DREIMER** (Z Moki) which had begun awkwardly.

ZADIFFRA (C Lammas) commenced to over-race when being restrained passing the 1400 metres and raced ungenerously for a distance shifting inwards passing the 1200 metres crowding **CALL ME ROYAL** onto **WOODSMAN** which was hampered losing ground.

IRISH commenced to over-race passing the 1200 metres. Going into the bend passing the 1000 metres, **ENDEAN ROSE** (U Holmquist) shifted outwards away from **IRISH** simultaneously as **HEEZA DREIMER** shifted inwards with **THE MIG** being buffeted between those two runners. Apprentice Z Moki was advised to exercise care.

WOODSMAN which was racing adjacent to the running rail shifted outwards rounding the bend near the 900 metres forcing **SOLO** over extra ground. **WOODSMAN** then raced very wide for the remainder of the bend. Apprentice A Jones, in the presence of the Riding Master, was questioned regarding her riding tactics and advised that **WOODSMAN** had in the past been reluctant to improve between runners so she had opted to shift to the outside for clear running. Miss Jones' explanation was noted, but she was advised that she would be expected to show better judgement in future.

THE MIG and **HEEZA DREIMER** both raced wide without cover.

SOUL SISTA got its head up when being steadied rounding the final turn after becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 350 metres.

CALL ME ROYAL which was laying inwards early in the final straight had to be briefly steadied near the 300 metres when **LUGROSVE** (V Colgan) shifted outwards to obtain clear running.

Race 8 DOMINATOR GARAGE DOORS TAURANGA 1600

TORRICELLA (R Elliot) shifted inwards leaving the barriers crowding **BEE TEE JUNIOR** (S Collett) onto **A RED PRINCE** (S Spratt) with **BEE TEE JUNIOR** and **A RED PRINCE** both having to steady losing ground.

SO IT GOES (L Magorrian) raced wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 700 metres.

OSMUNDA (B R Jones) and **SILK CHARDONNAY** (A Jones) raced wide throughout.

QUINTASTICS (L Satherley) was held up for a distance passing the 300 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **A RED PRINCE** rider S Spratt advised that the entire had tended to race greenly, and in her opinion would be better suited by some easing of the ground.

Race 9 MILLS REEF WINERY & RESTAURANT 2100

Trainer Ms M Murdoch was fined \$50 after presenting **AUGUSTA NATIONAL** (U Holmquist) to race without an item of notified gear (blinkers).

ON PAROLE (L Hemi), **VICTORIA HEIGHTS** (S Spratt) and **MARTINIZ SPECIAL** (Z Moki) all began awkwardly losing ground. **HER CHOICE** (G Cooksley) raced keenly in the lead in the early and middle stages.

Passing the 1700 metres HER CHOICE (G Cooksley) shifted inwards making contact with VARRO (L Satherley).

EKSUUDE (S Collett) and **VICTORIA HEIGHTS** commenced to race ungenerously when making the bend leaving the straight on the first occasion with **EKSUUDE** running wide.

ON PAROLE commenced to race fiercely when awkwardly placed on the heels of **CASTLE BEE** (L Magorrian) approaching the 1400 metres.

EL PISTOLA (C Lammas) commenced to improve wide from near the 800 metres.

EKSUUDE had to be steadied approaching the 600 metres when crowded for room between **AUGUSTA NATIONAL** and **EL PISTOLA** which lay in when improving to the outside of **EKSUUDE**. C Lammas was advised to exercise care. Inconvenienced as a result was **MARTINIZ SPECIAL**.

ON PAROLE ran wide rounding the final turn taking **EL PISTOLA** over extra ground.

VICTORIA HEIGHTS lay out near the 300 metres making contact with **MARTINIZ SPECIAL** with **VICTORIA HEIGHTS** being steadied. **VICTORIA HEIGHTS** continued to lay out under pressure and was unable to be fully ridden out as a result.
