RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BOTTLE-O PAHIATUA STAYERS (2200 metres)
<p>SCARAMOUCHE began awkwardly shifting out making contact with TONY SOPRANO with that runner then shifting out making heavy contact with O'REN ISHII, which had to steady, losing ground.</p> <p>BARTOLI had to steady shortly after jumping away when awkwardly placed on the heels of THE ORANGE PONY.</p> <p>OURS raced keenly early.</p> <p>SCARAMOUCHE was inclined to lug inwards in the home straight.</p> <p>O'REN ISHII hung throughout losing considerable ground, placing the rider at a disadvantage. Connections advised that they were unlikely to persevere with the mare as a racing proposition. Stewards advised that O'REN ISHII must trial if the decision is made to continue.</p> <p>GEM TWIST hung throughout so must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to its next start.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of TONY SOPRANO rider D Bradley could offer no excuse.</p> <p>Following the running of Race 1 the track conditions were retrospectively downgraded to Slow (8).</p>	
Race 2	MATT & MARION HICKEY SPRINT (1200 metres)
LILLY PINS began awkwardly.	

Race 3	DAVID TIMMINS ELECTRICAL SPRINT (1200 metres)
<p>Starter G Phillips was questioned by the Stewards after the race started at 2.14pm when the scheduled start time was 2.15pm. An inquiry was opened and adjourned pending further investigation.</p> <p>STAROSSA became fractious on the track prior to being mounted to go to the start. The filly was then taken back to the saddling stalls to be mounted and went to the start assisted by the Clerk of the Course. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the racing manners of STAROSSA.</p> <p>GREAT HASTE shifted in on jumping away making contact with ROCK OF ACES which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>STAROSSA and SHE WOLF came together on jumping away when both runners shifted ground, resulting in STAROSSA losing ground.</p> <p>LINCOLN'S LEGACY began awkwardly, shifting in making firm contact with AUXSOELUSIVE, with both runners becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>DAN CUGAT got its head up making the 800 metre bend awkwardly shifting out hampering PIECE OF KATE which lost ground.</p> <p>Near the 500 metres ROCK OF ACES had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of GREAT HASTE which shifted out.</p> <p>R Hannam the rider of LINCOLN'S LEGACY was advised to exercise greater care after he allowed his mount to shift out passing the 400 metres inconveniencing PAUA EYES and ROCK OF ACES.</p>	
Race 4	REX & DIANE WANSBROUGH 1400 METRES
<p>ESTIMATE became fractious in the barriers and lunged the gates resulting in the starter having the filly undergo a veterinary inspection. After being removed from the gates ESTIMATE escaped from the attendant so was late scratched by the stewards at 2.53pm. Connections were advised that ESTIMATE must trial to the satisfaction of the stewards prior to its next start.</p> <p>LET ME THINK shifted out shortly after jumping away crowding LAVISH PRINCE, which had to be steadied.</p> <p>SPECIAL BID began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>Near the 1300 metres LAVISH PRINCE faltered and was pulled up by rider C Lammas, suffering from a fractured near foreleg so was humanely euthanized.</p> <p>SHE KNOWS bumped with LINCOLN PARK on the point of the turn and then raced in restricted room for a short distance.</p>	
Race 5	MARTIN BEVERIDGE PAINTERS & DECORATORS 1400 METRES
<p>SCOOTA KING shifted in abruptly on jumping away hampering TOBY'S CHOICE, which lost ground.</p> <p>SHINDANO, MARA NA EIRE and TOBY'S CHOICE had to be steadied when the pace eased approaching the 800 metres.</p> <p>RON'S LAST raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Early in the home straight VITALIA was held up for a short distance on straightening.</p> <p>SWISS EXPRESS was inclined to lay out in the home straight.</p> <p>Rider S McKay reported that TOBY'S CHOICE was unsuited to today's track conditions.</p>	
Race 6	PURPLE HAZE LAVENDER AND CAFÉ 1400 METRES
<p>THIRTYLOVE began awkwardly making contact with the side of the barriers and was unbalanced.</p> <p>MORSE CODE began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>TAKE CARE was slow away.</p> <p>SAUVIGNON raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TAKE CARE had to momentarily steady near the 200 metres when LINCOLN'S SUNSET shifted in under pressure.</p> <p>Rider R Myers reported that HOKEY POKEY was unsuited to today's track conditions.</p>	
Race 7	STEPHEN SMITH ENGINEERING 1600 METRES
<p>DREAMCRUZA and LAPSAGLO were both slow away.</p> <p>Passing the 1100 metres FOXVILLE had to be firmly restrained off the heels of GOLD LABEL (R Goldsbury) when the pace steadied. R Goldsbury confirmed the stewards' observations that the filly slowed of its own accord when racing greenly.</p> <p>MISS NORWAY had to be steadied and angled out to avoid heels near the 900 metres.</p> <p>FOXVILLE commenced to give ground passing the 800 metres and went back on to PLACID which had to be steadied off heels.</p> <p>DREAMCRUZA lay in near the 800 metres tightening BLUSHING MOSS prior to being straightened.</p> <p>C Dell reported that FOXVILLE was never comfortable in the track conditions and was not persevered with.</p>	
Race 8	NEW WORLD PAHIATUA 1600 METRES
<p>DAL DANTRIX began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>CAFÉ CULTURE was slow away.</p>	

DAL DANTRIX commenced to over-race through the early and middle stages and then near the 800 metres had to be firmly restrained off the heels of **TIBERIUS**.

Near the 350 metres **STAR EMERALD** became unbalanced and went off stride free of interference.

CASTUP raced greenly in the home straight.

R Goldsbury (DAL DANTRIX) was reminded of her obligations with regard to her use of the whip on a horse not in contention.
