RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ECOLAB MAIDEN 1100 M

MASTER WONG was slow to begin.

WOLF KING jumped away awkwardly.

WOLF KING and ALWAYS READY raced wide without cover for the majority.

CLICHE over raced in the early and middle stages.

Following the running of race 1 the track was down graded to Dead 6.

Race 2 ANTON MORA & SON PAINTERSM 1400 M

ACCLAIM and **EPIC** were both slow to begin.

WESTERN and **ACCLAIM** over raced in the early and middle stages.

FACEUP raced wide without cover throughout.

WESTERN made the final turn awkwardly dictating NEVERSTOPDREAMING and ALLMOSTA wider on the track.

ACCLAIM raced greenly throughout.

Race 3 ICE ELECTRICAL MDN 1800 M

MAJESTIC STRIDER took control of the rider and galloped a distance before being recaptured. MAJESTIC STRIDER

underwent a veterinary examination and was passed fit to run.

MAJESTIC STRIDER was slow to begin and then commenced to over race in the early and middle stages.

HUSHED began awkwardly shifting in inconveniencing **LASTLAHA**.

WHITE DIAMOND lay out leaving the barriers crowding MOUNTAIN MAN which had to steady.

MOPSY had to steady passing the winning post on the first occasion when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **CHATEAU ROC.** As a consequence **MOPSY** dropped back on to **SAKURA** and **MOUNTAIN MAN** which both had to steady abruptly. After questioning riders it was established that **MOPSY** had over reacted when being restrained to trail which had resultant

consequences for trailing runners.

BLAZING OPAL made the first bend awkwardly running wide.

MOUNTAIN MAN over raced in the early and middle stages.

MAJESTIC STRIDER improved to the inside of SAKURA when racing fiercely near the 1000 metres with MAJESTIC STRIDER then shifting out forcing SAKURA wider which crowded WHITE DIAMOND on to the hind quarters of OMA ELLE, with WHITE DIAMOND having to be steadied.

LASTLAHA when weakening had to steady after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **WHITE DIAMOND** near the 600 metres.

WHITE DIAMOND and ANY STREAM WILL DO came together entering the final straight.

Race 4 STELLA ARTOIS 1800 M

CAVALRY jumped away very awkwardly with rider R Myers becoming unbalanced. **CAVALRY** then when racing ungenerously threw its head in the air contacting rider R Myers losing momentum. R Myers was examined by medical personnel and cleared to ride.

EMPIRE LASS and **LAMASON** both began awkwardly.

SKYCHI and **STREET SMART** came together on jumping away.

HEISTHEONE commenced to over race passing the 1600 metres.

LAMASON raced keenly in the middle stages.

STREET SMART was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight having to be straightened by its rider on several occasions.

Race 5 LA NUOVA APPARELMASTER 1800 M

LANGDON and **TE HANA** were slow in the early stages.

BIOLOGIST over raced in the early and middle stages.

LANDLORD was crowded briefly passing the 250 metres when inside **MUSCAT HILLS** which lay in momentarily.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BIOLOGIST** rider J Riddell could offer no tangible excuse other than the gelding may have struggled with the 59kg on a rain affected track.

LANGDON weakened over the final stages with Trainer Mrs K Zimmerman advising the Stewards that in her opinion something may be amiss with the gelding and that **LANGDON** would undergo an endoscopic examination following today's race with the outcome to be advised to the Stewards.

Race 6 HAMILTON VETS MDN 1400 M

VICTORIAS LEGACY and LEDBURY came together leaving the barriers.

POMPEII TIGER over raced in the middle stages, shifting out forcing HI FIVER wider on the track.

SKUFFLE improved onto the heels of the weakening **BRECON BEAU** near the 400 metres and had to steady.

Race 7 COMCAT 1400 M

REDALIGN blundered leaving the barrier.

WILLBEOKAY and SILVER COURT made firm contact on jumping away.

WILLBEOKAY was inclined to lay out over the final 100 metres when placed under pressure.

When questioned regarding the performance of **REDALIGN** which was eased down early in the final straight, rider J Parkes stated after blundering and getting back in the running the gelding failed to make any ground and was disappointing.
