RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WENTWOOD GRANGE 1000
O'GUY (S Spratt) began awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of SKELTER (M McNab) losing ground. SO CONSPICIOUS (L Magorrian) was a little slow to begin. O'GUY was steadied when in restricted room to the inside of NACHOS (T Thornton) approaching the 850 metres. SO CONSPICIOUS hung outwards throughout. O'GUY shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 350 metres.	
Race 2	LANGSFORD – N&G LTD 1200
THEVERDICT (L Satherley) and SPARKLING SWORD (D Johnson) were both slow to begin. BACHRO (C Lammas) began awkwardly. THEVERDICT raced ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 800 metres. BACHRO raced wide without cover.	

SNOWDON LILY (C Grylls) lay out passing the 500 metres making contact with BEATNIK (M McNab) becoming briefly unbalanced.	
Race 3	STABLECRAFT 1200
<p>TICKET TO RIDE (M Hills) began awkwardly making contact with PIAF (M Coleman).</p> <p>CASING THE JOINT (L Allpress) had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of PIAF which was shifting in with CASING THE JOINT then shifting in crowding MANDALAY (C Grylls) with both those runners having to be steadied near the 1000 metres. Jockey M Coleman was issued with a warning.</p> <p>GOLDEN COIN (O Bosson) got its head up when being restrained approaching the 900 metres for a distance.</p> <p>TICKET TO RIDE made the 800 metre bend awkwardly when racing wide, and continued to race wide for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>GOLDEN COIN lay out under pressure passing the 350 metres inconveniencing TICKET TO RIDE.</p> <p>PIAF raced greenly over the final 300 metres</p> <p>CASING THE JOINT commenced to lay out under pressure passing the 200 metres taking TICKET TO RIDE over extra ground. The connections of TICKET TO RIDE wished to view the films as to lodging a protest, but elected not to proceed.</p>	
Race 4	PORRITT SAND 1600
<p>FAME SEEKER (C Lammas) received veterinary attention on arrival at the races after transport difficulties and was cleared fit to race.</p> <p>ARCHDUCHESS (S Collett) began awkwardly, and then was crowded and hampered by DARK ARTS (O Bosson) which shifted away from ICECOLD (G Cooksley) which had begun awkwardly, with ARCHDUCHESS having to steady losing ground. As a result SURE ENOUGH (L Innes) was also steadied losing ground.</p> <p>SIMULATOR (M Hills) over-raced in the early and middle stages. Rider M Hills recommended to the connections that a tongue-tie be applied for its next start.</p> <p>DARK ARTS, ICECOLD, ARCHDUCHESS and TESSASTOCK (C Grylls) all over-raced when the pace steadied passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>SURE ENOUGH (L Innes) was briefly held up early in the final straight.</p> <p>ICECOLD was not persevered with over the final 200 metres. When questioned rider G Cooksley advised the gelding had hung throughout, and had also got its tongue over the bit. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 5	RAFFLES FARM 1600
<p>APPREHEND (O Bosson) sustained a small laceration under the left jawl whilst being transported to the meeting, and after undergoing a veterinary examination was passed fit to race.</p> <p>SUSIE WOLFF (M McNab) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Near the 1200 meters HIGH FINANCE (M Hills) had to be firmly restrained off the heels of WHO DARES WINS (M Cameron).</p> <p>MOONRAKER (S Collett) had to be restrained off the heels of HIGH FINANCE approaching the 1000 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 1000 metres BLUE PRINT (S Spratt) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of HIGH FINANCE, and dropped back on to APPREHEND which had to be firmly restrained for a distance. BLUE PRINT then was obliged to race wide for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>Passing the 450 metres TWINKLES (D Johnson) had to be firmly restrained off the heels of the weakening PURE LORDE (K Myers) dropping back on to APPREHEND which also had to be firmly restrained with TWINKLES and APPREHEND both being held up for a distance in the final straight before obtaining clear running passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>BLUE PRINT lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>TWINKLES lost the left hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 6	BATTLE PAINT 1600
<p>Trainer Mr R Manning was fined \$50 after failing to declare blinkers for TEENA ROX (D Johnson) by the required time. TEENA ROX was permitted to race in blinkers given that it had only had one previous race day start on 1 January 2015, was having its first start from Mr Manning's stable, and had worn blinkers when winning at its most recent trial appearance.</p> <p>BON MARCHE (M Coleman) reared as the start was effected losing ground.</p> <p>MANGAROA TAHI (K Myers) and REMIND ME AGAIN (A Jones) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>SECOND FLING (M McNab) shifted out leaving the barriers making contact with EXCITE ME (A Schwerin) which shifted away from that runner.</p> <p>BASIL BRUSH (S Collett) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers having to steady.</p> <p>KECHIKA (O Bosson) raced wide before being allowed to improve forward to lead near the 900 metres.</p> <p>MANGAROA TAHI lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres finishing wide on the track.</p> <p>SAROOKH (T Thornton) raced greenly in the final straight once placed under pressure.</p>	

Race 7	MONOVALE SAND 1400
<p>SAFFRON LADY (A Collett) put its head down as the start was effected losing ground (3L).</p> <p>LUPELANI (Z Moki) shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers hampering ROSEANA'S SPIRIT (M Coleman) and IT'S COMPLICATED (L Innes).</p> <p>RIGHT SAID FRED (S McKay) made the 800 metre bend awkwardly running wide taking LADY ARABELLA (C Lammas) over extra ground. RIGHT SAID FRED then continued to hang out until into the final straight.</p> <p>Approaching the 450 metres LUPELANI improved into a tight run making contact with the hind quarters of SAVUNO (S Collett) which had to be steadied, dropping back on to LADY ARABELLA which was hampered.</p> <p>SAFFRON LADY commenced to shift ground outwards passing the 300 metres, and continued to shift out when being ridden forward, and passing the 100 metres shifted out abruptly off the heels of PHOEBE SNOW (O Bosson), and continued to shift out taking SAVUNO over extra ground. After questioning riders concerned jockey A Collett was issued with a warning.</p>	
Race 8	COOLMORE AUSTRALIA 1600
<p>TROJAN WARRIOR (L Allpress) and BOB VALDEZ (Z Moki) were crowded between TRONIC ROSE (D Hain) and BLUE FLAG (O Bosson), both of which had begun awkwardly.</p> <p>YOU ARE AMAZING (A Collett) was very slow to begin.</p> <p>SAVED BY THE BELL (S Collett) raced ungenerously when being steadied for a distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>ANA (M Cameron), TRONIC ROSE and ELLE GRACE (L Satherley) all raced in restricted room going into the bend near the 900 metres.</p> <p>TROJAN WARRIOR had to be restrained off the heels of LAAFFAIRE (D Johnson) passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>SAVED BY THE BELL had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of RYKER (M Coleman) passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>YOU ARE AMAZING was briefly held up early in the final straight having to shift in across the heels of ELLE GRACE (L Satherley) to obtain clear running.</p> <p>ANA was unable to obtain clear running until passing the 300 metres.</p>	
Race 9	FLAIR – 20TH BIRTHDAY 1200
<p>SALTED CARAMEL was a late scratching at 1.38 pm on veterinary advice.</p> <p>FIERTE (L Magorrian) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>CHACHAR (M McNab) shifted out leaving the barrier crowding TEMPLE TIGER (B R Jones) and MODERATION (L Allpress) which had begun awkwardly, and then was steadied losing ground.</p> <p>FIERTE commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 900 metres.</p> <p>TEMPLE TIGER raced keenly through the middle stages, and had a tendency to lay out.</p> <p>SHOT IN THE DARK (O Bosson) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>CHACHAR and SHOT IN THE DARK came together early in the final straight when both runners shifted ground. SHOT IN THE DARK continued to lay in for the remainder of the race.</p>
