RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 GOLDPINE MORRINSVILLE 2200

FAST PROFIT (B R Jones) was reluctant to enter the barriers. During this delay **MR BARAQ** (M Cameron) reared and became cast in the barriers. After being removed **MR BARAQ** was declared a late scratching at 12.33 pm on veterinary advice. The stable representative was advised that **MR BARAQ** is now required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward before racing next. The connections of **FAST PROFIT** were advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the gelding.

FAST PROFIT jumped away awkwardly.

KIDNAPPED (T Thornton) raced keenly in the early stages.

EL PISTOLA (C Lammas) made contact with **FAST PROFIT** when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 400 metres.

ZAVIERA (L Innes) shifted outwards making contact with GOTTA KEEPER (S Collett) near the 50 metres.

EL PISTOLA raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

Race 2 GRAND TAVERN 2200

THORNBURY (S McKay) was slow away.

ITSABIRD (R Norvall) jumped away awkwardly, hampering THE KAKAHU EXPRESS (S Spratt).

SIH RAH (A Jones) and AMPARO (A Collett) both over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.

MON TRESOR (Z Moki) raced wide without cover until near the 1200 metres.

MARKWOOD (L Magorrian) shifted out approaching the 800 metres forcing **EL HEALO** (U Holmquist) to race three wide for a distance.

ITSABIRD was held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight.

AMPARO lost the off hind plate during the running.

Race 3 MERRY CHRISTMAS 1400

LANAKAY (A Jones) and HAFEMEISTER (K Myers) both jumped away awkwardly.

PARK RISE (L Magorrian) was slow away.

Passing the 900 metres **DARE TO DREAM** (S Collett) was steadied shifting back on to **SENECA LAKE** (O Bosson) which raced ungenerously for a short distance.

CARDINAL SIN (C Dell) commenced to race ungenerously passing the 900 metres shifting back on to **LANAKAY** which also commenced to race ungenerously. **CARDINAL SIN** then was inclined to lay out when making the bend.

ON THE EDGE (T Thornton) over-raced in the early to middle stages.

BUGLE CALL raced three wide without cover. **BUGLE CALL** (M Coleman) then ran wide making the final turn and raced greenly in the final straight.

ON THE EDGE was held up early in the final straight, obtaining clear running approaching the 200 metres.

SENECA LAKE was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

Race 4 TE AROHA MOWERS & CHAINSAWS 1400

SUMMALUCKY (D Johnson) began awkwardly making solid contact with **WOLFF SPIRIT** (K Myers) which was crowded on to **SUPREME ADDICTION** (S Collett) further hampering that runner which had been slow away.

GUMBOOTS (S Spratt) jumped inwards leaving the barriers making contact with **BONNY EMILIA** (L Innes) which was forced inwards, hampering **DANZABEEL** (M Coleman).

Passing the 1300 metres **BELLE OF MAPPERLEY** (C Grylls) shifted in abruptly, crowding **LEON** (S McKay) which was hampered and steadied. Rider C Grylls was advised he must ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground, and further advised that a warning would be placed on his record.

Approaching the 1000 metres **GUMBOOTS**, **BONNY EMILIA** and **SUMMALUCKY** all raced in restricted room to the inside of **MACKINTOSH** (V Colgan) with **BONNY EMILIA** shifting away from **GUMBOOTS** further crowding **SUMMALUCKY** which was hampered and steadied. Hampered as a result was **MIK JAGGER** (L Magorrian). V Colgan was advised that he must exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

COVERED 'N BAY (M Hills) raced wide without cover.

MIK JAGGER was inclined to lay out when making the turn.

IT CAN ONLY BE YOU (M Cameron) raced greenly approaching the 200 metres and when being corrected by its rider shifted out slight inconveniencing **TWIST THE WIND** (T Thornton) which shifted away from that runner.

SUMMALUCKY shifted in and away from **BELLE OF MAPPERLEY** (C Grylls) becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 200 metres.

MIK JAGGER which was not persevered with in the final straight underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which found the gelding to be mildly lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr G Cameron advised the gelding would now be spelled.

MACKINTOSH received veterinary treatment following the race after pulling the left front plate in the tie-up stalls.

Race 5 TE AROHA STALLION PLACEMENT SCHEME 1000

RED RAVEN (S Spratt) was hampered leaving the barriers.

RED RAVEN raced greenly shortly after the start going off stride losing considerable ground.

OUR TRIXIE (S McKay) became unbalanced when bumped shortly after the start.

PRECISION MISS (K Myers) had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres, and when shifting out made slight contact with **HIS MAJESTY** (O Bosson) which then shifted away from that runner.

ACRE (Z Nor Azman) raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight shifting out and hampering **MARSHAL** (M Cameron) near the 200 metres.

The Stewards opened and adjourned an inquiry into the ride aboard the third placed runner **KATIE'S SO KOOL** by apprentice rider A Jones.

Race 6 BEN COLLINS ELECTRICAL 1000

PACE SETTER (C Grylls) jumped away awkwardly.

AL PACINO (S McKay) was crowded leaving the barriers.

BALLYBAY (O Bosson) over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.

PRINCESS MICHELLA (D Johnson) raced wide without cover throughout.

BULLDOZER (L Magorrian) had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the final straight.

SABER (S Olney) was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. Apprentice rider S Olney was reminded of her obligations to ride her horses out fully to the finish when circumstances permit her to do so.

Rider A Jones (BUFFALO LASS) dropped her whip near the 400 metres.

Race 7 TE AROHA SUPPORTERS CLUB 1200

ALL THE RAAJ (C Grylls) was slow away.

DARCI'S DAUGHTER (S McKay) was crowded leaving the barriers.

MISS HOROTIU (M Coleman) blundered jumping away.

OVER TORQUE (C Lammas) raced wide without cover.

ROGART (U Holmquist) raced fiercely for a distance passing the 800 metres.

LOUISETTE'S DREAM (A Schwerin) raced greenly throughout, running wide in the final straight.

ALL THE RAAJ (C Grylls) shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres, hampering **NIPABRANDY** (S Collett) and **DARCI'S DAUGHTER**. C Grylls admitted a breach of careless riding, with his licence to ride in races being suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on 28 November up to and including racing on 5 December, 3 riding days.

Race 8 DON HAWTIN MEMORIAL 1200

FLORENCE IN FRANCE (S McKay) blundered jumping away, hampering MODEL AYE (L Magorrian).

HIFLYER (S Collett) and NEDDY NADEEM (A Jones) were slow away.

CUPID (M Coleman) became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **COOL CASTLE** (A Schwerin) passing the 900 metres when linking on to the course proper and was hampered.

PLUS FOURS (M Cameron) over-raced in the early to middle stages, and hung outwards. **PLUS FOURS** continued to hang out running wide rounding the final turn, and was unable to be fully ridden out. Trainer D Guy was advised that a warning would be placed against the colt's racing manners.

MODEL AYE (L Magorrian) raced ungenerously when becoming awkwardly placed on heels and hung out passing the 450 metres, and went off stride, losing ground.

HIFLYER was held up passing the 400 metres, and when looking to obtain clear running became awkwardly placed on the heels of **EDWARD** (D Johnson), striking a heel and shifting out abruptly, hampering **MEGAWATT** (O Bosson) and **NEDDY NADEEM** (A Jones).

Race 9 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200

RUBY FOUR SHOES (V Colgan) blundered badly jumping away.

BOTANIC (L Innes) began awkwardly making contact with **LILYPUT** (S Spratt) which was forced inwards crowding **AUGUST EDITION** (M Cameron) on to **DOLBADARN** (S Collett).

DINAH LEE (M Coleman) shifted inwards leaving the barriers with **CONJURING** (T Thornton) shifting away from that runner hampering **SCARLET'S SECRET** (O Bosson).

PADRONA (B R Jones) raced fiercely in the early stages.

TALITA (C Lammas) raced wide throughout.

RUBY FOUR SHOES went off stride passing the 600 metres shifting back on to **DINAH LEE** which was then forced wide on the track. **RUBY FOUR SHOES** continued to race ungenerously and give ground, and was not persevered with in the final straight. **RUBY FOUR SHOES** was found to have cast the left fore shoe, and having struck itself, suffering a lacerated heel bulb, requiring treatment veterinary treatment.

Race 10 TE AROHA VETERINARY SERVICES 1600

BEYOND REACH (S Spratt) knuckled jumping away and shifted inwards crowding **BABILLONI** (C Lammas) on to **GERRY MERITO** (Z Moki).

GOLD HUNTER (K Myers) was slow away.

IRISH GEM (C Dell) began awkwardly making contact with **HIDDEN TREASURE** (M Coleman) then shifting inwards away from that runner hampering **KEANDRA** (T Thornton).

PEACH BELLINI (S Collett) shifted inwards abruptly crossing the junction on to the course proper approaching the 1400 metres, despite the efforts of its rider, hampering **TRIGGER** (O Bosson), **SYLVIAN** (L Magorrian) and **KEANDRA**.

BABILLONI raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

HIDDEN TREASURE raced wide throughout.

TRIGGER commenced to give ground when placed under pressure passing the 500 metres, and continued to do so in the final straight shifting. **TRIGGER** underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities. Trainer D Guy advised **TRIGGER** would now be spelled.
