Late Scratchings:	Race 1 MISS FORTUNE – by order of the Stewards at 3.52pm.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NIGHTCAPS CONTRACTING / O'MEARA CRUTCHING MAIDEN (1600M) MISS FORTUNE dislodged rider T Direen during the preliminary and escaped riderless for a considerable distance before being recaptured by the clerk of the course. MISS FORTUNE was subsequently declared a late scratching by order of the Stewards at 3.52pm. Rider T Direen was uninjured in this incident. The start of this event was delayed approximately 4 minutes due to the above. DREAM DIVINE began awkwardly and raced wide throughout. CONCEAL raced keenly in the early stages and lay inwards in the early stages of the final straight. PADDY BLACK raced keenly in the early stages. I DON'T KNOW was steadied near the 1400 metres when in restricted room.
Race 2	CLOVERTONE / CALDWELL BUILDING & ELECTRICAL MAIDEN (1600M) GUNNA BEGOOD stood in the gates as the start was effected losing ground and was very slow in the early stages. REDDY TO RAZZLE got its head up in the early stages when racing keenly. ZAH GOOD ONE raced keenly in the early stages. MISS TUSCAN raced wide for the majority of the event and lay outwards rounding the final bend. LOCHAN ORA lay outwards in the early part of the home straight. When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding apprentice rider K Kalychurun advised LOCHAN ORA had failed to travel at any stage and had been disappointing when placed under full pressure. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination of the gelding which revealed no significant findings.

Race 3	H.E.N. BATT & SON HANDICAP (1600M)
<p>FALENA began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>DOCTOR EDEN got its head up passing the 1300 metres when being steadied with the trailing SHAKTI steadied in consequence and shifting outwards, hampering CAIRNSVILLE on its outside.</p> <p>CLAREVILLE FLIGHT was caught wide through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>LETTHETHUNDERROLL raced wide from the 800 metres.</p> <p>SHAKTI shifted ground outwards near the 150 metres and lay outwards over the concluding stages, having to be straightened in the shadows of the post.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner SALLY GETCHA GUN rider T Moseley reported that the mare had received an economical run throughout however had disappointed when placed under full pressure and he could offer no tangible excuses.</p>	
Race 4	SLEEMANS ELECTRICAL / McHUGH BUILDING MAIDEN (1200M)
<p>FOURMACS and OH NOVA were both slow to begin.</p> <p>OH NOVA raced greenly in the early stages.</p> <p>THE COVER GIRL (J Lowry) got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 1100 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of ABELL ROAD (S Wynne) which shifted inwards. THE COVER GIRL continued to race keenly for a short distance thereafter. Miss Wynne was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.</p> <p>VINO TINTO and NOTHINLYKHER bumped heavily at the 1100 metres with VINO TINTO shifting outwards abruptly unbalancing NOTHINLYKHER momentarily.</p> <p>THE COVER GIRL made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly when on the heels of CARMODY.</p> <p>GUN LAW made contact with the running rail passing the 800 metres and blundered losing ground.</p> <p>SMOKEM UP shifted outwards passing the 100 metres and hampered VINO TINTO out onto NOTHINLYKHER.</p> <p>On returning to scale following the running of this event VINO TINTO shied at another horse dislodging apprentice rider R Cuneen with the filly falling to the track and upon regaining its feet making heavy contact with the outside fence. R Cuneen was examined by the St John Ambulance Paramedics and found to be uninjured in this incident. VINO TINTO was subjected to a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have suffered no injuries.</p>	
Race 5	COMMERCIAL HOTEL / LINTON CONTRACTING MAIDEN (1200M)
<p>RAISING AL began awkwardly settling at the rear of the field.</p> <p>ROBIN CHARLES raced keenly and wide in the early stages.</p> <p>BINGO BENNY raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>TOP PRIZE and ELECDDES raced wide throughout.</p> <p>UNICO was steadied momentarily passing the 300 metres when awkwardly placed between KRUGER RAND and ROBIN CHARLES.</p> <p>CHANCERY LANE shifted inwards near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 6	PETE FAULKS MASTER DAGGER HANDICAP (1200M)
<p>TINKA TINKA began awkwardly losing several lengths.</p> <p>TINKA TINKA then over raced in the early stages and raced wide for the majority of the event.</p> <p>SWITZER began awkwardly.</p> <p>THE THEME was held up over the early stages of the run home.</p> <p>ALL THINGS NICE was steadied for a short distance passing the 600 metres and was held up for a short distance passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>SIR JACK REMINGTON lay outwards passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>DOM BENEDICTINE was steadied passing the 100 metres when STAND YOUR GROUND shifted outwards under pressure.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner BUCKWILD apprentice rider H Bennett advised the gelding had been unable to obtain the lead today and had also carried extra weight which had taken its toll.</p>
