MARQUATEER lay in under pressure in the final straight with rider S McKay electing to change his whip into his left hand

Race 3	TIMBERCO MAIDEN 1200M					
WESTERN began	awkwardly and settled back.					

ALL CHARM raced three wide without cover throughout.

WESTERN made the 400 metres bend awkwardly.

When questioned regarding the performance of **HOLD THE PHONE** which after racing prominently, was not persevered with over the final 200 metres. Rider O Bosson had no excuse. Stewards requested a veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 4

NULOOK ALUMINIUM & DOORS 1200M

DEVIL'S HARMONY blundered on jumping away.

ELLIE'S EMPRESS was crowded shortly after the start between CELTIC CROSS and REPULSE BAY both of which shifted ground.

POINT PERCY was inclined to get its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

IT'S ALRIGHT raced three wide without cover throughout.

DEVIL'S HARMONY lay inwards under pressure over the final 100 metres and had to be straightened.

Race 5 TARANAKI WINNERS CIRCLE MAIDEN 1400M

FIRST OF A KIND refused to jump away on terms, effectively losing all chance. Stable representative Mr A Peard was advised that **FIRST OF A KIND** must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to next racing.

SEWREEL shifted out leaving the barriers forcing **DIX SEPT** and **FUN N GAMES** into the line of **MR DAVINCI** which was crowded losing ground.

IT'S MAGIC was buffeted shortly after the start between BRECON BEAU and SPRITZ.

BRECON BEAU raced wide throughout.

Near the 600 metres **MR DAVINCI** raced up onto heels and when being steadied shifted out and bumped **DOGMATIC.**

Race 6 REVITAL FERTILISERS 1400M

WILLBEOKAY jumped outwards leaving the barriers hampering RUNWAY which lost ground.

WILLBEOKAY commence to hang outwards rounding the turn effectively taking no further part. Connections were advised that the mare must trial satisfactorily prior to its next start.

MAESTRO shifted out under pressure over the final stages briefly hampering **LETMETHINK**.

Race 7 FAST TRACK INSURANCE MAIDEN 1600M

ECHEZEAUX reared after being loaded away, then got down in its gate so was subsequently scratched at approximately 5.11pm by order of the Stewards. Co-trainer J Richards was advised that **ECHEZEAUX** must barrier trial satisfactorily prior to racing next. ECHEZEAUX subsequently required veterinary attention for minor lacerations.

A warning was placed against **INDECENT PROPOSAL** with regard to its barrier manners after being fractious in the gate. **BOCELLI** was slow to begin.

THE HASSLER was crowded leaving the barriers between KECHIKA and MORSE CODE which shifted outwards.

BOCELLI commenced to over race after making the crossing near the 1400 metres, proving difficult to restrain so was angled outward then raced wide from the 1200 metres.

ROSEADAY and **INDECENT PROPOSAL** both raced greenly throughout.

KECHIKA raced greenly throughout the final straight. O Bosson the rider of **KECHIKA** reported the mare had been indifferent in its action over the final stages. The Stewards ordered a veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 8 FIRST NATIONAL MILLS & GIBBON RATING 65 1800M

ANDALUCI was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers and got back.

BORDEAUX lay in leaving the barriers resulting in DA SHINDIG being crowded with DA SHINDIG getting back.

EFFECTAV raced wide around the first turn.

HEISTHEONE raced keenly in the middle stages.

SIR SAVA over raced in the middle stages.

DA SHINDIG was held up entering the final straight and had to shift inwards near the 250 metres to obtain clear running. **BORDEAUX** shifted out near the 250 metres briefly crowding **KING NERO** which was attempting a run to the outside of **BORDEAUX**.

SIR SAVA was held up rounding the final turn and only obtained clear running near the 150 metres.

HEISTHEONE was inclined to lay in over the final stages and had to be straightened.

When questioned into the run of **ANDALUCI** which finished last, rider O Bosson said although the gelding was disappointing it was possibly better suited to a longer distance.
