RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TEMUKA SEED (1984) LTD 2YO+ MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>TWILIGHT METEOR shifted out at the start crowding NAME OF THE STARS which lost ground. NAME OF THE STARS lay in passing the 1000 metres and raced ungenerously into the first bend. DONTPOKETHETIGER raced wide through the early stages.</p> <p>TWILIGHT METEOR and HEARTS OF STONE both raced wide for the majority of the race. VICAR'S DAUGHTER improved onto the heels of PINSHARP passing the 800 metres, clipping a heel and blundering momentarily, resulting in the trailing SHEZA DIAMOND and FAIRLIGHT both having to be restrained. Also hampered were NAME OF THE STARS and DIAMONDS INMY HALO, with DIAMONDS INMY HALO racing greenly for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>PINSHARP lay in passing the 250 metres, with rider M Cameron swapping the whip to the left hand. NAME OF THE STARS raced greenly in the straight and lay in, making contact with the rail near the 200 metres. FAIRLIGHT had to be steadied passing the 50 metres when improving onto the heels of DONTPOKETHETIGER.</p> <p>When spoken to regarding the performance of WEEDY, rider T Moseley advised that the gelding had only raced fairly and he could offer no tangible excuses.</p>	
Race 2	TEMUKA TRANSPORT (1967) LTD 1200 RATING 75 (1200m)
<p>ASTROTURF got back through the early stages and was out paced for the majority of the race. DO UNO WHOIAM raced wide in the early stages.</p>	

<p>MAL D'MOUR raced keenly in the middle stages. MAL D'MOUR was held up momentarily early in the run home.</p>	
Race 3	D'CASH & PORT FM DASH RATING 85 (1200m)
<p>PINS GOLD began awkwardly and got back. JACK'S RUN and FLIRTY GERTEY both raced ungenerously for a short distance passing the 1000 metres due to the lack of pace. FLIRTY GERTEY lay in under pressure passing the 125 metres and had to be straightened. MADAM BENTLEY and NEWS FLASH brushed passing the 100 metres. s</p>	
Race 4	SOUTH CANTERBURY SILAGE LTD SPRINT RATING 65 (1200m)
<p>SPIDER LILY was slow to begin and further hampered when SWITCHED ON shifted out abruptly at the start. JEAN'S WAY began awkwardly and got back as a result. METALWORKER was crowded and lost ground shortly after the start when FATHER WAYNE which was laying out shifted out. SPIDER LILY had to be steadied at the 1000 metres when crowded by ZIPPIN which was making the bend awkwardly. STRIKE UP THE BAND raced wide throughout. JEAN'S WAY and METALWORKER brushed passing the 200 metres when both runners shifted ground. Apprentice P Shaikh (DYNAMIC) was spoken to advisedly regarding his use of the whip between the 200 and 100 metres. When spoken to regarding the improved performance of DYNAMIC, trainer M Pitman advised they had changed the gelding's working routine which included a course of swimming which resulted in a better performance today.</p>	
Race 5	THE JOLLY POTTER STAYERS RATING 75 (2100m)
<p>CANTINA began awkwardly and settled at the rear of the field. SPEEDY JAX began to race keenly for a short distance passing the 1200 metres as the pace steadied. CANTINA attempted to improve wide from the 800 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner CANTINA, rider A Collett advised that the mare was uncomfortable on today's Dead (4) track. The connections advised that consideration will be given to sending the mare for a spell.</p>	
Race 6	JOHNNY WALSH 1600 RATING 75 (1600m)
<p>WISE MOVE began awkwardly and got back. MONTRACHET and PENNYS FROM HEAVEN raced wide throughout. BRIDGET TOWN was held up early in the run home. When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner EDENSONG, rider M Cameron advised that the uneven tempo of today's race had not suited the mare's racing style.</p>	
Race 7	DAVE GRANT & NEIL KINGSTON MILE MAIDEN (1600m)
<p>SO GALLANT (A Chan) was slow to begin and then improved wide to be outside of the leader passing the 1000 metres, and when shifting in momentarily crowded WAVE RACER which had to be steadied. Apprentice rider A Chan was advised to exercise greater care. VILLA ELBA raced wide throughout. Passing the 300 metres VILLA ELBA (K Mudhoo) which was laying in shifted in dictating WAVE RACER which was also laying inwards onto LETIZIA which was crowded and had to steady. Apprentice rider K Mudhoo was advised to exercise greater care and ensure he straightens his mount sooner. STOLEN HEART was held up early in the run home and had to be steadied passing the 250 metres and shift ground outwards to find clear racing room. LINDIS PASS lay in passing the 300 metres, momentarily crowding BLUE POOL BLUR which had to be steadied. VELVET ROSE shifted grounds outwards at the 300 metres and was momentarily held up when awkwardly placed on heels near the 200 metres. Apprentice rider A Chan in the presence of riding mentor W Harnett was shown a replay of his ride on SO GALLANT for educational purposes.</p>	
Race 8	GERALDINE VILLAGE INN SPORTS BAR MILE RATING 65 (1600m)
<p>The start was delayed approximately 3 minutes due to the horses arriving late at the start area. ROYAL DOLLAR was slow to begin MISS MIA was slow in the early stages. MAGGIE'S SECRET raced wide in the early stages.</p>	

PERFECT SECRET raced in restricted room in the final 50 metres.
