RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	AON INSURANCE STAYERS
<p>ROCK ROSE (S Collett) began awkwardly. CRAFTY LADY (S McKay) shifted outwards leaving the barrier hampering AL MUNROE (R Hannam) which lost ground. ROCK ROSE raced keenly in the early stages and passing the winning post on the first occasion got its head up when being restrained off the heels of LA QUIANTE (K Smith). RATHGAR (R Myers) commenced to over-race in the back straight and was shifted outwards to avoid heels near the 800 metres forcing ROCK ROSE wider. HARE BAWL (L Hemi) had to be angled off the heels of DAL DUNVEGAN (J Parkes) near the 100 metres to improve.</p>	
Race 2	AWASSI/C R GRACE 1200
<p>NIGHT VOYAGE (M McNab) was slow to begin. BEEFEATER (K Myers) raced keenly in the early and middle stages. REVOLUTION (J Parkes) raced three-wide without cover throughout. HOSKINS (K Smith) had difficulty obtaining clear racing room until near the 100 metres. LIANA shifted out under pressure near the 250 metres bumping with SHE WOLF which in turn made firm contact with ALY'S BELT. A short distance further, ALY'S BELT was buffeted between BEEFEATER and NIGHT VOYAGE when BEEFEATER shifted out into clear running</p>	

THE BANDITO (R Myers) shifted outwards over the final stages simultaneously as **BEEFEATER** (K Myers) was improving to its outside, resulting in **BEEFEATER** being momentarily hampered. Rider R Myers was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

The connections of the second placed **BEEFEATER** viewed footage of the final stages but elected not to proceed with an objection against the winner **THE BANDITO**.

Apprentice R Goldsbury reported that her mount **PAUA EYES** got its tongue over the bit during the running and was not able to ride the mare to full advantage in the final straight.

NIGHT VOYAGE lost its off-front plate during the running.

Race 3 | **PGG WRIGHTSON 1200**

KINGOFPLATINUM dislodged rider J Parkes during its preliminary and galloped a short distance prior to being re-captured, with a subsequent veterinary examination clearing **KINGOFPLATINUM** to start.

KINGOFPLATINUM was slow to begin after being dictated wider when **MACFINN** (S Collett) shifted outwards (4L).

MACFINN raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained.

TEMPLE TIGER (S McKay) bumped with **EDGE OF GLORY** (U Holmquist) near the 800 metres.

Race 4 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE**

ALL IN VOGUE (J Parkes) jumped outwards leaving the barrier hampering **MANEO INVICTUS** (L Hemi) and **PRINCESS BELLE** (D Bradley) which were both forced wider.

Apprentice D Turner was issued with a warning under rule 638 (1)(d) after he allowed his mount **YWAHOO** to shift inwards near the 1000 metres when not clear of **CELLAR** (M McNab) which had to be steadied. Stewards took into account outward movement from **ROYAL RUBY** (R Hannam) when assessing the degree of interference.

MANEO INVICTUS had to be straightened near the 250 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **ALL IN VOGUE**, rider J Parkes could offer no tangible excuse however was of the opinion the filly may benefit with a longer distance.

Race 5 | **RURAL AIR WORK/BREWS WAIPAWA 1400**

SCARLET AURORA (K Smith) shifted outwards on jumping bumping with **SHINDANO** (J Parkes) which in turn bumped **KURATAU** (S Collett) which lost ground.

SHINDANO raced greenly throughout and passing the 800 metres shifted outwards resulting in **SCARLET AURORA** being checked. **SHINDANO** then shifted very wide on the turn near the 450 metres taking **KURATAU** over considerable extra ground.

SCARLET AURORA raced greenly throughout.

THE KEPT LADY (M McNab) had to be straightened near the 150 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BELLE BOY**, rider D Bradley reported that despite ducking inwards near the 200 metres and having to be straightened, he could offer no real excuse and was disappointing.

Race 6 | **LEOPARD HOTEL CHRISTMAS CUP**

SIR GUS (D Turner) and **TIBERIUS** (R Hannam) came together and bumped on jumping.

A RED PRINCE (S Collett) reared and lost ground at the start.

SAVARHYS (S McKay) began awkwardly and was slow away.

RED MAFIA (L Hemi) raced three-wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

A RED PRINCE raced three-wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

SANJARA and **TIBERIUS** were held up in the early stages of the home straight until near the 250 metres.

SAVARHYS was inclined to shift inwards under pressure over the final stages.

NO CHANGE lost its off-hind plate during the running. Following the race **NO CHANGE** showed signs of lameness which was attributed to the shoe being displaced.

Race 7 | **BEST TRAVEL MILE**

ROCK ON (R Hannam) was slow to begin (4L).

ROUGH RULER (S Collett) got its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

PLACID (J Parkes) raced keenly in the early stages.

ROYAL POWER (M McNab) was inclined to lug outwards rounding the turn and near the 800 metres bumped with **CASH DEAL** (U Holmquist).

CASH DEAL shifted inwards passing the 400 metres and had to be steadied off the heels of **LIBRETTI** (D Bradley).

GATES OF EDEN (K Smith) commenced to give ground near the 800 metres and was not persevered with thereafter. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer G Vile advised that he would monitor the progress of the filly in the coming days.

Race 8

CHB RAM BREEDERS MILE

KING SAMBO (J Parkes) was tightened shortly after the start, losing ground.

IRISH WHISPER (M Dravitzki) and **MERITAGGIO** (D Bradley) came together and bumped near the 350 metres.

HANDLEMEWITHCARE (L Hemi) had to be steadied over the final stages when racing up onto the heels of **STEELFIX** (R Myers).

When questioned regarding the performance of **KING SAMBO**, rider J Parkes reported that after being tightened shortly after the start, he had got further back than intended and was of the opinion the gelding was not entirely suited to the firm nature of today's track. Trainer F Auret advised that **KING SAMBO** would be spelled.
