## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BARFOOT & THOMPSON 2200
<p><b>TAMA AKARANA</b> (Z Nor Azman) knuckled leaving the barrier, losing ground.</p> <p><b>ATTILA</b> (R Elliot) began awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p><b>IFRA DANCER</b> (M Du Plessis) and <b>ASYLUM SEEKER</b> (M McNab) were both slow to begin.</p> <p><b>TAMA AKARANA</b> had to steady passing the 2100 metres when crowded to the inside of <b>ASYLUM SEEKER</b> which shifted to the inside of <b>GLOBAL WARRIOR</b> (D Johnson).</p> <p><b>HILARIOUS</b> (C Lammas) over raced when being restrained near the 1800 metres, when awkwardly placed inside the heels of <b>FIRST HONOUR</b> (S Spratt) which was taken in slightly by <b>ARITE GURU</b>. <b>HILARIOUS</b> then over raced in the middle stages having to be steadied off heels for a distance.</p> <p><b>IFRA DANCER</b> raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>FIRST HONOUR</b> had to be steadied off the heels of the weakening <b>BE BEAUTIFUL</b> (A Collett) near the 450 metres, and then was held up for a short distance.</p> <p><b>ARITE GURU</b> (C Dell) had to steady approaching the 400 metres when in restricted room between <b>BE BEAUTIFUL</b> and</p>	

**PENTIRE BABE** (T Thornton) which both shifted ground slightly under pressure.

**WAIHOU LASS** (B Hutton) fell near the 400 metres when racing free of interference, dislodging rider B Hutton. **TAMA AKARANA** which was following, ducked out abruptly, dislodging rider Z Nor Azman. **WAIHOU LASS** was attended to by the veterinarian and euthanased after fracturing the off fore leg. Z Nor Azman and B Hutton were attended to by the course doctor, with B Hutton being taken to hospital and following x-rays, was found to have fractured his left elbow.

**ATTILA** was held up near the 250 metres, before shifting inwards abruptly across the heels of **HILARIOUS** to obtain clear running.

**VITESSE** (M Hills) began awkwardly, and was then crowded by **TOUTING** (M Coleman) which shifted in after beginning awkwardly. **VITESSE** had to steady as a result. **VITESSE** then over raced in the early stages having to be steadied off heels passing the 1100 metres.

**BLACKMAGICWOMAN** (D Johnson) had to steady passing the 1100 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

**TOUTING** went off stride passing the 1050 metres with **SNOWDOWN LILY** (C Grylls) reacting and ducking outwards away from **TOUTING**.

**SCARLET'S SECRET** (O Bosson) lay out, when shifting outwards near the 450 metres making contact with **AUGUST EDITION** (A Collett) which shifted wider on the track.

**VITESSE** had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

O Bosson reported that in his opinion **SCARLET'S SECRET** would appreciate some easing of the ground.

**CHACHAR** (M McNab) was late scratched at 5.55pm after refusing to enter the barrier. Trainer T Pike was advised that **CHACHAR** would now be required to trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

**HALLELOOJAH** (R Elliot) stumbled on jumping away.

**SALTED CARAMEL** (S Collett) began awkwardly.

**RONCHI** (G Cooksley) was hampered near the 1050 metres and had to be steadied off the heels of **HALLELOOJAH** which lay in with **HALLELOOJAH** continuing to lay in, crowding **DIVA ACHIEVER** (D Johnson) in onto **MAGIC OF THE SUN** (S Spratt) and **AMBER RAYNE** (T Thornton) which had to be sharply checked near the 900 metres, losing ground. Apprentice rider R Elliot was issued with a warning.

**DEELINGA** (A Jones) raced wide without cover.

**AMUN RA** (M Du Plessis) went off stride when racing in restricted room to the inside of **SEVENTH UP** (O Bosson) passing the 500 metres.

**PRIMROSE HILL** (A Collett) and **WHISTLE BLOWER** (V Colgan) both began awkwardly, losing ground.

**LUCKY SWEEP** (S Spratt) and **THE REBEL KNIGHT** (T Thornton) both began awkwardly.

**WHISTLE BLOWER** and **LE PETITE ROUGE** (S Collett) had to be steadied off heels when the pace eased near the 1100 metres with **WHISTLE BLOWER** continuing to over race through the middle stages.

**SISTERHOOD** (C Grylls) raced wide without cover.

**HEAD OFFICE** (G Cooksley) over-raced through the middle stages.

**CHATAM WHISPER** (U Holmquist) had to be steadied when attempting a marginal run to the inside of the weakening **ROUND MIDNIGHT** (S McKay) passing the 300 metres.

**LONG HARBOUR** (M Du Plessis) lost the near hind plate.

**SOUTHERN POWER** (A Jones) was slow to begin.

**DRESDEN PARK** (M McNab) began awkwardly.

**RIOT ACT** (T Thornton) was slow to begin.

**SACRED MASTER** (V Colgan) knuckled leaving the barrier.

**SACRED MASTER** over raced when awkwardly placed on heels near the 1100 metres.

**TUFFAAR** (S McKay) raced wide without cover.

**KENTUCKY SON** (U Holmquist) raced ungenerously in the middle stages.

**NOMISMA** (M Du Plessis) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of **SOUTHERN POWER** passing the 550 metres.

**RIOT ACT** and **DRESDEN PARK** both became tailed off passing the 600 metres and were not persevered with thereafter with **DRESDEN PARK** being pulled up. Subsequent veterinary examinations did not reveal any abnormalities. The connections of **DRESDEN PARK** advised that the mare, which is in foal, would now be retired. T Thornton the rider of **RIOT ACT** advised that she had not persevered with the gelding as she felt something may have been amiss with the gelding. Trainer C Stevenson was advised that he must provide a clear veterinary certificate for **RIOT ACT** prior to the gelding racing next.

**BIG DREAMER** (S Collett) and **LUEN YAT MIRACLE** (K Myers) came together on two occasions over the final 100

metres.

**STACCATO** (O Bosson) and **TROJAN WARRIOR** (S Spratt) came together over the concluding stages.

**TUFFAAR** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

**Race 6**

**SOUL SISTA** (O Bosson) was slow to begin.

**NEVER IN DOUBT** (C Grylls) began awkwardly and then was crowded.

**GEPPETTO'S GIRL** (M Du Plessis) raced ungenerously through the middle stages when the pace eased.

**LAAFFAIRE** (D Johnson) was restrained passing the 1300 metres, becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **AMUSE** (S Spratt) which was also restrained when crowded to the inside of **ROC'S ARE DIAMONDS** (M McNab) which shifted in slightly. **LAAFFAIRE** and **AMUSE** both then over raced for a distance on a moderate pace.

**STOLE MY THUNDER**, (S Collett) **NEVER IN DOUBT** and **SOUL SISTA** all over raced when the pace steadied.

**WAIPIPI LAD** (V Colgan) raced wide throughout.

**LAAFFAIRE** had some difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting out passing the 200 metres.

**SOUL SISTA** was held up for clear running until passing the 300 metres.

**AMUSE** was crowded when weakening passing the 200 metres.
