## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>NEW YEARS DAY RACES 2000</b>
<p><b>JUBILANT</b> (O Bosson) made contact with a gate leaving the enclosure and after passing a veterinary examination at the start, was cleared to run.</p> <p><b>BAD BOY BROWN</b> (K Myers) began awkwardly and then blundered after clipping the heels of <b>BON MARCHE</b> (L Allpress) which had begun awkwardly and shifted out.</p> <p><b>SPEED KING</b> (M Dravitzki) was slow to begin and then was crowded shortly after when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p><b>BON MARCHE</b> raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>MIO KIWI</b> (L Hemi) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>BON MARCHE</b> shifted out passing the 400 metres making firm contact with <b>SPEED KING</b> which was hampered. Rider L Allpress was issued a warning.</p> <p><b>MIO KIWI</b> was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p><b>BON MARCHE</b> and <b>BAD BOY BROWN</b> came together approaching the 150 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>STELLA ARTOIS 1200</b>
<p><b>SHOT IN THE DARK</b> (O Bosson) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>SABER</b> (S Olney) shifted out entering the final straight making contact with <b>THE KNIGHT'S QUEEN</b> (R Myers).</p> <p><b>SHOT IN THE DARK</b> had to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>Apprentice S Olney (<b>SABER</b>) was reminded of her obligations in regard to riding her mounts out fully to the finish when there is a reasonable chance of it running into a position for which there is prize money to be awarded or a dividend to be declared.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>LISTER/KENNERLEY FAMILY FROM CLIVE</b>
<p><b>SWEET MELODY</b> dislodged rider J Parkes during the preliminary. Both rider and horse were cleared to run.</p> <p><b>LENIN THE BROWN</b> (M McNab) shifted inwards abruptly at the start crowding <b>SWEET MELODY</b> (J Parkes) which lost ground.</p>	

<p><b>YEAGER</b> (R Goldsbury) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>ONE FINE DAY</b> (K Smith) was held up in the home straight until near the 150 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of <b>ROCK OF ACES</b> rider O Bosson advised Stewards that in his opinion the gelding had not been suited by the track conditions today. A post-race veterinary examination of <b>ROCK OF ACES</b> failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>TRINITY HILL 1400</b>
<p>The start of the race was delayed due to <b>SCOOTA KING</b> being very reluctant to load. The connections of the gelding were advised that a warning would be placed against its barrier manners. Trainer G Kenny advised that the gelding would no longer be persevered with as a racing proposition.</p> <p>Shortly after the start <b>LATIN ROSE</b> (M McNab) lay in crowding <b>HUNGRY EYES</b> (L Allpress), <b>RAZZLE DAZZLE MAN</b> (R Myers), <b>DELGATIE PEARL</b> (L Hemi), <b>NESSUN DORMA</b> (S McKay) and <b>BUFFALO BEN</b> (J Parkes) contributing to this incident was slight outward movement from <b>SECLUDED</b> (O Bosson).</p> <p><b>RAZZLE DAZZLE MAN</b> over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p><b>NESSUN DORMA</b> had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>DELGATIE PEARL</b> passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>Rider R Hannam reported to Stewards that <b>SCOOTA KING</b> had commenced to lay in passing the 600 metres and was unable to be ridden out to full advantage in the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>FASTTRACK INSURANCE MILE</b>
<p><b>MACROTH</b> (L Hemi) shifted out abruptly at the start resulting in <b>APPREHEND</b> (O Bosson) being tightened and losing ground.</p> <p><b>RATPACK</b> (K Smith) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>PIAZZA</b> (C Grylls) and <b>APPREHEND</b> both made the first bend awkwardly.</p> <p><b>GEM TWIST</b> (D Turner) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Approaching the 200 metres <b>APACHE MOON</b> (J Parkes) shifted out and away from <b>KEEP US HAPPY</b> (M McNab) resulting in <b>ARCHDUCHESS</b> (S Collett) making contact with <b>PIAZZA</b> which was forced out bumping <b>CAN COUP</b> (L Allpress) outwards onto the hind quarters of <b>APPREHEND</b> which became severely unbalanced.</p> <p><b>FISTFULOFDOLLARS</b> (C Dell) was held up until near the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>BETAVET PREPARE 2000</b>
<p><b>STAR EMERALD</b> was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 6.20pm after striking out when in the barriers, incurring superficial wounds to its hind legs.</p> <p><b>ZED LEPELIN</b> (S McKay) began awkwardly and was slow to begin as a result.</p> <p><b>ASCOMANNI</b> (J Parkes) was held up entering the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>AMP SOLUTIONS 3YO 1400</b>
<p><b>SHOCKTILLYOUDROP</b> (D Bradley) was slow to begin then was further hampered when bumping with <b>SERAPHIM</b> (S Collett) which had begun awkwardly.</p> <p><b>WATERBERG</b> (O Bosson) hung outwards crossing onto the course proper approaching the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>RINGLOCK</b> (J Parkes) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>Passing the 1000 metres <b>HOKEY POKEY</b> (R Myers) raced in restricted room to the inside of <b>HUNTA PENCE</b> (K Myers) making contact with the hind quarters of <b>SHOCKTILLYOUDROP</b> with <b>HOKEY POKEY</b> having to be steadied.</p> <p><b>RINGLOCK</b> had to steady when weakening approaching the 150 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>SACRED SHOT</b> (M McNab) resulting in <b>KATE THE GREAT</b> (R Hannam) having to shift ground outwards off the heels of <b>RINGLOCK</b>.</p> <p><b>EEPA NEEMA</b> (D Turner) and <b>WATERBERG</b> came together passing the 150 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>SEE YOU AT DIVA 1400</b>
<p><b>CHOP SUEY</b> (R Hannam) was slow to begin.</p> <p>Approaching the 850 metres <b>BORN HAPPY</b> (L Hemi) was steadied when placed in restricted room.</p> <p>Shortly after entering the home straight <b>CHOP SUEY</b> was angled out to avoid the heels of the rapidly tiring <b>PLEASURE PALACE</b> (D Turner) and in doing so bumped with <b>RIPE</b> (M Hills) which was forced outwards onto <b>DOCKET</b> (M McNab) which was unbalanced.</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres <b>CHOP SUEY</b> improved into a marginal run to the inside of <b>SILVER NANCHO</b> (L Allpress) which shifted in slightly with <b>SILVER NANCHO</b> becoming unbalanced for a distance and was not preserved with for the remainder.</p> <p>Rider J Parkes reported to Stewards that <b>ACCOLADES</b> had felt indifferent in its action throughout the running. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>
