Race 2 GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1200

DIVERGENT (M Du Plessis), RED SPUR (A Jones) and HOLD ON (M McNab) were all slow to begin.

PASABAHCE (R Elliot) raced ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 900 metres, making contact with the running rail.

MY ALAYNE (T Thornton) ran wide when making the bend passing the 900 metres forcing **SHOOT TO KILL** (D Johnson) wider on the track.

THE ROVER (S Spratt) raced ungenerously when being steadied for a distance approaching the 850 metres.

RED SPUR (A Jones) had a tendency to hang inwards in the early to middle stages.

SHOOT TO KILL raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

DIVERGENT (M Du Plessis) was held up entering the final straight.

JESSICOVA (L Allpress) had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **THE ROVER** passing the 300 metres, which shifted out slightly.

HOLD ON shifted out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running when not clear of **MY ALAYNE** which was checked losing ground. M McNab admitted a resultant breach of careless riding with the Judicial Committee suspended his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 19 December up to and including racing on 28 December, 4 riding days.

HOLD ON shifted out passing the 150 metres with DIVERGENT shifting away from that runner crowding THE ROVER on to JESSICOVA which was placed in restricted room with HOLD ON then continuing to shift out crowding DIVERGENT, THE ROVER and JESSICOVA on to CAPISTRANO PEARL (K Myers) which shifted in slightly. As a result DIVERGENT was hampered with THE ROVER being checked and JESSICOVA being severely checked. M McNab admitted a resultant breach of careless riding with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride in races from

the conclusion of racing on 28 December up to and including racing on 3 January 2016, 5 riding days.

PASABAHCE raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.

Race 3VISION FRESH – WORKING WITH KIWI GROWERS 3YO

Trainer Mr T Busuttin was warned for failing to declare gear for **MAGNIFICENT TIME** (M Du Plessis) by the required time.

SIMULATOR (O Bosson) was crowded shortly after leaving the barrier, and then shifted back out when being corrected by its rider crowding **MAGNIFICENT TIME** on to **DUKE STREET** (B R Jones).

AHJAY (T Thornton) ducked out approaching the 1200 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels and steadied. **AHJAY** then raced greenly for the remainder of the race.

DUKE STREET (B R Jones) raced wide without cover throughout.

KEEP CARMEN CARION (C Grylls) was held up rounding the final turn, and then had to steady passing the 300 metres when improving into a marginal run to the inside of **IVY'S GOLD** (D Johnson).

MOONRAKER (R Elliot) was held up rounding the final turn and became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **LOLA JANE** (C Lammas) which was also held up and shifted in when being steadied. **LOLA JANE** then continued to be held up for a distance.

FOUR DEGREES (S McKay) had a tendency to lay out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 4 CROCKFORD REAL ESTATE SUMMER RACEDAY – 16 JAN TGA

THOUGHTFUL (A Collett) was very slow away (3L).

NEAT AZA PIN (L Satherley) began awkwardly shifting in, making contact with **DOMINATION** (K Myers). **LEON** (D Johnson) was slow away.

CAPTAIN CAVALIER (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly shifting in, making contact with BRESHARNY (M Hills).

PORONUI (T Thornton) raced wide until being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.

LADY ROCK (M McNab) had difficulty finding clear running early in the final straight, and then was held up passing the 300 metres.

PORONUI commenced to weaken early in the final straight, and passing the 200 metres shifted away from

DOMINATION crowding **OUTSIDER** (C Grylls) on to **LADY ROCK** which became briefly unbalanced. **PORONUI** was then steadied for a short distance.

NEAT AZA PIN raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 5 KIWI BUS BUILDERS 1600

SCANDINAVIAN (M McNab) and EL ENCANTO (M Hills) were slow to begin.

EL ENCANTO was inconvenienced passing the 600 metres by MINGS GIRL (L Allpress) which shifted out.

CHEQUESINTHEMAIL (A Jones) had difficulty obtaining clear running passing the 300 metres.

MARCELLUS (M Coleman) raced wide without cover throughout.

When questioned regarding the improved performance of **FANTASY JET** (L Satherley) trainer Ms S House explained that she had been disappointed with the mare's run at Taupo, but had trialled well since and was confident of an improved performance.

CANTARE (K Myers) was held up rounding the final bend shifting out passing the 350 metres to obtain clear running	
making contact with NEALA (R Norvall). CANTARE then moved out when placed under pressure dictating NEALA	
wider on the track.	
Passing the 100 metres GOLDEN COIN lay in when placed under pressure inconveniencing ALL THE RAAJ which had	το

SHARE THE WONDER (R Elliot) raced wide without cover throughout.

MARKWOOD (M Du Plessis) commenced to over-race passing the 1500 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels, and then shifting out. **MARKWOOD** then raced wide without cover from near the 1200 metres.

ZEUS (V Colgan) made the crossing awkwardly near the 1500 metres, and passing the 1400 metres had to be steadied off heels racing ungenerously and shifting back on to **RIDDLE** which had to be restrained when becoming awkwardly placed.

MANGAROA TAHI (A Collett) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages, and then hung outwards when racing wide from near the 700 metres.

SIH RAH (A Jones) raced keenly passing the 1400 metres, and shifted out off heels. **SIH RAH** was then allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader.

EL HEALO (U Holmquist) raced ungenerously when being restrained for a distance passing the 1400 metres, and continued to do so shifting in to avoid heels passing the 1300 metres.

BUCCELLATI (S McKay) raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 900 metres when making the bend.

ITSABIRD was held up and shifted in passing the 200 metres, and when improving into a marginal run to the outside of **THE BOSS** (C Lammas) had to steady when that runner shifted out slightly. **ITSABIRD** then shifted away from **THE BOSS** making contact with **SIH RAH**. As a result **RIDDLE** which was following had to steady.

MANGAROA TAHI was not persevered with in the final straight with rider A Collett advising that the gelding is feeling the firm nature of the track.
