## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>COMAG LIMITED 2000</b>
<p><b>WAJA</b> (D Johnson) was late scratched at 2.58 pm on veterinary advice as it was found to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer Mr G Richardson advised Stewards that the gelding was now likely to be spelled.</p> <p><b>SECOND FLING</b> (C Grylls) began awkwardly shifting out abruptly hampering <b>SUNNY FRONTS</b> (C Dell), <b>CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF</b> (C Lammas) and <b>ALL KNITTED UP</b> (S Spratt) which all lost ground.</p> <p><b>CARDINAL SIN</b> (M Hills) began awkwardly shifting out making contact with the hind quarters of <b>WHITE DIAMOND</b> (L Allpress) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>ASYLUM SEEKER</b> (K Myers) shifted out on jumping away.</p> <p><b>LIN</b> (S Collett) which was racing in restricted room to the inside of <b>ASYLUM SEEKER</b> had to be steadied near the 1600 metres when <b>SUNNY FRONTS</b> made contact with the running rail and ducked outwards. Rider K Myers the rider of <b>ASYLUM SEEKER</b> was reminded of her obligations to allow sufficient room for runners to her inside at all times unless sufficiently clear to shift ground.</p> <p><b>CARDINAL SIN</b> made the bend near the 1600 metres awkwardly when racing keenly forcing <b>ALL KNITTED UP</b> wider on the track.</p> <p><b>LANAKAY</b> (A Jones) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>SUNNY FRONTS</b> was held up entering the final straight having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>SECOND FLING</b> was denied a run to the inside of <b>JEDI KNIGHT</b> (S McKay) having to steady near the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>RAY'S LEGACY</b> (T Thornton) after being held up early in the final straight was crowded then checked passing the 100 metres when <b>WHITE DIAMOND</b> shifted out abruptly after being struck by the rider of <b>JEDI KNIGHT'S</b> whip. Contributing to this incident was inward movement from <b>LANAKAY</b>.</p> <p><b>SO TRUE</b> (O Bosson) was held up throughout the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MATAMATA VETERINARY SERVICES 1600</b>

<p><b>WAVE RACER</b> (T Thornton) began awkwardly shifting in crowding <b>DANZABEEL</b> (L Innes) and <b>I'M ALL EARS</b> (Z Nor Azman), contributing was outward movement from <b>SUSIE WOLFF</b> (M Du Plessis).</p> <p><b>BARBOSSA</b> (M Cameron) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>TALLULAH BELLE</b> (S Collett) lay out making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.</p> <p><b>TALLULAH BELLE</b> had to steady when weakening when <b>ALMARIE</b> (L Allpress) shifted out passing the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>COVERED 'N BAY</b> (S McKay) lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing <b>ALMARIE</b>.</p> <p><b>CHATHAM WHISPER</b> (S Spratt) was held up until passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>S Spratt the rider of <b>CHATHAM WHISPER</b> was reminded of her obligations in regard to riding her horse out to the end of the race if there is a reasonable chance of it running into a position for which there is prize money to be awarded.</p> <p><b>BELLE OF MAPPERLEY</b> (C Grylls) lost the left front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 3	<b>CARRFIELDS LIVESTOCK MATAMATA 1200</b>
<p><b>THORNHILL</b> (L Allpress) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>POLAR SECRET</b> (D Johnson) jumped in the air when the gates opened and lost ground.</p> <p><b>GO NICHOLAS</b> (M Du Plessis) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>JAIDES JEWELL</b> (K Myers) began awkwardly becoming unbalanced, and then shortly after shifted in hampering <b>PRAISE DAN</b> (A Jones).</p> <p><b>GO NICHOLAS</b> (M Du Plessis) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>TIGER CLAWS</b> (C Lammas) lay out hampering <b>PENTAGON ACHIEVER</b> (O Bosson) approaching the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>GO NICHOLAS</b> made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.</p> <p><b>COOL SPIRIT</b> (S Spratt) raced greenly rounding the bend losing ground.</p> <p><b>PENTAGON ACHIEVER</b> (O Bosson) had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p>	
Race 4	<b>STIHL SHOP MATAMATA 1200</b>
<p><b>FIXATION</b> (M Coleman) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>OVER TORQUE</b> (C Lammas) and <b>SHAMASH</b> (A Collett) both began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>REGINA GIOVANNA</b> (L Innes) raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 5	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE</b>
<p><b>SAINT LUCIA</b> (A Collett) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>SHE'S PRISMATIC</b> (K Myers) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with <b>MACKENZIE KATE</b> (D Johnson) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>NEALA</b> (R Norvall) shifted inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear of <b>MISS HOROTIU</b> (M Coleman) which was checked. Also crowded in this incident was <b>SHE'S PRISMATIC</b> and <b>MY PALOMA</b> (B R Jones). R Norvall admitted a resultant breach of careless riding with the Judicial Committee suspended R Norvall's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 19 December up to and including racing on 27 December, 3 riding days.</p> <p><b>SHE'S PRISMATIC</b> raced ungenerously in the middle stages having to be firmly restrained passing the 800 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.</p>	
Race 6	<b>NOBLE AND LEE CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1400</b>
<p><b>ULTIMATE IMAGE</b> (G Cooksley) began awkwardly shifting out.</p> <p><b>FEROZ</b> (M Hills) and <b>NO NEED</b> (M Du Plessis) were both slow to begin.</p> <p><b>MIKIMOTO</b> (M Cameron) shifted in shortly after jumping away hampering <b>TWYA</b> (S Spratt).</p> <p><b>SPRINGLOADED</b> (L Magorrian) blundered shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>FEROZ</b> was held up until approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres <b>ULTIMATE IMAGE</b> (G Cooksley) improved on to the heels of the weakening <b>LINK ROAD</b> (L Allpress) clipping a heel of that runner and shifted in when blundering crowding the weakening <b>HAYPIN</b> (T Thornton) with <b>ULTIMATE IMAGE</b> not being persevered with for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of <b>PIAF</b> rider M Coleman could offer no tangible excuse for the filly's performance.</p> <p><b>PIAF</b> (M Coleman) lost the right front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 7	<b>BELL &amp; GRAHAM LAWYERS 1400</b>
<p>Trainer Mr P Stevens was issued with a warning for presenting <b>SPAWN OF ELAIA</b> (A Collett) to race without notified gear (side winkers).</p> <p><b>HE'S NO SAINT</b> (A Jones) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MALINA</b> (S Spratt) began awkwardly, and then was further hampered losing ground when runners on either side shifted ground.</p> <p><b>BEACON OF HOPE</b> (M Cameron) began awkwardly making contact with <b>SIGNOFTHETIMES</b> (D Johnson) with that runner becoming briefly unbalanced, then <b>BEACON OF HOPE</b> shifted back out crowding <b>SEGENHOE</b> (S Collett) which had to be steadied.</p> <p><b>HANNIBAL LECTER</b> (L Satherley) shifted out abruptly shortly after jumping away making contact with <b>SPAWN OF ELAIA</b> with both runners becoming unbalanced.</p>	

**ESSDEE** (C Grylls) was steadied approaching the 1300 metres when placed in restricted room.  
**MAJIC EL** (M Du Plessis) and **BEACON OF HOPE** (M Cameron) both over-raced in the early and middle stages.  
**JESSABEEL** (M Coleman) shifted out slightly making the bend near the 800 metres crowding **SIGNOFTHETIMES** out on to **SPAWN OF ELAIA** which both had to steady.  
**MAJIC EL** shifted out approaching the 750 metres forcing **HANNIBAL LECTER** wider.  
**MAJIC EL** was steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 600 metres.  
 Passing the 100 metres **ESSDEE** had to be checked when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **JESSABEEL** which lay in despite the efforts of its rider.  
 Near the 75 metres **BEACON OF HOPE** shifted inwards abruptly away from **JESSABEEL** making contact with **VONCHOI** (T Thornton).

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>MATAMATA TYRE SERVICES 1600</b>

**AMUSE** (S McKay) began very awkwardly losing ground (6L).  
**IN A FRENZY** (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly then had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **STARSTRIPE** (M Cameron).  
**MODERATION** (L Allpress) raced ungenerously for a short distance when crossing over on to the course proper approaching the 1300 metres.  
**IN A FRENZY** made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres shifting out making contact with **EMMUSKA** (U Holmquist).  
**FASCINATE ME** (M Coleman) was briefly held up for clear running early in the final straight.  
 When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **MUSCAT HILLS** rider D Johnson advised Stewards that in her opinion the mare having to carry 60kgs had a negative effect on its performance.  
**MODERATION** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.
