## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>TOTALLY VETS PREMIER</b>
<b>LA ADELITA (R Hannam)</b> was slow away. <b>HOT SPOT (D Mo)</b> was tightened at the start and lost ground. <b>SILK BELT (L Allpress)</b> was obliged to race three-wide throughout and near the 1100 metres, when racing tight to the outside of <b>RAGHU</b> , shifted in and bumped with that runner. <b>L Allpress</b> was advised to exercise care. <b>RAGHU</b> raced greenly throughout. <b>LA ADELITA</b> was held up for some distance near the 200 metres, <b>POROTENE DIVA (C Johnson)</b> raced in restricted room near the 200 metres. <b>J Parkes</b> could offer no excuses for the disappointing run of <b>ICEHOUSE</b> . A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no abnormality but the gelding did incur a superficial laceration to the offside hind leg.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>BROKERWEB RISK SERVICES 2YO PREMIER</b>
<b>THE DUKE OF JAZZ</b> sustained an injury to the near hind leg upon arrival at the track and was subsequently declared a late scratching at 12:53pm. . A veterinary clearance is required prior to <b>THE DUKE OF JAZZ</b> next racing. <b>CHA SIU BOA (C Grylls)</b> was slow away. <b>SHOWMEYAMONEYHONEY (D Bradley)</b> struck the side of the gate on jumping away and lost ground.	

<p><b>HUGO THE BOSS (J Riddell)</b> over-raced early and made the first corner awkwardly.</p> <p><b>CHA SIU BOA</b> had to be steadied after racing up onto the heels of <b>SHOWMEYAMONEYHONEY</b> near the 600 metres.</p> <p><b>J Riddell</b> could offer no excuses for the performance of <b>HUGO THE BOSS</b> which led throughout but failed to respond when put under pressure in the home straight eventually tailing the field home. A post-race veterinary examination of <b>HUGO THE BOSS</b> revealed no abnormality. Trainer <b>J Bary</b> advised that the colt would now be spelled.</p>	
Race 3	<b>RICH HILL STUD 3YO PREMIER</b>
<p><b>CASAQUINMAN (J Parkes)</b> and <b>SCRUTINIZE (C Johnson)</b> bumped at the start.</p> <p><b>CHINA SILK (C Grylls)</b> over-raced in the lead for the majority of the event.</p> <p><b>MACKINTOSH (J Riddell)</b> was held up rounding the final bend before gaining clear running near the 150, then shifted out near the 100 metres and in doing so bumped with <b>COCHISE (M du Plessis)</b> close to the winning post. <b>J Riddell</b> was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.</p> <p><b>R Myers (PERFECT HARMONEE)</b> dropped her whip near the 150 metres.</p>	
Race 4	<b>MILLS REEF PREMIER</b>
<p><b>CENTRE ATTENTION (J Riddell)</b> began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p><b>DARCI MAC (D Mo)</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ISOLA BELLA (L Allpress)</b> hung out throughout.</p> <p><b>FANCY NANCY (K Myers)</b> lay out marginally when making the turn near the 900 metres and contacted <b>ISOLA BELLA</b> which shifted out and hampered the trailing <b>CHARLESTOWN (D Turner)</b> in consequence.</p> <p><b>LA FILLE EN JEU (M du Plessis)</b> raced fiercely throughout and finished the race off disappointingly. A subsequent veterinary examination of <b>LA FILLE EN JEU</b> revealed no abnormality.</p> <p><b>BAZZ (J Parkes)</b> raced three-wide without cover throughout and lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p><b>SILVER BUBBLES (R Myers)</b> was held up passing the 500 metres until near the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>ISOLA BELLA</b> raced in restricted room over the final stages between <b>BAZZ</b> and <b>CHARLESTOWN</b> when both those runners shifted ground under pressure.</p>	
Race 5	<b>MCDONALDS PREMIER</b>
<p><b>RIGHT ROYAL ROSE (M Dravitzki)</b> shifted in on jumping tightening <b>EARL'S COURT (R Myers)</b>.</p> <p><b>PERFECTLYENCHANTED (M du Plessis)</b> was slow from a wide draw.</p> <p><b>ANNIESSTAR (D Mo)</b> had to steady momentarily near the post on the first occasion when <b>CHINA STAR (R Hannam)</b> shifted in when crossing to the lead.</p> <p><b>NYMPH MONTE (M Coleman)</b> over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>DESIGNATOR (L Allpress)</b> hung throughout and was not persevered with over the final stages. A post-race veterinary examination of <b>DESIGNATOR</b> revealed no abnormality.</p> <p><b>PERFECTYENCHANTED</b> was held up in the final straight and near the 250 metres had to be steadied off the heels of the tiring <b>DESIGNATOR</b></p> <p><b>J Parkes</b> the rider of <b>DIAMANTINE</b> reported that the gelding was not aided by a 3kg rise in weight since its last start which was a month prior.</p>	
Race 6	<b>KAMADA PARK MANAWATU CHALLENGE STAKES - GpIII</b>
<p><b>BEL SORRISO (M Coleman)</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>MIGHT SOLOMON (J Riddell)</b> had to steady shortly after leaving the barriers when awkwardly placed near the heels of <b>TOMORROWLAND (C Grylls)</b> which shifted in when moving forward. <b>C Grylls</b> was advised to exercise care.</p> <p><b>TOMORROWLAND</b> then raced keenly in the trail for some distance.</p> <p><b>HAYLEY MAREE (D Bothamley)</b> had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the home straight.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of <b>SAAVOYA</b> rider <b>L Allpress</b> reported that the mare had travelled well until the turn however when placed under pressure in the home straight had failed to run on as anticipated. A post-race veterinary examination of <b>SAAVOYA</b> revealed no abnormality.</p> <p><b>M du Plessis (SLICE OF CLASS)</b> was stuck in the face by a clod during the running sustaining a minor laceration to his nose.</p>	
Race 7	<b>HOTEL COACHMAN MANAWATU CUP - GpIII</b>
<p><b>ST RANSOM (C Dell)</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SKY BIRD (C Johnson)</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>GUARANTOR (L Allpress)</b> raced fiercely in the early stages proving difficult to restrain.</p> <p><b>CITY CHIC (S Wynne)</b> was placed in restricted room and crowded passing the winning post on the first occasion when inside <b>SALFORD ART (M Coleman)</b> which shifted in and away from <b>MADONNA MIA (D Bradley)</b> when that runner was attempting to obtain a position closer in. After questioning riders and viewing video footage it was established that simultaneously to <b>MADONNA MIA</b> moving inward the pace immediately ahead had steadied which had contributed to this incident.</p> <p>Nonetheless <b>D Bradley</b> was reminded of his obligations with respect to shifting ground.</p> <p><b>ST RANSOM</b> commenced to over-race near the 1700 metres when the tempo eased.</p> <p><b>SAMPSON (J Parkes)</b> raced three-wide without cover rounding the first turn until being taken forward near the 1400 metres to race adjacent to the leader.</p>	

**GREY GURU (M Dravitzki)** raced four-wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

When questioned regarding the run of **GUARANTOR, L Allpress** reported that after travelling well, the gelding failed to finish the race off when put under pressure in the final straight.

**Race 8**

**MURPHY PROPERTIES PREMIER**

**RUNWAY** was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2:56pm after sustaining an injury upon arrival at the course. A veterinary clearance is required prior to **RUNWAY** next racing.

**CAFÉ CULTURE (R Myers)** was slow away.

**JUSTLIKEYASISTR (D Mo)** began awkwardly.

**CATALINA DE LAGO (L Allpress)** raced keenly in the early stages.

**OLLIE'S NOTE (M Coleman)** raced wide throughout.

**CATALINA DE LAGO** raced in restricted room for a short distance approaching the 1200 metres.

**CAFÉ CULTURE (R Myers)** was obliged to make its run wide rounding the final turn.

**POSTBOY (H Tinsley)** was held up and unable to improve until reaching the final straight.
