RACE COMMENTS:

LA ADELITA (R Hannam) was slow away.

HOT SPOT (D Mo) was tightened at the start and lost ground.

SILK BELT (L Allpress) was obliged to race three-wide throughout and near the 1100 metres, when racing tight to the outside of **RAGHU**, shifted in and bumped with that runner. **L Allpress** was advised to exercise care.

RAGHU raced greenly throughout.

LA ADELITA was held up for some distance near the 200 metres,

POROTENE DIVA (C Johnson) raced in restricted room near the 200 metres.

J Parkes could offer no excuses for the disappointing run of **ICEHOUSE**. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no abnormality but the gelding did incur a superficial laceration to the offside hind leg.

Race 2 BROKERWEB RISK SERVICES 2YO PREMIER

THE DUKE OF JAZZ sustained an injury to the near hind leg upon arrival at the track and was subsequently declared a late scratching at 12:53pm. . A veterinary clearance is required prior to **THE DUKE OF JAZZ** next racing.

CHA SIU BOA (C Grylls) was slow away.

SHOWMEYAMONEYHONEY (D Bradley) struck the side of the gate on jumping away and lost ground.

HUGO THE BOSS (J Riddell) over-raced early and made the first corner awkwardly.

CHA SIU BOA had to be steadied after racing up onto the heels of SHOWMEYAMONEYHONEY near the 600 metres.

J Riddell could offer no excuses for the performance of **HUGO THE BOSS** which led throughout but failed to respond when put under pressure in the home straight eventually tailing the field home. A post-race veterinary examination of **HUGO THE BOSS** revealed no abnormality. Trainer **J Bary** advised that the colt would now be spelled.

Race 3 RICH HILL STUD 3YO PREMIER

CASAQUINMAN (J Parkes) and SCRUTINIZE (C Johnson) bumped at the start.

CHINA SILK (C Grylls) over-raced in the lead for the majority of the event.

MACKINTOSH (J Riddell) was held up rounding the final bend before gaining clear running near the 150, then shifted out near the 100 metres and in doing so bumped with COCHISE (M du Plessis) close to the winning post. J Riddell was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

R Myers (PERFECT HARMONEE) dropped her whip near the 150 metres.

Race 4 MILLS REEF PREMIER

CENTRE ATTENTION (J Riddell) began awkwardly and got back.

DARCI MAC (D Mo) was slow to begin.

ISOLA BELLA (L Allpress) hung out throughout.

FANCY NANCY (K Myers) lay out marginally when making the turn near the 900 metres and contacted **ISOLA BELLA** which shifted out and hampered the trailing **CHARLESTOWN (D Turner)** in consequence.

LA FILLE EN JEU (M du Plessis) raced fiercely throughout and finished the race off disappointingly. A subsequent veterinary examination of **LA FILLE EN JEU** revealed no abnormality.

BAZZ (J Parkes) raced three-wide without cover throughout and lay in under pressure in the final straight.

SILVER BUBBLES (R Myers) was held up passing the 500 metres until near the 300 metres.

ISOLA BELLA raced in restricted room over the final stages between **BAZZ** and **CHARLESTOWN** when both those runners shifted ground under pressure.

Race 5 MCDONALDS PREMIER

RIGHT ROYAL ROSE (M Dravitzki) shifted in on jumping tightening EARL'S COURT (R Myers).

PERFECTLYENCHANTED (M du Plessis) was slow from a wide draw.

ANNIESSTAR (D Mo) had to steady momentarily near the post on the first occasion when **CHINA STAR (R Hannam)** shifted in when crossing to the lead.

NYMPH MONTE (M Coleman) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

DEZIGNATOR (L Allpress) hung throughout and was not persevered with over the final stages. A post-race veterinary examination of **DEZIGNATOR** revealed no abnormality.

PERFECTYENCHANTED was held up in the final straight and near the 250 metres had to be steadied off the heels of the tiring **DEZIGNATOR**

J Parkes the rider of **DIAMANTINE** reported that the gelding was not aided by a 3kg rise in weight since its last start which was a month prior.

Race 6 KAMADA PARK MANAWATU CHALLENGE STAKES - GpIII

BEL SORRISO (M Coleman) was slow to begin.

MIGHT SOLOMON (J Riddell) had to steady shortly after leaving the barriers when awkwardly placed near the heels of TOMORROWLAND (C Grylls) which shifted in when moving forward. C Grylls was advised to exercise care.

TOMORROWLAND then raced keenly in the trail for some distance.

HAYLEY MAREE (D Bothamley) had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the home straight.

When questioned regarding the run of SAAVOYA rider **L Allpress** reported that the mare had travelled well until the turn however when placed under pressure in the home straight had failed to run on as anticipated. A post-race veterinary examination of **SAAVOYA** revealed no abnormality.

M du Plessis (SLICE OF CLASS) was stuck in the face by a clod during the running sustaining a minor laceration to his nose.

Race 7 HOTEL COACHMAN MANAWATU CUP - GpIII

ST RANSOM (C Dell) began awkwardly.

SKY BIRD (C Johnson) was slow to begin.

GUARANTOR (L Allpress) raced fiercely in the early stages proving difficult to restrain.

CITY CHIC (S Wynne) was placed in restricted room and crowded passing the winning post on the first occasion when inside **SALFORD ART (M Coleman)** which shifted in and away from **MADONNA MIA (D Bradley)** when that runner was attempting to obtain a position closer in. After questioning riders and viewing video footage it was established that simultaneously to

MADONNA MIA moving inward the pace immediately ahead had steadied which had contributed to this incident. Nonetheless **D Bradley** was reminded of his obligations with respect to shifting ground.

ST RANSOM commenced to over-race near the 1700 metres when the tempo eased.

SAMPSON (J Parkes) raced three-wide without cover rounding the first turn until being taken forward near the 1400 metres to race adjacent to the leader.

GREY GURU (M Dravitzki) raced four-wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

When questioned regarding the run of **GUARANTOR, L Allpress** reported that after travelling well, the gelding failed to finish the race off when put under pressure in the final straight.

Race 8 MURPHY PROPERTIES PREMIER

RUNWAY was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2:56pm after sustaining an injury upon arrival at the course. A veterinary clearance is required prior to **RUNWAY** next racing.

CAFÉ CULTURE (R Myers) was slow away.

JUSTLIKEYASISTR (D Mo) began awkwardly.

CATALINA DE LAGO (L Allpress) raced keenly in the early stages.

OLLIE'S NOTE (M Coleman) raced wide throughout.

CATALINA DE LAGO raced in restricted room for a short distance approaching the 1200 metres.

CAFÉ CULTURE (R Myers) was obliged to make its run wide rounding the final turn.

POSTBOY (H Tinsley) was held up and unable to improve until reaching the final straight.
