RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Fell Engineering 2100
TAMA AKARANA (M McNab) underwent a veterinary examination at the start and was declared a late scratching at 12.59pm.	
THORNBURY (C Dell) was slow away.	
LIPSIPSUC (L Magorrian) began awkwardly before being further hampered by RAY'S LEGACY (T Thornton) which was taken out by AFFOGATO (M Hills).	

AFFOGATO and **RAY'S LEGACY** both raced keenly when being steadied in the early stages.
LIN (S Collett) raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1700 metres and shifted out hampering **LIPSIPSUC** (L Magorrian) which was forced wider on the track.
THORNBURY raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.
IFRA DANCER (G Cooksley) raced keenly in the early to middle stages.
GLOBAL WARRIOR (Z Moki) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.
CHOREOGRAPHY (M Cameron) shifted in passing the 300 metres crowding **GLOBAL WARRIOR** on to **RAY'S LEGACY**.
RAY'S LEGACY then became awkwardly placed on heels soon after and briefly steadied. When being corrected by its rider **CHOREOGRAPHY** shifted out crowding **AFFOGATO** and **PRIMROSE HILL** (A Collett).
CHOREOGRAPHY made contact with the hind quarters of **AFFOGATO** which was laying in near the 50 metres.
GLOBAL WARRIOR shifted out over the concluding stages making brief contact with **CHOREOGRAPHY**.
IFRA DANCER lost the left front plate during the running.

Race 2	Cowley's Hire Centre 1000

HOT MOVE (M Cameron) and **WYNDSPELLE** (K Myers) were both slow away.
HOT MOVE raced very ungenerously in the early stages, losing contact with the body of the field and making the final turn very awkwardly, running wide. Trainer Mr N Tiley advised that the gelding would undergo further examination on return to his stable and is likely to try alternative gear as he believed **HOT MOVE** may have reacted poorly to the addition of the tongue tie.
OLYMPIC (T Thornton) raced ungenerously in the middle stages when being restrained off heels.
MOOGHAMIR dislodged Rider C Grylls following the race with both rider and horse being uninjured.

PICNIC BAY (M Du Plessis), **ENTRÉE** (S Collett) and **SINGLE MOMENT** (A Jones) were all slow away.
HONOUR PRINCESS (M Cameron) began awkwardly.
THEWAYWEROLL (BR Jones) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.
ONTHE SAUCE (M Hills) raced three wide without cover.
HONOUR PRINCESS raced a little ungenerously passing the 1000 metres when steadying off heels.
HONOUR PRINCESS was held up rounding the final turn and had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 200 metres.
WHO'S QUEEN (K Myers) was held up early in the final straight.
KIRSTEE (U Holmquist) shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres and then shifted back in inconveniencing **PICNIC BAY** which had to steady. U Holmquist was advised she must exercise greater care. **KIRSTEE** then continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.
PICNIC BAY was again held up passing the 200 metres shifting out across the heels approaching the 100 metres to obtain clear running.
NO PUSHOVER (A Collett) shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres dictating **ONTHE SAUCE** out into the line of **WHO'S QUEEN** which had to change ground.
ENTRÉE underwent an endoscopic examination after returning to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril which was clear.

Race 4	Cervus Equipment 1200

THE KAIHU KID (G Cooksley) was slow to begin.
FLASH SUGGESTION (K Myers) shifted outwards when jumping away, hampering **QUICK ANSWER** (T Thornton) which lost ground.
DASHIN (Z Moki) began awkwardly, hampering **VAN GOGH** (L Magorrian).
ZEDSATIONAL (D Nolan) jumped away awkwardly, making contact with **PISTOL PETE** (U Holmquist) which blundered.
VAN GOGH raced three wide without cover.
THE KAIHU KID became tailed off through the middle stages and was not persevered with in the final straight finishing a distant last. Mr C Stevenson was advised that **THE KAIHU KID** is now required to trial to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards prior to racing again.

RED RAVEN (M Du Plessis) blundered when leaving the barriers, losing ground.
MIGHTY MAK (S Collett) raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1300 metres.

THE CHIEF (A Schwerin) raced three wide without cover.	
Race 6	Kamo Club 1400
<p>SEBRING DRAGON (M Hills) was slow away.</p> <p>BOLD WARRIOR (L Magorrian) began awkwardly, then having to be restrained to avoid the heels of NIPABRANDY (K Myers).</p> <p>BLACK LACE (A Collett) was crowded passing the 1300 metres, losing ground when racing in restricted room to the inside of ZUCCHERO (M Du Plessis) which raced ungenerously and shifted in when being steadied. HOLLY ROSE (S Collett) which was following, was hampered as a result.</p> <p>NELSON PARK (C Dell) raced wide without cover.</p> <p>MACARIO (R Elliot) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p>ZUCCHERO shifted out making brief contact with NELSON PARK passing the 250 metres when looking to obtain clear running.</p> <p>MONGOLIAN MACHETE had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>Rider M Cameron advised that MONGOLIAN MACHETE had raced greenly amongst runners throughout and would benefit from the experience.</p>	
Race 7	Ford Fiesta 1400
<p>STREET WARS (M Hills) was slow away.</p> <p>Approaching the 1200 metres STREET WARS commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied and then was crowded slightly by AMADEUS (M Cameron) which shifted in and further hampered STREET WARS which lost ground. M Cameron was advised that a warning would be placed on his record.</p> <p>STREET WARS was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>WAYNE (T Thornton) which had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight, shifted out over the final 100 metres crowding ALADDIN (BR Jones) which was steadied. T Thornton was advised that a warning would be placed on her record.</p> <p>AMADEUS collapsed post-race after suffering from heat exhaustion. AMADEUS was treated by the Veterinarian and suffered a number of abrasions. The stable representative was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to AMADEUS racing again.</p>	
Race 8	The Skandel and Mawah Vellous Owners Pay Homage to Dean Logan
<p>ONEWA ROAD was declared a late scratching at 5.04pm after proving very unruly during its preliminary and pulling the right front plate with Rider T Thornton then being unwilling to ride the gelding due to its unruliness. Trainer Ms K Knight was advised that ONEWA ROAD must now trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.</p> <p>VICENTE (M Cameron), SUMMER WARRIOR (A Collett) and BE BEAUTIFUL (Z Moki) were slow to begin.</p> <p>LE PETITE ROUGE (S Collett) raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>SEGENHOE (K Myers) over-raced when being restrained near the 1400 metres and continued to race keenly into the middle stages.</p> <p>JUSTRUSH (R Elliot) raced ungenerously when being restrained to avoid the heels of MACAKIZI (L Magorrian) approaching the 600 metres.</p> <p>MAYTRA DEE (G Cooksley) lay in under pressure making slight contact with LE PETITE ROUGE passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>C Dell (IT CAN ONLY BE YOU) was issued with a warning with regards to his whip use prior to the 200 metres.</p>
