## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>WILD BUCK NZ ALE MAIDEN 2000M</b>
<p><b>ST MALO</b> was slow to begin and raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p><b>DECANTER</b> raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>SKILLS</b> was held up for a short distance passing the 600 metres</p> <p><b>ST MALO</b> raced in restricted room passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>Rider R Bishop (<b>DECANTER</b>) reported that the mare had made abnormal respiratory noises throughout the running. A post race veterinary inspection revealed the mare, which had previously undergone 2 wind operations, was showing signs of wind obstruction. The connections were advised that the mare must have a veterinary clearance including a dynamic endoscopic examination prior to racing next. Co-trainer A Furlong reported that consideration would be given to the mare's racing future.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>GREG DALY REAL ESTATE/TASMAN AGRICULTURE RATING 75 2000M</b>
<b>SUPERIOR COURT</b> and <b>LUKANDER</b> were slow to begin.	

<p><b>MESSINES</b> got its head up and raced keenly over the early stages.          Passing the 1000 metres <b>PETER PARKER</b> had to steady for some distance when making the bend awkwardly.  <b>MESSINES</b> weakened passing the 600 metres.  <b>PETER PARKER</b> shifted inwards near the 150 metres and had to be straightened. <b>SUPERIOR COURT</b> was placed in restricted room as a result. Following the running of this race the connections of 2<sup>nd</sup> placed <b>SUPERIOR COURT</b> lodged a protest under Rule 642(1) against <b>PETER PARKER</b> (R Black). After hearing all relevant submissions the JCA dismissed the protest.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>FAHEY CONTRACTING/VERNON &amp; VAZEY MAIDEN 1020M</b>
<p><b>MAHORA BAY</b> raced wide throughout.  <b>MADAM ROXY</b> became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>BLACK ESTATE</b> near the 600 metres when making the bend awkwardly.  <b>RAROONEY</b> and <b>BLACK ESTATE</b> came together near the 500 metres.  <b>RAROONEY</b> was checked and shifted ground outwards abruptly near the 400 metres when <b>BLACK ESTATE</b> (B Murray) shifted ground inwards. B Murray admitted a breach under Rule 638(1)(d) of Careless Riding. After hearing evidence and submissions the JCA suspended B Murray's licence to ride for 2 days effective the 13<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> January 2016.  <b>BLACK ESTATE</b> was steadied when in the tight quarters over the concluding stages.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>REEFTON CRANE &amp; CONSTRUCTION RATING 65 1020M</b>
<p>The start of this race was delayed by 2 minutes on request of race day control.  <b>GOODTAGO</b> began awkwardly and got back as a result.  <b>MILK IT</b> raced wide throughout.  <b>MADAM COURTNEY</b> improved wide from the 600 metres.          A Chan, the rider of <b>GOODTAGO</b>, dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>ELECTRONET MAIDEN 1400M</b>
<p><b>TRANSOME</b> underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection due to the filly colliding with the running rail on route to the barriers.  <b>DANN DOONAYR</b> began awkwardly and shifted inwards abruptly shortly after jumping having to be straightened.  <b>TRANSOME</b> bounded as the start was effected and got back.  <b>TORRIO</b> raced in restricted room in the early stages.  <b>THIRD TIME LUCKY</b> lay inwards near the 1100 metres and blundered becoming unbalanced over the crossing losing considerable ground.  <b>TORRIO</b> raced wide in the early to middle stages.  <b>FLAVOURING</b> and <b>FUN FAIR</b> both raced keenly for a short distance near the 800 metres.  <b>TRANSOME</b> raced wide from the 800 metres.  <b>FLAVOURING</b> was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.  <b>FUN FAIR</b> lay inwards near the 200 metres having to be straightened with the rider swapping the whip hands near the 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>MOLLOY &amp; ASSOCIATES REEFTON CUP 1400M</b>
<p><b>EL CHICO</b> shifted out on jumping and made contact with <b>OVERTHERIVER</b> which was shifted onto <b>KEEPA TRAMP</b>, which was hampered and got back.  <b>A BOB SHORT</b> raced wide in the early stages.  <b>UPPLAND</b> raced keenly in the early stages.          Near the 1100 metres <b>OUR PREMONITION</b> (B Moore) shifted inwards when not clear causing both <b>OVERTHERIVER</b> and <b>EL CHICO</b> to be checked. <b>OVERTHERIVER</b> and <b>EL CHICO</b> both over-raced for some distance thereafter. B Moore admitted a breach under Rule 638(1)(d) of Careless Riding. After hearing evidence and submissions the JCA suspended B Moore's licence to ride for 2 days effective 13<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> January 2016.  <b>EL CHICO</b> which gave ground from the 600 metres underwent a post race veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>BILL O'MALLEY MEMORIAL RATING 65 1400M</b>
<p><b>SHEEZ ALL HEART</b> began awkwardly and got back.  <b>LOTTERIO</b> began awkwardly.  <b>MIDNIGHT CAPP</b>A was hampered shortly after the start when <b>WHY WAIT</b> shifted inwards and <b>MAEVE DAVONE</b> shifted out.  <b>BORN HAPPY</b> raced wide in the early to middle stages,  <b>STAR OF GREENBEEL</b> raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.  <b>LOTTERIO</b> raced wide throughout.  <b>SHEEZ ALL HEART</b> had to steady near the 900 metres when awkwardly placed between <b>TUKAWA</b> which made the bend awkwardly shifting inwards and <b>STAR OF GREENBEEL</b> which had continued to race ungenerously.  <b>MAEVE DAVONE</b> was steadied and placed in restricted room passing the 600 metres.  <b>SAVANNAH SOMOYA</b> was held up for some distance passing the 400 metres before shifting ground outwards near the 150</p>	

metres to obtain clear running.

**STAR OF GREENBEEL** lay inwards throughout the straight. D Walsh reported that the gelding was unsuited to the turning nature of the track and in his opinion would take benefit from today's race.

**Race 8**

**BIRCHFIELD COAL MINES RATNG 75 1400M**

**PAINTBALL** was a late scratching at 12.25pm on veterinary advice.

**PAT IN BRACKETS** and **GOLD ALLURE** both began awkwardly and got back.

**DO UNO WHOIAM** raced wide throughout.

**DOCTOR EDEN** raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

**PAT IN BRACKETS** was heavily restrained passing the 700 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of **DIAMOND EDGE** (B Moore) which shifted in. B Moore was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Passing the 400 metres **WERIO** and **KAGE IS KING** were both steadied and lost ground when awkwardly placed between **DOCTOR EDEN** and **DO UNO WHOIAM**.

**PAT IN BRACKETS** was held up for a short distance near the 300 metres.

**GOLD ALLURE** and **DO UNO WHOIAM** made firm contact on entering the home straight.

R Cuneen, the rider of **PAT IN BRACKETS**, had his whip accidentally knocked from his hand near the 100 metres.
