RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WILD BUCK NZ ALE MAIDEN 2000M

ST MALO was slow to begin and raced wide in the early stages.

DECANTER raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SKILLS was held up for a short distance passing the 600 metres

ST MALO raced in restricted room passing the 400 metres.

Rider R Bishop (**DECANTER**) reported that the mare had made abnormal respiratory noises throughout the running. A post race veterinary inspection revealed the mare, which had previously undergone 2 wind operations, was showing signs of wind obstruction. The connections were advised that the mare must have a veterinary clearance including a dynamic endoscopic examination prior to racing next. Co-trainer A Furlong reported that consideration would be given to the mare's racing future.

Race 2 GREG DALY REAL ESTATE/TASMAN AGRICULTURE RATING 75 2000M

SUPERIOR COURT and LUKANDER were slow to begin.

MESSINES got its head up and raced keenly over the early stages.

Passing the 1000 metres **PETER PARKER** had to steady for some distance when making the bend awkwardly.

MESSINES weakened passing the 600 metres.

PETER PARKER shifted inwards near the 150 metres and had to be straightened. **SUPERIOR COURT** was placed in restricted room as a result. Following the running of this race the connections of 2nd placed **SUPERIOR COURT** lodged a protest under Rule 642(1) against **PETER PARKER** (R Black). After hearing all relevant submissions the JCA dismissed the protest.

Race 3 FAHEY CONTRACTING/VERNON & VAZEY MAIDEN 1020M

MAHORA BAY raced wide throughout.

MADAM ROXY became awkwardly placed on the heels of **BLACK ESTATE** near the 600 metres when making the bend awkwardly.

RAROONEY and **BLACK ESTATE** came together near the 500 metres.

RAROONEY was checked and shifted ground outwards abruptly near the 400 metres when **BLACK ESTATE** (B Murray) shifted ground inwards. B Murray admitted a breach under Rule 638(1)(d) of Careless Riding. After hearing evidence and submissions the JCA suspended B Murray's licence to ride for 2 days effective the 13th to 16th January 2016.

BLACK ESTATE was steadied when in the tight quarters over the concluding stages.

Race 4 REEFTON CRANE & CONSTRUCTION RATING 65 1020M

The start of this race was delayed by 2 minutes on request of race day control.

GOODTAGO began awkwardly and got back as a result.

MILK IT raced wide throughout.

MADAM COURTNEY improved wide from the 600 metres.

A Chan, the rider of GOODTAGO, dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.

Race 5 ELECTRONET MAIDEN 1400M

TRANSOME underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection due to the filly colliding with the running rail on route to the barriers

DANN DOONAYR began awkwardly and shifted inwards abruptly shortly after jumping having to be straightened.

TRANSOME bounded as the start was effected and got back.

TORRIO raced in restricted room in the early stages.

THIRD TIME LUCKY lay inwards near the 1100 metres and blundered becoming unbalanced over the crossing losing considerable ground.

TORRIO raced wide in the early to middle stages.

FLAVOURING and FUN FAIR both raced keenly for a short distance near the 800 metres.

TRANSOME raced wide from the 800 metres.

FLAVOURING was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

FUN FAIR lay inwards near the 200 metres having to be straightened with the rider swapping the whip hands near the 100 metres.

Race 6 MOLLOY & ASSOCIATES REEFTON CUP 1400M

EL CHICO shifted out on jumping and made contact with **OVERTHERIVER** which was shifted onto **KEEPA TRAMP**, which was hampered and got back.

A BOB SHORT raced wide in the early stages.

UPPLAND raced keenly in the early stages.

Near the 1100 metres **OUR PREMONITION** (B Moore) shifted inwards when not clear causing both **OVERTHERIVER** and **EL CHICO** to be checked. **OVERTHERIVER** and **EL CHICO** both over-raced for some distance thereafter. B Moore admitted a breach under Rule 638(1)(d) of Careless Riding. After hearing evidence and submissions the JCA suspended B Moore's licence to ride for 2 days effective 13th to 16th January 2016.

EL CHICO which gave ground from the 600 metres underwent a post race veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities.

Race 7 BILL O'MALLEY MEMORIAL RATING 65 1400M

SHEEZ ALL HEART began awkwardly and got back.

LOTTERIO began awkwardly.

MIDNIGHT CAPPA was hampered shortly after the start when **WHY WAIT** shifted inwards and **MAEVE DAVONE** shifted out. **BORN HAPPY** raced wide in the early to middle stages,

STAR OF GREENBEEL raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

LOTTERIO raced wide throughout.

SHEEZ ALL HEART had to steady near the 900 metres when awkwardly placed between **TUKAWA** which made the bend awkwardly shifting inwards and **STAR OF GREENBEEL** which had continued to race ungenerously.

MAEVE DAVONE was steadied and placed in restricted room passing the 600 metres.

SAVANNAH SOMOYA was held up for some distance passing the 400 metres before shifting ground outwards near the 150

metres to obtain clear running.

STAR OF GREENBEEL lay inwards throughout the straight. D Walsh reported that the gelding was unsuited to the turning nature of the track and in his opinion would take benefit from today's race.

Race 8 BIRCHFIELD COAL MINES RATNG 75 1400M

PAINTBALL was a late scratching at 12.25pm on veterinary advice.

PAT IN BRACKETS and GOLD ALLURE both began awkwardly and got back.

DO UNO WHOIAM raced wide throughout.

DOCTOR EDEN raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

PAT IN BRACKETS was heavily restrained passing the 700 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of **DIAMOND EDGE** (B Moore) which shifted in. B Moore was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Passing the 400 metres **WERIO** and **KAGE IS KING** were both steadied and lost ground when awkwardly placed between **DOCTOR EDEN** and **DO UNO WHOIAM**.

PAT IN BRACKETS was held up for a short distance near the 300 metres.

GOLD ALLURE and DO UNO WHOIAM made firm contact on entering the home straight.

R Cuneen, the rider of PAT IN BRACKETS, had his whip accidentally knocked from his hand near the 100 metres.
