RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	VERNON AND VAZEY MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>OKAGBARE was slow to begin.</p> <p>RAROONEY and SUNFLOWER made the crossing awkwardly near the 1000 metres and raced keenly for a short distance afterwards.</p> <p>Near the 800 metres MOREIRA had to be briefly steadied when awkwardly placed near the heels of OKAGBARE.</p> <p>ANUTHA BOMBER raced wide throughout and then weakened passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>MOREIRA lay inwards over the final stages.</p> <p>OKAGBARE lost its off-hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 2	FAT PIPI PIZZA RATING 65 (1200m)
<p>PINZANO began awkwardly and got back as a result.</p> <p>SAN MICHELE raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>MARE MIA raced wide throughout.</p> <p>MARE MIA made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres and shifted wide when steadied by rider D Hirini.</p> <p>SAN MICHELE hung outwards on the bend near the 400 metres and had to be steadied by rider R Black with the mare losing ground in consequence. When questioned regarding the run of SAN MICHELE, Miss Black reported the mare had travelled poorly throughout and had trouble making the bends. A subsequent veterinary examination showed no apparent abnormalities. The connections reported the mare had been unsuited to racing right-handed.</p>	

<p>RAW GOLD had to be steadied passing the 150 metres when briefly crowded by RAPT who shifted outwards. RAPT then continued to shift outwards under pressure bumping with MILK IT near the 100 metres. Rider S Wynne was shown the film and spoken to advisedly.</p>	
Race 3	RAILWAY HOTEL HOKITIKA RATING 65 (1200m)
<p>POP HIT was crowded briefly on jumping when AGOSTINI shifted inwards. POP HIT raced wide throughout. DAVONE CODE was held up on the final bend.</p>	
Race 4	BIRCHFIELDS COAL & LANDSCAPING RATING 85 (1200m)
<p>SOMETHINGS BURNING was slow to begin. PINSGOLD was briefly crowded in the early stages between CARAMAC and SABER who both shifted ground. PINSGOLD then got its head up and raced keenly for a short distance. CARAMAC raced keenly over the early to middle stages. PINSGOLD raced wide throughout. ISHIMINE raced wide from the 600 metres. Near the 500 metres UPPLAND had to be heavily restrained and was checked when taken inwards by PINSGOLD (S Wynne) causing WAITINO BISCUIT to be checked when awkwardly placed near the rail. Soon after rider M Dravitzki (WAITINO BISCUIT) lost the use of her near side iron which was unable to be regained for the remainder of the race. Rider S Wynne admitted a breach under Rule 638(1)(d) - Careless Riding. After considering submissions on penalties the JCA suspended Miss Wynne's riders licence from the conclusion of racing on the 16th January up to and including the 3rd of February 2016 (5 days). When questioned with regards to SOMETHINGS BURNING, rider K Kalychurun reported the gelding had been unsuited to racing right-handed.</p>	
Race 5	HOKITIKA BUSINESSES CUP (2180m)
<p>MISSTEEFLYING and ASCOMANNI bumped shortly after the start. CONFUSED, ASCOMANNI, KINGIESSTAR and TEDDYTWINKLETOES over raced in the middle stages. Passing the 500 metres MISSTEEFLYING had to be steadied when held up on the heels of KINGIESSTAR. Near the 200 metres MISSTEEFLYING again had to be restrained when placed in restricted room between INA JAM and ASCOMANNI who both shifted ground. ASCOMANNI and GINGERBREAD MAN brushed in the shadows of the post. KINGIESSTAR lost its near foot plate during the running.</p>	
Race 6	MOTELS OF HOKITIKA MAIDEN (1645m)
<p>MADAM ROXY underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination after becoming cast in its stall and was cleared to race. MISS NORWAY began awkwardly. OUR SPICE was briefly steadied near the 1200 metres when crowded to the inside of ROUGH RULER. K Mudhoo, the rider of ROUGH RULER, was shown the film and spoken to advisedly. PAYMENT PENDING made the bend awkwardly near the 1100 metres. MADAM ROXY weakened near the 500 metres. Rider J Lowry reported the mare had held its breath throughout. Trainer S Cunningham advised she would no longer persevere with the mare from her stable. OUR SPICE lay inwards throughout the final straight.</p>	
Race 7	BANCORP TREASURY SERVICES RATING 75 (1645m)
<p>LEEDS was slow to begin. WERIO blundered shortly after the start. KING NERO shifted outwards in the early stages hampering KAGE IS KING and WERIO. FANTAMO over raced in the early stages and had to be steadied for a stride near the 1300 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of DOCTOR EDEN. KAGE IS KING improved wide from the 800 metres. LEEDS was held up for a short distance near the 200 metres and then when obtaining clear racing room made contact with DOCTOR EDEN.</p>	
Race 8	WEST COAST SCRAP & STEEL MISS SCENICLAND STAKES (1645m)
<p>ARE YOU MINE raced wide in the early stages. TACTICALL was buffeted in the early stages between CARLTON PRINCESS and SLICK NICKEL which had both shifted ground. GOLD ALLURE began awkwardly and got back as a result.</p>	

ARE YOU MINE raced keenly near the 1300 metres and was steadied outwards away from the heels of **CARLTON PRINCESS** with **ARE YOU MINE** racing wide for a considerable distance.

BRAH SPRING made the first bend awkwardly and shifted outwards hampering **TACTICALL**.

Near the 700 metres **MISS CITRON** was steadied for several strides when crowded for racing room to the inside of **CARLTON PRINCESS**, which had been buffeted by the improving **TACTICALL**.

GOLD ALLURE was held up racing towards the 600 metres.

ZAH GIRL lay inwards throughout the run home.

RUNWAY lay inwards in the run home.

ARE YOU MINE returned to the enclosure with a laceration to its rear hind leg. A subsequent veterinary examination showed that the mare had been galloped on.

Race 9	POWER FARMING WEST COAST RATING 65 (1645m)

TUKAWA shifted outwards in the early stages causing **TOETWOTOE** to make contact with **LET'S ESCAPE**.

TOETWOTOE got it head up and raced keenly in the early stages.

FARCE, HABITUDE, LET'S ESCAPE, TUKAWA were all placed in restricted room after 200 metres when **CURLI** shifted inwards. Stewards spoke with rider M Chui regarding this who advised his horse had lay inwards away from the improving **CASEY MARIE**. Notwithstanding this rider M Chui was advised to exercise more care.

CASEY MARIE raced wide on the first bend.

BOYSWAY raced wide throughout.

Near the 300 metres **MR WHIZ** had to be steadied momentarily when crowded between **LET'S ESCAPE** and **BOYSWAY** who both shifted ground.

TOETWOTOE had difficulty obtaining clear racing room in the early stages in the run home.

PETER PARKER was inclined to lay outwards in the home straight.
