Race 1 WAITAHORA FARMERS RTG 65 MILE

PADDY OWEN was tightened on jumping and settled back. **PADDY OWEN** then lost contact with the field, with rider M Tanaka reporting that in his opinion the gelding would be better suited to more rain affected going.

DON'STOPGIRL (L Hemi) was slow away.

KINGS COURT (L Allpress) was held up near the 400 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **MAESTRO** (J Parkes).

DELILAH DELTORO (D Turner) shifted in under pressure near the 250 metres resulting in **HIIQUE** (M Singh) having to shift outwards across that runner's heels to improve, with **KINGS COURT** being dictated over extra ground. Apprentice M Singh was reminded on his obligations when shifting ground.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **MAESTRO**, rider J Parkes was unable to offer any explanation.

DAVEY CROCKETT (S McKay) jumped inwards abruptly from the start hampering **JUDI ANNE** (D Hirini) and **SILKYSAND** (D Turner) which had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **FANCY**

NANCY (R Hannam). **SILKYSAND** then raced ungenerously for a distance near the 1200 metres.

PLEASURE PALACE (M Tanaka) began awkwardly losing ground.

BRONSTEEL (L Hemi) was slow to begin.

DAVEY CROCKETT raced three-wide without cover throughout.

JUDI ANNE had to be steadied approaching the bend near the 800 metres when in restricted room between **DAVEY CROCKETT** and **QUESTION MARK** (A Collett) which over-raced and shifted outwards when being restrained.

PLEASURE PALACE was obliged to make its run wide from the 700 metres.

BRONSTEEL was briefly held up near the 400 metres, with **BRONSTEEL** having to be steadied near the 250 metres when racing to the inside of **SILKYSAND** which shifted inwards under pressure.

FANCY NANCY lay in under pressure near the 200 metres momentarily hampering SLIMLINE (D Mo).

BEACON OF HOPE (J Parkes) shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages bumping with **SLIMLINE** which became unbalanced near the finish. Prior to the authorization of dividends, the connections of the 3rd placed **SLIMLINE** viewed video footage of the final straight however elected not to proceed with an objection against the 1st placed **BEACON OF HOPE.** Rider J Parkes was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

DAVEY CROCKETT lost the near front plate during the running.

Race 3 MCI & ASSOCIATES MDN 1400

NEAT BELT (J Riddell) blundered badly on jumping, shifting inwards bumping with **ALWAYS READY** (L Allpress).

CARRINGTON PARK (D Turner) was slow away.

SHE'S BLUFFING (D Hirini) raced wide without cover throughout.

JUDITH KATE (C Dell) was held up for a short distance near the 400 metres.

JUDITH KATE had to be angled inwards over the final stages in order to continue to improve.

ALWAYS READY raced greenly over the final stages.

Race 4 SCALETEC WEIGHING TECHNOLOGY 3YO 1400

M Tanaka replaced L Magorrian as the rider of SUNSPEAR.

O'KNOW (J Parkes) and PINSRAAD (D Mo) came together leaving the barriers.

SECRET WAR (R Hannam) was slow to begin.

OUR TRIXIE (R Goldsbury) made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly forcing **PINSRAAD** outwards into the line of the trailing **MIDNIGHT FLYER** (S McKay) which had to steady. **OUR TRIXIE** then when being corrected by its rider shifted inwards placing **SECRET WAR** in restricted room momentarily.

When questioned regarding the performance of **O'KNOW**, Rider J Parkes reported that in his opinion the filly may be better suited to a longer distance.

Race 5 TARARUA CLUB MAIDEN SPRINT

CUBAN BREEZE underwent a veterinary examination prior to the start and subsequently declared a late scratching at 2.46pm when found to be lame in the left foreleg.

BELLONTHEROCKS (A Collett) jumped inwards abruptly leaving the barriers crowding **DANMULAN** (M Tanaka). **BELLONTHEROCKS** then had to be restrained in the early stages when awkwardly placed to the inside of **LENIN THE BROWN** (R Myers) which shifted inwards.

BENNY 'N' THE JETS (C Dell) raced wide without cover throughout.

DANMULAN hung outwards rounding the bend near the 400 metres, with **DAN MULAN** then shifting out under pressure near the 250 metres dictating **LENIN THE BROWN** (R Myers) and **PIECE OF KATE** (D Turner) wider.

Race 6 PRENTERS READY MIX CONCRETE MDN STAYERS

IRIDIUM (M Cropp) was crowded leaving the barriers between BLAZING OPAL (D Turner) and COUNTDOWN (R Myers) which shifted outwards.

CASH DEAL (M Ward) commenced to over-race through the early stages and passing the winning post on the first occasion when being heavily restrained to avoid the heels of **COUNTDOWN**, shifted outwards

resulting in MACROTH (R Hannam) being forced wider.

PENNY WONDER (H Andrew) made the first bend awkwardly.

IRIDIUM made the crossing near the 1600 metres awkwardly.

BRICKLEBERRY (S McKay) was held up entering the final straight until near the 250 metres.

ANY STREAM WILL DO (L Allpress) had difficulty obtaining clear racing room in the early stages of the final straight until near the 200 metres.

SCARAMOUCHE (J Parkes) was inclined to lug inwards throughout the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance of **SCARAMOUCHE**, Rider J Parkes explained that once obtaining a leading position the gelding was taken on through the middle stages which in his opinion proved detrimental to its chances when placed under pressure in the home straight.

Rider J Riddell was unable to offer any explanation for the performance of **GOLDANDDIAMONDPARK**.

Race 7 BAMBRY'S WATER TREADMILL WOODVILLE-PAHIATUA CUP

BAD BOY BROWN (R Myers) was crowded on jumping between **TIBERIUS** (R Hannam) and **DUKEBOX** (A Collett) which was taken inward by **BEAU AGEN** (L Hemi).

CENTRE ATTENTION (D Turner) got its head up when being restrained in the early stages, with **CENTRE ATTENTION** commencing to over-race shortly after becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of **DUKEBOX**. **CENTRE ATTENTION** then made the first bend awkwardly.

RIGHT ROYAL ROSE (M Dravitzki) was briefly held up near the 350 metres.

JACK'S BOY (J Riddell) lay out under pressure near the 250 metres momentarily hampering the weakening **CAJUN** (M Tanaka).

TIBERIUS lay inwards in the early stages of the final straight, and near the 250 metres was held up for clear running until the 100 metres.

Race 8 GOLDEN BAY CEMENT MDN MILE

M Tanaka replaced L Magorrian as the rider of MOONRAKER.

MOTIVATOR (K Smith) was slow to begin.

VERGISSON (R Myers) and THIRTYLOVE (L Hemi) came together on jumping.

I SPIED (R Hannam) jumped outwards abruptly from the barriers hampering **ZIMMABELLE** (A Collett) and **HER SON** (C Dell), both of which lost ground.

EM KAY POPS (J Parkes) got its head up when being restrained in the early stages and entering the first bend had to be steadied when racing inside **MOONRAKER** (M Tanaka) which lay inwards, with the trailing **CANNY MAGIC** (L Allpress) having to be steady to avoid the heels of **EM KAY POPS**.

THIRTYLOVE and **EM KAY POPS** bumped near the 350 metres.

ACCLAIM (D Turner) hung inwards in the early stages of the final straight and had to be straightened.

ACCLAIM hung inwards again near the 100 metres placing **CANNY MAGIC** in restricted room for the remainder.

MOTIVATOR tailed off throughout and proved uncompetitive. When questioned, Rider K Smith was unable to offer any explanation. Trainer G Haigh advised that **MOTIVATOR** would no longer be persevered as a racing proposition.
