Race 1	NZB FESTIVAL SALE ON SUNDAY MAIDEN (2000m)
<p>PERFECT JAZZ and HIGH IN DEMAND were slow to begin.</p> <p>FREIGHT TRAIN raced greenly when being restrained shortly after the start.</p> <p>BROTHER BOWMAN raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>HIGH IN DEMAND raced wide throughout.</p> <p>HIGH IN DEMAND lay inwards near the 380 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>HIGH IN DEMAND and SKILLS lay outwards in the final stages of the home straight when under pressure.</p>	
Race 2	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1000m)
<p>DISTURBANCE and LIVADREAM came together on jumping.</p> <p>LILY JEAN began awkwardly.</p> <p>G Jogoo, the rider of LIVADREAM, accidentally dropped his whip near the 150 metres.</p> <p>LAMBADA shifted outwards passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>LIVADREAM veered inwards when clear of the field near the 100 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of LAMBADA, rider T Moseley advised that the filly failed to handle the prevailing track conditions.</p>	

Race 3	NZB SOUTH ISLAND SALE ENTRIES CLOSE FEBRUARY 5 RATING 85 (1200m)
When questioned regarding the performance of A BOB SHORT , rider J Lowry advised that the gelding was unable to let down in the prevailing track conditions.	
Race 4	FASTTRACK INSURANCE SUPPORTING NZ RACING MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>The track was downgraded to Slow (9) retrospective to this race.</p> <p>MR TYPHON raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>BUSHIDO blundered when shifting inwards passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>BUSHIDO lay inwards across the heels of MR TYPHON passing the 350 metres and had to be straightened.</p>	
Race 5	RACING THIS SATURDAY AT ASHBURTON MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>KEEPIASECRET and FASHION LASS came together on jumping.</p> <p>SUNFLOWER raced keenly passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>MOREIRA made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>MOBY had to be steadied passing the 800 metres when SHEZA DIAMOND (G Jogoo) shifted inwards. Rider G Jogoo was advised to exercise greater care in future when shifting ground.</p> <p>MOBY lay inwards and bumped with FASHION LASS which in turn bumped with KEEPIASECRET passing the 750 metres.</p> <p>FATHER WAYNE tired sharply from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>SUNFLOWER was awkwardly placed close to the heels of VICAR'S DAUGHTER and had to be steadied passing the 550 metres.</p> <p>MOBY lay inwards passing the 150 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of VICAR'S DAUGHTER, rider T Direen advised that the filly failed to handle the prevailing track conditions.</p> <p>Rider T Moseley (PERMANENT) was reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.</p>	
Race 6	CHRISTCHURCH CASINO RATING 75 (2000m)
<p>SILVER MINX and TELL THE WORLD were slow to begin.</p> <p>TELL THE WORLD (A Chan) bumped with SOUTHERN RAIDER which in turn bumped with SILVER MINX approaching the crossing near the 1700 metres, with TELL THE WORLD becoming unbalanced. Apprentice A Chan was advised to exercise greater care in future when shifting ground.</p> <p>SHADOW PLAYER raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>TELL THE WORLD raced wide in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>SILVER MINX improved wide from the 1200 metres.</p> <p>Rider S Muniandy (MCMAY) was reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.</p> <p>Rider D Bradley advised that SOUTHERN RAIDER failed to handle the prevailing track conditions.</p>	
Race 7	SPEIGHT'S MID ALE RATING 75 (1400m)
<p>PAT IN BRACKETS shifted outwards on jumping, crowding CARBIDE which in turn shifted outwards and bumped with CANTILENA.</p> <p>PAT IN BRACKETS raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>CARBIDE raced wide throughout.</p> <p>ARE YOU MINE lay outwards in the home straight.</p> <p>Rider B Moore (DOUBLE BLUE) was reminded of her obligations in regard to use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 8	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400m)
<p>MADAM COURTNEY (T Moseley) shifted inwards near the 1300 metres with ITS NO SECRET having to be steadied and taken inwards onto KIRINA BELLE who bumped with ELVERA which in turn buffeted BRIDGET TOWN. Rider T Moseley was warned to exercise greater care in future when shifting ground.</p> <p>ELVERA and TOETWOTOE raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>KIRINA BELLE lay inwards and placed FASCINATE ME in restricted room passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>TOETWOTOE had to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>BRIDGET TOWN lay inwards under pressure passing the 300 metres and had to be straightened.</p>
