RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 NEW WORLD WELLINGTON CITY HANDICAP

WRITTEN COMMAND (M Hills) began awkwardly.

DONT GLOAT (**D Turner**) hung out rounding the final bend effectively losing all chance. Stewards requested a veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities. Trainer **A Sharrock** was advised that a warning would now be placed on the racing manners of **DONT GLOAT**. **A Sharrock** in turn advised he would consider the gelding's future as a racing proposition **WRITTEN COMMAND** shied and ducked out abruptly passing the 100 metres losing momentum.

STUNNING PRINCESS (D Bradley) returned to the enclosure with blood in both nostrils. A subsequent veterinary examination confirmed the mare to be a bleeder. Trainer **L Latta** was advised that the mare is now subject to a three month stand down before next racing.

Race 2 NEW WORLD STOKES VALLEY 2YO MAIDEN

LA MOULINE (M Du Plessis) lay out and away from HEROIC VALOUR (M Cameron) on leaving the barriers. This resulted in crowding to TINY TEMPER (R Myers) which shifted out and bumped with ATTITUDZEVERYTHING (J Parkes) with that runner then shifting out abruptly into the line of LADY ROSEANNE (L Magorrian) which was badly hampered and lost ground.

O Bosson (ROSA CAROLINA) was advised to exercise greater care after shifting in shortly after the start hampering **ATTITUDZEVERYTHING** which had to be steadied.

HEROIC VALOUR lay out passing the 800 metres inconveniencing LA MOULINE. HEROIC VALUE was then inclined to race greenly for a short distance getting its head up on several occasions. ATTITUDZEVERTHING raced greenly throughout.

LADY ROSEANNE lay out under pressure in the run down the final straight

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{LA}}$ MOULINE had to be steadied near the post when $\ensuremath{\mathsf{HEROIC}}$ VALOUR $% \ensuremath{\mathsf{Shifted}}$ shifted out.

Race 3 NEW WORLD CHURTON PARK HANDICAP

FLOSCEE'S GOLD (R Hannam) shifted in on jumping bumping with OLIVIA MARY (D Hirini).

LINCOLN'S LEGACY (I Hemi) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers between KONOHIKI (R Myers) which shifted out and KHALAMA (O Bosson) which shifted in abruptly.

THE AXE (C Johnson) raced keenly throughout and had to be restrained off heels near the 600 metres.

OLIVIA MARY had to steady when in restricted room and shift ground outwards near the 350 metres to improve.

LINCOLN'S LEGACY raced disappointingly and finished last. Rider L Hemi considered something may be a miss with the

gelding. A subsequent veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormality.

R Myers could offer no excuses for the performance of KONOHIKI.

Race 4 NEW WORLD ISLAND BAY MAIDEN

ADONIS was a late scratching behind the barrier on veterinary advice at 2.20pm after showing signs of lameness. Trainer **T Bamby** was advised that a clearance will be required before **ADONIS** races again.

BIGGIE SMALLS (R Myers) was slow to begin and then crowded when MACHA (R Hannam) shifted in on jumping.

MISSMOSA (D Hirini) raced in restricted room for a short distance through the early stages when back.

PAUA EYES (R Goldsbury) raced wide throughout.

MISSMOSA raced in restricted room in the early part of the final straight.

Te Baker (COLOMBIAN ROSE) was reminded of his obligations with regard to the use of his whip prior to the 200 metres.

Race 5 NEW WORLD RAILWAY METRO HANDICAP

SILVER NANCHO (J Riddell) blundered on jumping away and settled back.

SILK BELT (C Johnson) was held up from the 600 metres and for the entire length of the home straight going to the line untested.

ROCKY RIDE (C Lammas) began awkwardly and lost ground.

KINGOFPLATINUM (D Bradley) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SILVER NANCHO (J Riddle) raced wide throughout.

KEEP US HAPPY (M Dravitzki) was held up early in the home straight and was unable to take advantage of a narrow run which presented near the 300 metres.

SILVER NANCHO was jostled when weakening approaching the 100 metres.

Race 6 NEW WORLD HUTT CITY MAIDEN

QUATRE VINGTS (C Lammas) and RHIANNON (M Tanaka) were slow to begin.

DREAM DANCER (D Turner) was held up rounding the turn and near the 300 metres when attempting a marginal run between **FRUITION (M Hills)** and **COMMANDER (J Parkes)** shifted out and contacted the heels of **COMMANDER** and blundered coming back onto **ZBEAUTY (G Cooksley)** which was checked and effectively lost its chance.

SAVASON (L Magorrian) was held up for the majority of the home straight only gaining clear running in the final 50 metre.

Race 7 NEW WORLD WILLIS STREET METRO HANDICAP

ROCK ON (J Parkes) began very slowly and lost several lengths.

VITESSE (M du Plessis) lay out leaving the barriers dictating MORRIS LASS (D Mo) wider.

FIVE TO MIDNIGHT (D Bradley) jumped out at the start bumping with ANIMATOR (R Myers).

VITESSE over-raced in the early stages.

SAKURA (D Turner) over-raced throughout.

ANIMATOR (R Myers) shifted out under pressure near the finish resulting in **CHOP SUEY(R Hannam)** being dictated outward. Prior to the authorization of dividends, connections of the second placed **CHOP SUEY** viewed footage but elected not to proceed with an objection against the winner **ANIMATOR**.

Race 8 WELLFIELD DESERT GOLD STAKES -GpIII

This race started approx. 2mins late due to several runners proving difficult to load.

FAME SEEKER (G Cooksley) jumped in at the start tightening CHIC (J Riddell) which lost ground.

DEEDEE PANACHE (R Myers) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers and lost ground.

DUCHESS KATE (M Cameron) attempted to jump the crossing at the 1550 metres and was unbalanced briefly. DUCHESS

KATE then over-raced for a distance.

STRADA CAVALLO (C Johnson), COLDPLAY (O Bosson), BLACK SAV (J Parkes) and CHIC all over-raced in the middle stages when the tempo steadied.

STRADA CAVALLO continued to over-race for some distance.

BELLA COURT (D Bradley) raced wide from the 1000 metres

FAME SEEKER was held up passing the 400 metres and had to shift ground outwards near the 250 metres to obtain clear running

LAUBERHORN (M Hills) was held up early in the home straight and when angled out for clear running near the 300 metres bumped with **STRADA CAVALLO.**

COLD PLAY was held up in the final straight and unable to be tested at any stage.

CHIC was held up over the final stages when running on from well back.

BLACK SAV was inclined to lay in on occasion in the final straight.

Race 9 NEW WORLD SILVERSTREAM HANDICAP

LETSGETITON (C Lammas), CASTUP (M Du Plessis), NOM DU BEEL (K Smith) and **ZORRALI** (D Mo) were all slow to begin. **KEILIB (M Tanaka)** and **NYMPH MONTE (R Myers)** raced wide throughout

MASTER THOMAS (M Cameron) over-raced throughout.

LETSGETITON had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the final straight.

FLYING IBIS (D Turner) was held up passing the 400 metres so was taken wider approaching the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

KNOWING (L Hemi) had to steady near the 200 metres when racing in restricted quarters.

K Smith, the rider of **NOM DU BEEL** which dropped out over the final stages reported that the going was too firm for the gelding on this occasion.
