**RACE COMMENTS:**

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>NZB FESTIVAL SALE ON SUNDAY MAIDEN (1400m)</b>
<p><b>Trainers J &amp; K Parsons</b> were fined \$50 after presenting <b>MOERAKI MIST</b> without an item of notified gear.</p> <p><b>Trainers T &amp; M Stokes</b> were fined \$100 by the Judicial Committee after presenting their two stable runners with incorrect saddle cloth numbers.</p> <p><b>OPIHI JADE</b> and <b>YOGI</b> were slow to begin.</p> <p><b>PARANA</b> and <b>JULIEFOUNDHER</b> came together shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>I' M A SINGLE LADY</b> contacted a heel of <b>NOT AVAILABLE</b> and blundered passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p><b>MOERAKI MIST</b> raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>JULIEFOUNDHER</b> over raced for a short distance passing the 900 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p><b>FLYTIME</b> lost the left hind plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>AVON CITY FORD MAIDEN (1600m)</b>
<p><b>JUST A JACKET</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>AURIOL</b> began awkwardly, crowding <b>BARCLAY CREEK</b> onto <b>MONTE CINTO</b>.</p> <p><b>JUST A JACKET</b> raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p> <p><b>LADY BYRON</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>MINUTES TO MIDNITE</b> (K Mudhoo) lay out under pressure in the final straight, inconveniencing <b>LADY BYRON</b>. Apprentice Mudhoo was advised that he must make a greater effort to maintain a straighter line of running.</p> <p><b>BARCLAY CREEK</b> and <b>MONTE CINTO</b> came together passing the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>R Black</b> (LADY EM) was issued with a warning for her use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>THE MORGAN</b> gave ground quickly from the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the final straight, finishing a distant last. A post race veterinary inspection indicated the gelding to be suffering from a wind affliction with a dynamic scope being suggested by the Veterinarian. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>NZB SOUTH ISLAND SALE ENTRIES CLOSE FEBRUARY 5 RATING 75 (1600m)</b>
<p><b>OPIHI RANGER</b> shifted inwards leaving the barriers, crowding <b>FEELIN THE LOVE</b> onto <b>SIR SINGO</b>.</p> <p><b>PAT IN BRACKETS</b> which began awkwardly was restrained to the rear on jumping.</p> <p><b>PAT IN BRACKETS</b> commenced to over race near the 900 metres shifting outwards to avoid heels before improving forward wide.</p> <p><b>PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE</b> was held up entering the final straight and was then unable to obtain clear running until near the 100 metres.</p> <p><b>GALLANT DEFENDER</b> (S Muniandy) shifted inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres, taking <b>REVOLUTIONARY</b> inwards, resulting in <b>PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE</b> which was attempting to improve to the inside of <b>REVOLUTIONARY</b> having to be steadied. S Muniandy was issued with a warning.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the poor performance of <b>OPIHI RANGER</b>, rider D Walsh advised that the gelding had raced in a fresh state in its first run for a month and had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions which he described as shifty. J Lowry, the rider of <b>DO UNO WHOIAM</b>, also advised that his mount had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions. The track was downgraded to Dead (6) retrospective to this race.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>BERKLEY STUD SELLING @ FESTIVAL SALE RATING 65 (2100m)</b>
<p>Trainer <b>D Crozier</b> was fined \$300 after presenting <b>CAVATINO</b> without a lead bag.</p> <p><b>HE'S A BIGDEEL</b> raced ungenerously going into the first turn passing the 1800 metres and shifted outwards. When being corrected by its rider <b>HE'S A BIGDEEL</b> lost its footing behind.</p> <p><b>SKEEN</b> shifted outwards under pressure hampering <b>INA JAM</b> near the 175 metres before being corrected by its rider. L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>When questioned regarding his riding tactics aboard <b>KEYNOTE</b>, which was angled wide on the track early in the final straight, apprentice G Jogoo advised he had been instructed to angle wider for better footing but conceded he had erred in his judgment by angling as wide as he had.</p> <p>Apprentice B Murray admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip on his mount <b>CAVATINO</b> prior to the 200 metres and was fined \$250 by the Judicial Committee.</p> <p>D Walsh reported that his mount <b>MESSINES</b> had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>CHRISTCHURCH CASINO DUNEDIN GOLD CUP TRIAL (2100m)</b>
<p><b>KEEPA TRAMP</b> was crowded leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>SADLERS ROCK</b> raced three wide without cover from the 1200 metres.</p> <p><b>KAHARAU</b> shifted ground outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.</p> <p><b>SHE'S INSATIABLE</b> underwent a post race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>PUNTERS CHALLENGE ON APRIL 16 – ENTER NOW RATING 65 (1200m)</b>
<p><b>MULBERRY</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>MAL D'MOUR</b> began awkwardly, making contact with <b>HAPI GIRL</b> which blundered.</p> <p><b>DI MONET</b> raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p><b>ABELL ROAD</b> raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>MAL D'MOUR</b> had to be steadied after improving onto the heels of <b>DAIFUKU</b> rounding the turn passing the 500 metres.</p> <p>R Black (<b>KASUNDI</b>) dropped her right rein near the 300 metres, with <b>KASUNDI</b> then shifting inwards abruptly, hampering <b>FASCINATE</b>, which also resulted in <b>MELANIE CLAIRE</b> being inconvenienced.</p> <p><b>MULBERRY</b> was held up becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>STILL WATERS</b> near the 350 metres.</p> <p><b>MULBERRY</b> lay outwards in the final straight hampering <b>MELANIE CLAIRE</b> near the 150 metres.</p> <p><b>DAIFUKU</b> lost the left front plate during the running.</p> <p><b>KASUNDI</b> lost the right rear plate during the running.</p> <p>A post race veterinary inspection of <b>CELTIC CROSS</b> revealed slight lameness in the right foreleg.</p> <p><b>DAIFUKU</b> which was galloped on during the running underwent a post race veterinary inspection but did not require any treatment suffering minor superficial lacerations.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>BARNESWOOD FARM AGISTMENT RATING 75 (1200m)</b>
<p><b>SPRINGWATER</b> and <b>BACK IN THE DAY</b> were slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BIG KAHUNA</b> commenced to over race passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>MADAME JAMAI</b> and <b>WHISKEY BOLERO</b> raced wide without cover.</p> <p><b>TOMM JONES</b> was held up in the early part of the straight, striking a heel of <b>BIG KAHUNA</b> and blundering near the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>MAIA'S ANGEL</b> lay out under pressure in the straight, inconveniencing <b>SANDY'S STAR</b> at the 300 metres before then making contact with that runner near the 200 metres.</p> <p>Apprentice <b>B Murray</b> (STORMY LASS) was issued with a warning regarding his whip use prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>SPEIGHT'S TIMARU STAKES (1400m)</b>
<p>Trainer T Rae was issued with a warning after presenting <b>ILLUMINATI</b> without an item of notified gear.</p> <p><b>MISS ALICE</b> and <b>TOMA VALEA</b> were slow to begin.</p> <p><b>NORAH</b> and <b>MISS ALICE</b> raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>MADAM VICTORIA</b> (R Cuneen) shifted inwards passing the 1200 metres when not sufficiently clear of <b>MISS ALICE</b> which was checked and forced inwards, crowding <b>MEURSAULT</b> onto <b>TOMA VALEA</b> which had to be steadied. R Cuneen defended a resultant charge of careless riding. After hearing evidence and submissions the Judicial Committee found the charge to be proven suspending R Cuneen's licence to ride at race meetings for 5 days effective 7 February to 19 February inclusive.</p> <p><b>MISS ALICE</b> then raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained.</p> <p><b>RED DIRT GIRL</b> raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>VOLCANO</b> over raced for a distance in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>NEWS FLASH</b> had to be steadied to avoid the heels of <b>ZERO TUA HUNDRED</b> entering the final straight passing the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>NORAH</b> lay outwards in the home straight and made contact with <b>MISS ALICE</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>LINDAUER RATING 65 (1600m)</b>
<p>The start was delayed whilst <b>CRISTALLO</b> underwent farrier attention prior to the start.</p> <p><b>ROC CITY</b> was obliged to race wide throughout.</p> <p><b>FALZANO</b> raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>LUKE</b> lay out under pressure rounding the final turn and in the straight.</p> <p><b>M Chui</b> admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip on his mount <b>NIGHT NURSE</b> prior to the 200 metres, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.</p> <p><b>B Murray</b> admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip on his mount <b>THE REAL DEAL</b> prior to the 200 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 2 days effective 7 February to 13 February (inclusive).</p>
