## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>MARSDEN SHEARING 3YO MAIDEN</b>
<p>INCANTATION (L Hemi) was slow to begin and then raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>RUSTY IN MELBOURNE (M Dravitzki) was steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of PERANTO near the 900 metres.</p> <p>PERANTO (M Tanaka) raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MURRAY FREE CONTRACTING MAIDEN</b>
<p>Shortly after the start, MACHA (R Hannam) ducked in abruptly losing ground.</p> <p>RICHIE ROX (H Tinsley) got its head up when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>ALL CHARM (R Goldsbury) commenced to over-race near the 1000 metres making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly forcing MISSMOSA (D Hirini) wider on the track. MISSMOSA then raced wide without cover for the remainder.</p> <p>THATSTHETICKET (D Mo) lay in when placed under pressure early in the final straight making contact with PERFECT PITCH (C Lammas).</p> <p>C Lammas the rider of PERFECT PITCH admitted a charge under Rule 636 (1) (d) of failing to ride his mount out fully to the finish when having a reasonable chance of finishing in fifth position with the judicial committee imposing a fine of \$200.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of RICHIE ROX rider H Tinsley reported that RICHIE ROX may not have been suited by the application of blinkers. Trainer P Campbell advised he would alter the geldings gear prior to its next start.</p>	

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>ROWDEN ELECTRICAL SERVICES HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>ZORRALI (C Lammas); ON THE HILL (M Singh) and IRISH WHISPER (M Dravitzki)</b> were all slow to begin. <b>DARCI MAC (D Mo)</b> which was over-racing had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>IN ANOTHER LIFE (R Myers)</b> approaching the 1000 metres. <b>DARCI MAC</b> then shifted out forcing <b>ENDURE (R Hannam)</b> wider on the track. <b>CHARLESTOWN</b> and <b>ON THE HILL (M Singh)</b> both over-raced when the pace eased passing the 1000 metres. <b>IRISH WHISPER</b> and <b>CHARLESTOWN (L Hemi)</b> were both steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of <b>ENDURE</b> near the 600 metres. After questioning riders and viewing available footage Stewards could not apportion blame to any particular rider. <b>IRISH WHISPER</b> was steadied when attempting a marginal run to the outside of <b>ENDURE</b> which shifted out slightly near the 200 metres and in doing so, shifted out making contact with the hindquarters of <b>PLATINUM BALOS (M Tanaka)</b>. <b>R Hannam</b> was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. <b>Rider D Mo (DARCI MAC)</b> advised Stewards that his saddle had moved forward when racing along the back straight placing him at a disadvantage.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>CARTERS ASHHURST POHANGINA CUP</b>
<p><b>OVERTHERIVER</b> underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was passed fit to race. <b>OVERTHERIVER (H Tinsley)</b> began awkwardly shifting out and hampering <b>CHAMBOARD (R Myers)</b> which clipped that runner's heel and blundered. <b>ETERNITY (R Hannam)</b> began awkwardly losing ground. <b>Rider D Mo (SPEECH CRAFT)</b> dropped his whip just short of the winning post. <b>Trainer T Riddell</b> reported that <b>SPEECH CRAFT</b> was feeling the effects of the heat post-race.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>ARANUI HARVESTERS MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>MASTER JACK (C Lammas) and KNUCKLEHEAD (M Cropp)</b> began awkwardly. <b>HELVETICA (Te Baker)</b> raced greenly in the middle stages. <b>CANNY MAGIC (T Johnson)</b> raced wide without cover throughout. <b>MASTER WILLIAM (D Hirini)</b> was denied a run entering the final straight and had to steady. <b>BOXACHOCOLATES (R Myers)</b> was steadied when denied a run to the outside of <b>I SPIED (R Hannam)</b> which shifted out slightly near the 350 metres. <b>FIREBIRD FLYER (M Dravitzki)</b> was held up passing the 250 metres having to be firmly restrained. <b>FRANCOME</b> and <b>FIREBIRD FLYER</b> bumped over the final stages. <b>D Mo</b> reported the saddle on <b>FRANCOME</b> shifted placing him at a disadvantage. <b>R Hannam</b> reported that <b>I SPIED</b> may be suited to a longer trip.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>ERNIES HAY &amp; FENCING CONTRACTING HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>MASTER THOMAS</b> was a late scratching at 4.04pm on veterinary advice after dislodging rider during its preliminary and galloping almost a circuit. <b>JACKSSTAR (D Mo)</b> began awkwardly losing ground. <b>CENTRE ATTENTION (R Goldsbury)</b> was held up briefly passing the 350 metres. <b>JACKSSTAR</b> improved onto heels just short of the finishing line and had to be steadied. <b>ANIMATOR (R Myers)</b> was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. <b>R Myers</b> advised Stewards that she was unable to ride <b>ANIMATOR</b> out to full advantage due to the gelding's tendency to lug in.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>HAYDEN ALLEN MEMORIAL</b>
<p><b>DANMULAN (K Smith)</b> over-raced in the early stages and then lost ground when being restrained off the heels of <b>REDALIGN (M Singh)</b> approaching the 800 metres when that runner shifted in. Also hampered in this incident was <b>SILK BELT</b>. <b>M Singh</b> was issued with a warning. <b>CLUBS CHOICE (M Tanaka)</b> raced three-wide without cover throughout. <b>DANMULAN</b> lugged out rounding the final bend. <b>OLIVIA MARY (D Hirini)</b> and <b>POSTER GIRL (L Hemi)</b> were held up near the 400 metres. <b>SLIMLINE (R Goldsbury)</b> shifted out to obtain clear running near the 250 metres and made contact with <b>BEEFEATER (H Tinsley)</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>THE TANK GUY HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>LORD CASANOVA (M Tanaka)</b> knuckled over at the start making contact with the hindquarters of <b>LA ADELITA (H Tinsley)</b> dislodging <b>M Tanaka</b> who was attended to by St John's personnel. <b>HOT SPOT (D Hirini)</b> raced without cover.</p>	

**RULE THE WORLD (C Lammas)** raced disappointingly and finished well back. **C Lammas** could offer no excuses and a subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections advised that **RULE THE WORLD** would be monitored over coming days.
