RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MY SKIN & BEAUTY 2200 MAIDEN 2200M
PAYMENT PENDING and STRICTLY LIMITED were slow to begin. SWEET TIME made the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly getting its head up on a number of occasions. PAYMENT PENDING improved wide from the 800 metres.	
Race 2	EASY MADE MARMALADE R85 1600M
LAKOTA was slow in the early stages and had to be steadied near the 1100 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of PENNYS FROM HEAVEN (R Black) which shifted inwards. Rider R Black (PENNYS FROM HEAVEN) was warned under Rule 638(1)(d) and reminded of her obligations.	

Race 3	GARDEN FRESH OAMARU R65 1600M
<p>BABILLONI was slow to begin.</p> <p>BEAUTY ACE began awkwardly and then raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1400 metres.</p> <p>FLICKA OF GOLD raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>CRISTALLO had to be steadied near the 350 metre mark when FINAL SHINKO (K Mudhoo) shifted ground outwards, rider K Mudhoo was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.</p> <p>SLICK NICKEL (G Jogoo) became awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring DOWRA at the 300 metres and shifted ground outwards making contact with CRISTALLO. G Jogoo was warned under Rule 638 (1)(d). Simultaneously SHANZOU shifted inwards dictating FINAL SHINKO onto CRISTALLO which was buffeted and lost ground.</p> <p>Near the 50 metres CRISTALLO shifted inwards abruptly and contacted the heels on FINAL SHINKO blundering and badly unbalancing rider C Barnes.</p> <p>Rider J Lowry (DOWRA) was reminded about the use of his whip on a runner out of contention.</p>	
Race 4	OAMARU LICENSING TRUST R75 1400M
<p>BACK IN THE DAY was slow to begin.</p> <p>CHAMPOLLION was restrained to the rear on jumping.</p> <p>MELS EVIE raced wide throughout.</p> <p>FANTAMO over keenly for a short distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>CHAMPOLLION raced keenly in the middle stages having to be heavily restrained off heels near the 800 metres.</p> <p>CHAMPOLLION again had to steady when on heels approaching the 600 metres.</p> <p>STARLIGHT ANGEL lay outwards passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>TOMM JONES lay inwards throughout the run home and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.</p>	
Race 5	OAMARU SCAFFOLDING MAIDEN 1200M
<p>RAROONEY was slow to begin.</p> <p>JANEFIELD JEWEL raced wide throughout</p> <p>RAROONEY had to steady near the 900 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of JANEFIELD JEWEL.</p> <p>DIAMONDS INMY HALO was heavily restrained off heels near the 700 metres and lay outwards from that point running off. Connections were advised the mare must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing next. A post-race inspection of DIAMONDS INMY HALO revealed no abnormalities.</p> <p>Rider A Chan (GO GO TINKER) was reminded about the use of the whip on a runner out of contention.</p>	
Race 6	UNDER & OUT DRILLING R65 1200M
<p>A Chan replaced D Chin as the rider of CARMEN SANDIEGO.</p> <p>CARMEN SANDIEGO and OH SO SMART were both slow to begin.</p> <p>OVERNIGHTSENSATION raced wide throughout.</p> <p>PORTOVENERE lay outwards rounding the final bend and had to be straightened.</p> <p>STRALIS was steadied near the 300 metres and shifted ground inwards to obtain clear running.</p> <p>PORTOVENERE lay outwards passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>KILLA QUESTION lay inwards near the 50 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>When questioned about the improved performance of OVERNIGHTSENSATION trainer K Rae reported that he could offer no tangible reason for the improved performance. Rider T Moseley reported that the tempo of the race had suited the mare.</p> <p>P Shaikh (PORTOVENERE) defended a charge under Rule 638 (3)(b)(i) in that he used his whip unnecessarily. After hearing all relevant submissions the JCA dismissed the charge.</p>	
Race 7	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1400M
<p>DREAM DIVINE was slow to begin.</p> <p>HOT DATE and BENS LASS raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>WINDERMERE LASS raced wide throughout.</p> <p>MIRAGE was steadied at the 800 metres.</p> <p>INBEE was steadied near the 500 metres when awkwardly placed on heel.</p> <p>Payment of dividends was withheld when M Pitman co trainer of FUN FAIR lodged a protest against winner MYSTIFY ME under Rules 642 (1) and 638 (3) (c). After viewing all relevant video footage and reading of relevant rules Mr Pitman sought leave from the JCA to withdraw the protest.</p>	
Race 8	OAMARU NORTHSTAR MOTELS R65 2200M
<p>GRAFFITI began awkwardly, blundering and shifting outwards making firm contact with AMAROK.</p> <p>AMAROK raced keenly in the early stages and got its head up on a number of occasions.</p> <p>POINT PROVEN improved wide from the 1400 metres.</p> <p>SKILLS was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of SHE'S PAYBACK near the 1100 metres when the tempo of the</p>	

race eased.

INA JAM improved wide from the 800 metres.

INA JAM made the bend near the 400 metres awkwardly becoming unbalanced and shifting outwards.

INA JAM shifted inwards under pressure near the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

When questioned about the improved performance of **ODABELLA** co-trainer K Hughes informed Stewards that the mare had appreciated the prevailing track conditions.
